DER REICHSBLAD (Berlin -- Monday, 29 December 1902) -- During the customary Monday morning press conference held at the Chancellory, it was plain to see that there are some worried men at the Foreign Affairs Dept. The events, or rather, lack of them, in the UK is, of course, the main issue. Questions asked about what the Chancellor intended to do were turned aside with evasive answers. Von Richtofen did, however, say that the general military-political situation in the West was being reviewed and the appropriate steps would be taken. *** Another issue raised concerned the persistent rumor that Germany would invade Scandinavia.
