Girls are the most dependent and least sexy. They're also lazier and less considerate than either women or ladies. There appears no redeeming feature that would make a woman prefer to be called a girl.

While <u>lady</u> draws the highest ratings in theory on beauty and popularity, <u>in practice</u> the term is reserved for unfamiliar, low-status women. The typcial lady is weaker, less sexy, less intelligent, and less a leader than the typical women.
