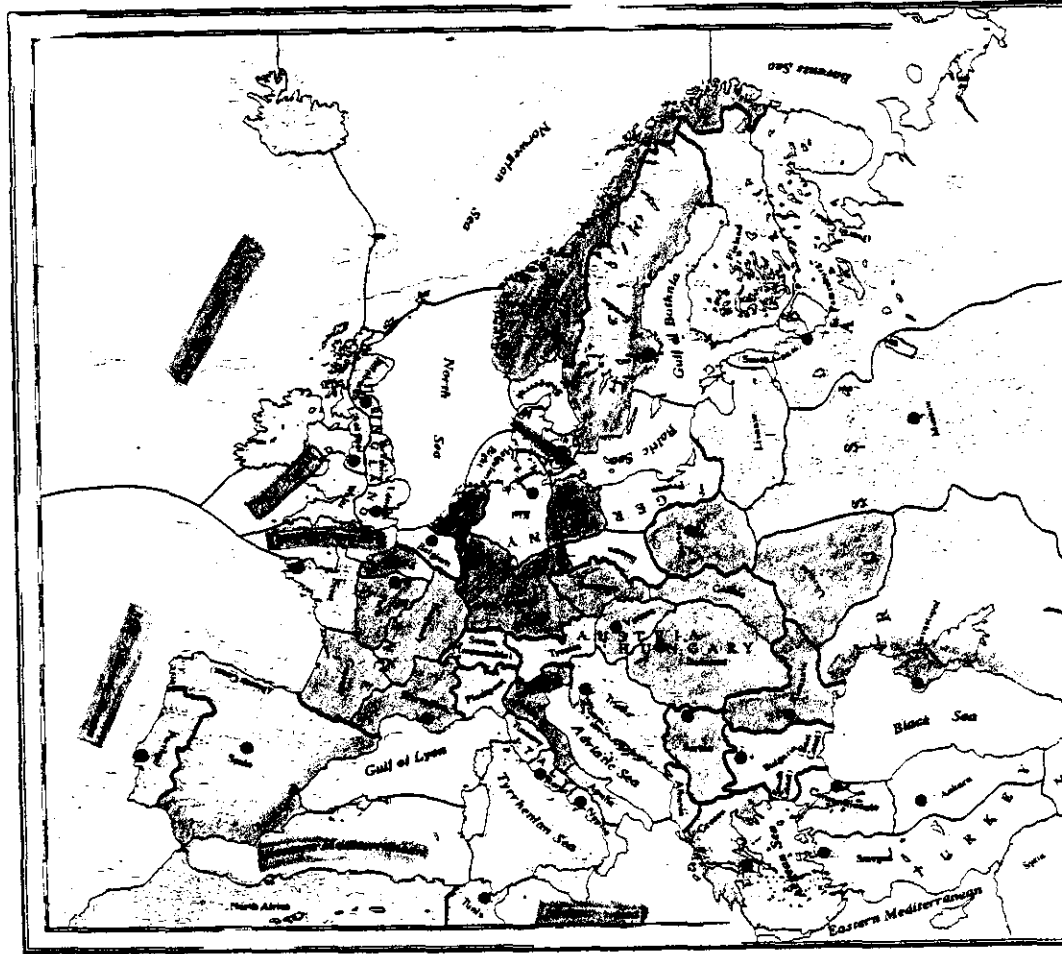

 Francis the Honest didn't want to go but an English archer named Mark of the Woods

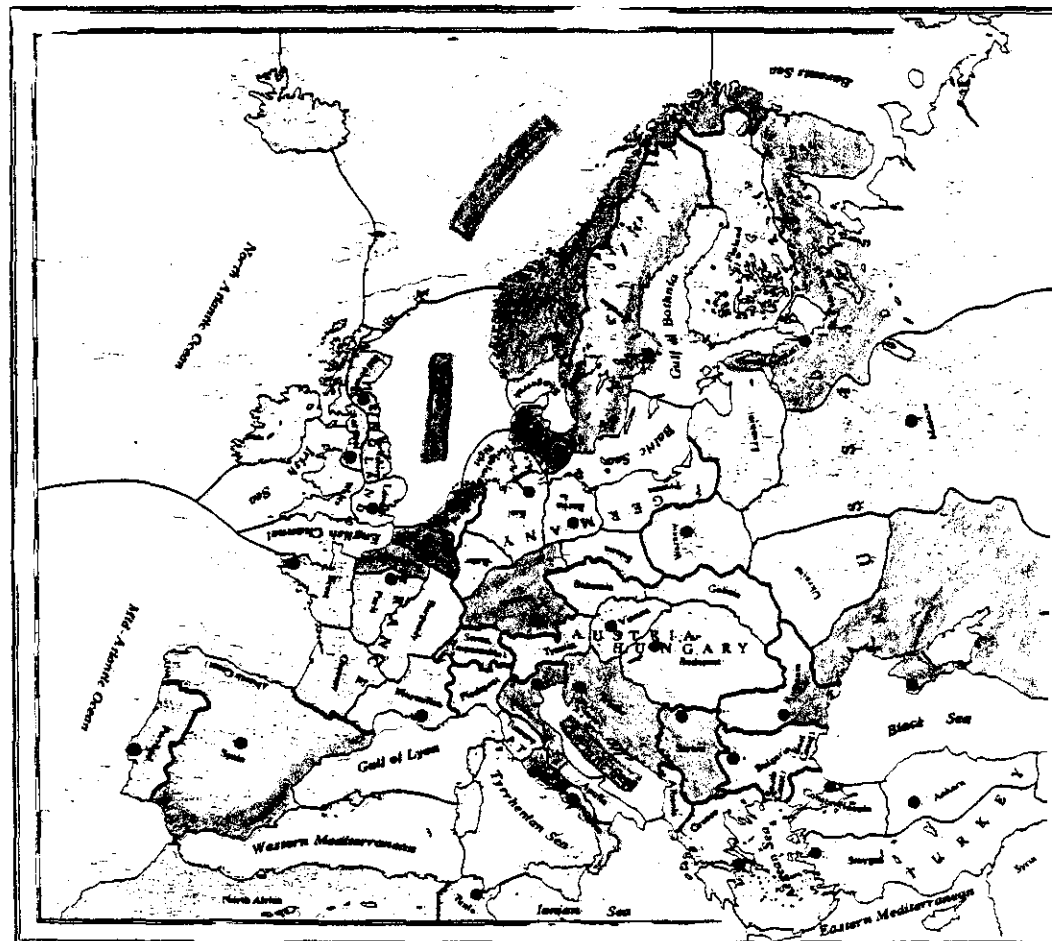
