London -- Italy delivered a formal note of protest here today over alleged violations of the TET (Tides of Easter Truce) agreement by English troops...The Foreign Office said it intends to nationalize the Papacy by 1915...As an afterthought, it threw in the Eiffel Tower and the Spires of Moscow as further objectives for the first Five-Year Plan to nationalize Europe...Local partisans resisting nationalization procedures will be impressed into the Royal Navy for the future invasion of Africa, and any place else close at hand...Conscription quotas for this month have been raised 314% to implement the formation of the 5th and 6th Armies, and the 9th Fleet...The Minister of Defense made his annual announcement that "Our boys will be home by Christmas."

Propaganda --

Vienna -- Units of the Hungarian Guards, the Austrian Fifth Army, and the Rumanian Royal Cavalry were dispatched into Russia today to aid Germany in throwing

back the Turkish barbarians. This move was taken only after the rout of the German forces in Armenia, and with the consultation of the German ambassador. The forces will be withdrawn after the Turks are contained, and the CEF forces will do nothing but aid the German forces in protecting their hegemony in Russia.

In other news, von Korber announced that victory over the French in the North African campaign is expected within the month. Units of the Third Fleet have landed in Tunis, and it is expected that the French threat to the Italian prefectures will soon be ended. Elections in the prefectures of Apulia, Roma, and Venetia will go on as scheduled.

Propaganda --

Constantinople -- Rome: How about it?

Constantinople -- Hurried conferences in Vienna to avert war between this nation and Austria-Hungary have apparently failed. It appears that unless concessions are made by Austria in the Balkans, there will be Janizaries crossing the Danube. The cession of Serbia and the Moslem areas of Albania and Transylvania will avert war. Peace with Russia has been made -- can Austria not follow his example?

Italy -- Austria: Tunis is all we want.

Moscow -- The cession of Muscovy to Russia has been made official. The last Turkish troops left the area just as the Russian legions arrived. Are the Eastern powers going to war together against some common enemy? It appears likely. Negotiations are already underway for the return of the Crimea to Russia, and the total withdrawal of Ottoman troops from Russia's 1901 boundaries.

Paris & London -- Marshall La Temur today simultaneously released statements from the remaining free holdings of France on the future deployment of the army and navy. He cited the bravery of the French who have been fighting completely unaided against the Italians, Germans, Russians and English for eight long years. Marshall La Temur announced that the fight was over, and that the remaining French lands would be peacefully incorporated into the Empires of Italy, Germany, Russia, or England ("Whoever gets there first!").

Rome -- Of course, what do you think I built them for?

Vienna -- Austria-Hungary and the new government of Great Russia have formed an alliance to destroy the Ottoman threat in the East. It is hoped that this alliance has not come too late to save the people of Moscow from their cruel and hideous massacre by the Turks.

GM Note -- Your propaganda wasn't printed last time, Jim, because it was with your SPRING moves, which weren't printed until this issue. If anyone sends in propaganda with advance moves, he will have to specify if he wants it published whether his moves are printed or not; otherwise, it is printed with the moves.

GM Note -- The GERMAN move "A Ruh-Mun" succeeded because of the (unwanted) FRENCH
order, "A Bur (S) FRA A Ruh-Mun". This is following the precedent established by
Charles Wells in game 1965P, the arguments for which will be found on pages 5 and 6
of LONELY MOUNTAIN #39. We are not overly happy with this precedent, however, and
invite arguments -- both pro and con -- from the players, to be received NLT June 14.
Dave, submit one build order, in case we reverse our decision after reviewing the
arguments. This is one of the cases where a strictly 'legalistic' interpretation of
the Diplomacy Rulebook goes against a 'realistic' interpretation -- however, treating
such a situation too loosely could easily open a Pandora's Box of questions about
other common Diplomacy rulings....

He came to Budapest and asked the protection of the Council, and also requested permission for his country to join the Council. This the Council, with its liberal entrance policy, was quick to grant. It had no sooner done this than a messenger rushed into the hall, handed a letter to the Secretary for the Council, and dropped dead. This caused a great deal of interest in the contents of the letter. It seemed that it was a report from the Bosnian fleet, now in Athens. The fleet reported Turkish spies, assassins, guerrillas, and other agitators in Macedonia, not to mention a full-scale Turkish invasion last fall. Furthermore, Rear Admiral Luttenvarden asserted, the Turks had built two new piers in Smyrna, both capable of taking ships up to 16,000 tons. Previously, there had been no such docks built outside the Black Sea by Turkey.

Then came the real shock. An unidentified task force, consisting of two fishing trawlers supported by a converted Palestinian schooner, had raided Crete and blown up five peasants near Iraklion, carrying off their valuables and women. The fragments of the deadly mine were said to be in the possession of the Rear Admiral, and he said in the letter that the mine was unmistakably of Turkish or Armenian manufacture. The Rear Admiral reported quick reaction, with six balloons sent up to hunt down and kill the raiders, but the raiders were not found.

This angered the delegates greatly. No signatory of their Council, said the leading Ruthenian delegate in a brilliant impromptu speech, would be treated like that by a foreign power. He demanded war -- immediate war with Turkey -- and in the heat of the moment the Council declared war. Within a few hours a mob assembled in front of the Turkish Embassy, demanding "revenge on the murderers". The mob was eventually dispersed, but the Ambassador was requested to leave Council territory immediately. At this moment Admiral Luttenvarden's ships are sailing for Constantinople, the heart of Turkey. The Council also promised the Bulgarian delegate that he would be restored to his throne.

After things had cooled down a bit in Budapest, the Council returned to regular business. The group enacted a special statement, to be issued to the itinerant press, which read as follows: "The Kaiser of Germany has responded favorably to our peace initiatives. The individual responsible for the attack on the Austrian Emperor's land at Salzburg last April has been punished to our satisfaction, and we have concluded a treaty of peace with the Kaiser. Our countries have agreed to stop all acts of war, and to continue this for

five years. Once more the peasants of Bohemia will be able to sow their fields in peace. Once more the miners of Silesia will dig up coal in peace. Peace is a glorious thing." The news was received with rejoicing in Budapest, Fiume, Vienna, and Prague. The Council also, shortly thereafter, announced a tentative cease-fire with Italy, effective until further notice.

Budapest -- The signatories of the Council of Vienna, due to numerous provocations, among them the unlawful seizure of the throne of Bulgaria by an usurper, find it necessary to declare war on the Ottoman Empire. Bulgaria will be returned to its rightful ruler, who was also declared a full member of the Council by the assembly of that council. The Council, after its 1902 meeting at Budapest, will recess for the winter, to meet again on January 5, 1903, in the capital of the King of all Czechs, Prague.

Budapest -- It is very helpful of the German Kaiser to declare a demilitarized zone to exist, consisting of two of the richest areas of the Vienna Alliance and none of the Empire of Germany, but the non-aggression pact which we agreed to stands exactly as it was worded in correspondence between the Council and Kaiser. No additions which the Kaiser may have thought to add later, without consulting the Council, are binding on it. What is binding on it is what is publicized by it. No demilitarized zone exists, and Council states reserve the right to maneuver as they see fit within the provinces of Bohemia and Tyrolia. The Council will stand firmly by its word, but not by some extension or elaboration on its word made by a foreign State.

Capri -- Secretary of Aggression Benito Halleinni blamed "a lack of communication" for the failure of Italian forces to act this last Spring. He casually mentioned that the defective part of the network has been executed.

Rome -- Thousands of wildly cheering Italians crowded the streets of the capital city today, converging on the British Embassy to cheer the entry of England into the crusade on France. The British Ambassador, although awakened at 1:00 p.m., was quite surprised and pleased by the demonstration of friendship.

NSG -- Italy, wake up! You blew one big chance already.

NSG -- I am not even going to comment on the fact that we had an alliance.

GM Note -- To respond to the question asked us with the last moves: If two different armies are ordered by the same player to the same place, and an enemy's army is ordered there also, it is a stand-off all the way around, unless one of the armies so moving is moving with (uncut) support.
