another regarding the length of time he could go without a security blanket.

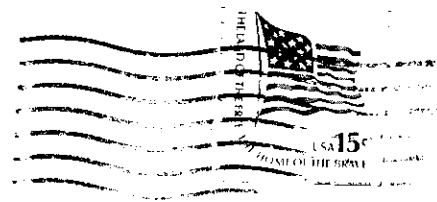
The Prime Minister was recently seen in Parliament throwing a temper tantrum and
