Propaganda --

Antwerp -- For the past several weeks, French troops crossing the frontier into Bel-
gium were greeted by cryptic signs reading "Welcome to Belgium, the Philadelphia of
Europe -- signed the British First Fleet". The sullen, but sober, Belgians -- at
least the men and children who were in evidence -- appeared most reluctant to dis-
cuss the meaning of the signs.

London -- Special from Buckingham Palace -- a spokesman for His Britannic Majesty in-
dicated that arrangements had been attempted to present a decoration to Admiral (now
retired) Sir Julian Smythe-Barrellaz for "exceptional services to the crown". How-
ever, the spokesman admitted not having been able to contact the Admiral as communi-
cations appear to have been broken between London and the Admiral's country estate.

Sublime Porte, Constantinople (Jan. 23) -- H.I.M. Linda I, in her coronation message
as Queen of Serbia, announced that all nationalistic groups in the Empire would be
suppressed. The divisional groups that caused the downfall of Germany and are now
contributing to the defeat of Austria constitute a clear and present danger to the
freedom of the Empire. The rights of minorities as individuals and in matters of
religion has not been and will not be interfered with by H.I.M.'s government. How-
ever, no books, save prayer and language books, may be printed in any language but
New Turkish, which is Turkish in a phonetic alphabet devised in 1896 by the Imperial
Academy. This law will, of course, be gradually brought into effect, with primers
coming under the law immediately. By 1915, it is expected, all citizens will speak
and read Turkish. -- by Ahmed ibn Mohammed, for H.I.M. Linda I
