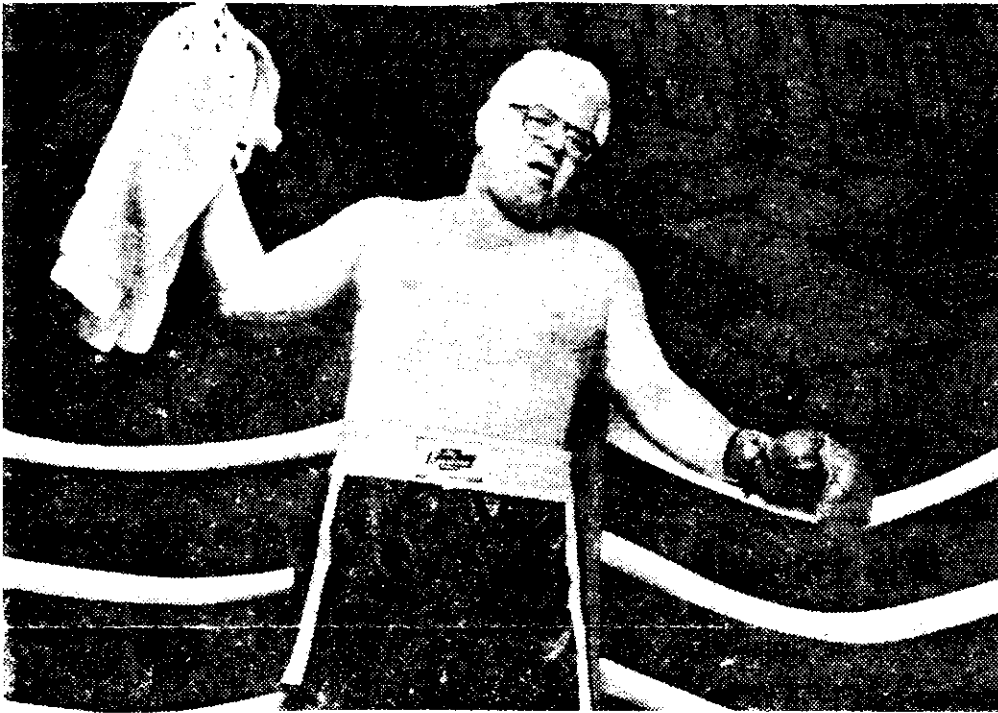

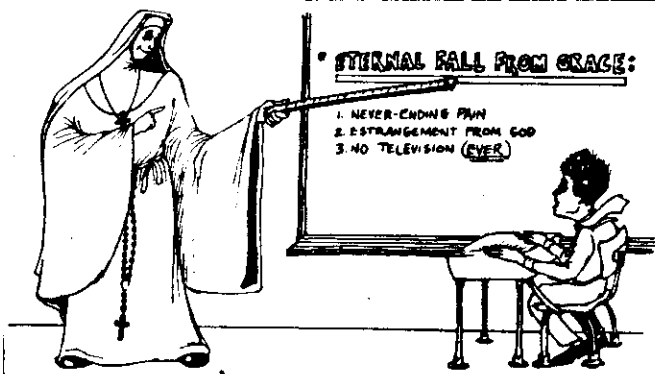

KLEIN GUILTY! FREED ON TECHNICALITY
