If the seasons are combined you can make your Spring orders conditional on the other players' Winter builds. By the way, I've been misspelling Blaine's last name - there's no "l".

EMPEROR DAVE to KAISER JOHN: Well done, mon ami! Shall we now go after - how do you say - bigger fish?

BRUSSELS: Amidst the pop of champagne corks and showers of rose petals, advance elements of the French Imperial Army marched into this capital early yesterday. King Leopold himself publicly praised the action, calling the French and their German allies "the glorious defenders of the Low Countries against the ravenous sea-wolves prowling the Channel." In the excitement gripping the capital, few noticed when the Belgian flag atop the Parliament Building was abruptly hauled down and replaced by a Tricolor emblazoned with a black dagger - the imperial standard of Emperor Dave le Dirty.

PARIS to LONDON: Contrition is of little value unless it's timely as well as sincere. I'm not sure yours was either one.

BERLIN: In an enthusiastic and powerful speech to a joint session of the Bundesrat and the Reichstag, the Kaiser has condemned the expansionistic and oppressive policies of Italy, Russia and Turkey. Citing a recently received letter from the conflict area, the women are being driven into the fields and the animals are being raped. The Kaiser was disgusted. The French ambassador was calculating the tax revenue if this mode of entertainment was practiced in Paris.

BERLIN: French envoy has given the Kaiser urgent appeal from Emperor "Dirty Dave." The French have appealed to the German military machine for support. According to sources close to the Kaiser, the Kaiser was elated upon learning that he was granted tax-exempt status at the Parisian bordello and the excitable young Kaiser passed out. Once revived, he promised to push the foreign shopkeepers from the shores of the continent.
