Paris -- England: Yes.

Paris -- Rome: We interpret your evacuation of Berlin as an invitation for us to occupy it, in return for our assistance in your capture of Smyrna, your future defense of it, and your imminent capture of Trieste. If this is not true, you can easily keep us out of Berlin with a standoff; but if you do this, we would ask you to explain your ingratitude. In hopes that our relationship will continue to prosper at the expense of the Russians, I remain your own Louis the Last.

St. Pete -- Turkey: I think you're out this time. Many thanks for your help.

St. Pete -- England: Why should you trust France? For that matter, why should you work with him? There's no way you can get more than one or two supply centers from me without running into conflict with France. As it is, you're going to end the game as a third-rate power. I'm offering peace with you. Look at the map!

St. Pete -- France & Italy: Look, I'm out of it. If I'm lucky, I'll keep my home supply centers this year and maybe some others. The Big Russian Menace is ended. Now what are you two going to do? Italy is out to win, I'm sure of that -- he stabbed France and now me and if he gets an alliance with England, he can win the game by destroying France.
