1979IT ENDGAME STATEMENT

GAMEMASTER (John Daly): The game began with wars between Italy and Austria, Russia and Turkey, and England, France and Germany attacked each other. Russia joined the attack on England just as England NMRd in SO2, but Turkish harassment in the south kept Russia from capitalizing on his gains in the north. The European situation was in delicate balance until SO4 when Germany broke through the French lines. By 1905, Germany and Russia were the dominant powers as England and France were crumbling, Italy and Austria were locked in an even battle, and Turkey was making negligible progress against Russia. In 1905 Russia invaded Austria and the southern war became I-R vs. A with Turkey attacking all three of them. Italy and Russia were making progress against Austria and Turkey when Germany attacked Russia in 1908, but Italy attacked Germany at the same time so that as Germany took Warsaw in FO8, Italy took Munich. Italy and Russia combined to reverse Germany's gains in Russia, but just as it looked like Germany was in trouble, Italy attacked Russia in 1910. Russia turned to Turkey for help and together they held Italy back in the south until 1915 when Turkey was eliminated in the Italian assault. Meanwhile in the east, with Russia and Germany distracted by each other, France mobilized his remaining two fleets to eventually join Italy in keeping Germany out of the Med. But when Italy got strong enough to defend the Med by himself he eliminated France and the war continued with only Germany, Italy and Russia left to fight. The three giants shifted alliances and jockeyed for position until the G-I draw was passed in W19.

1979IT (DOGS#2) was begun on November 3, 1979 and was completed on October 26, 1982 with a voted G-I draw in W19. Despite the length of the game, only one standby was used in each of four positions. Stan Johnson and Jake Walters are commended for their game-long commitment. They played their positions for nearly as long as I have been publishing! Steve Heinowski also gets special recognition for playing his French standby position for twelve game years, despite never having more than two centers. Thanks go to Arnold Trembley for holding his Turkish standby position for ten years. And of course congratulations go to Michael Anderson and Stan Johnson for sharing the draw.

Any of the players in this game are welcome to send me endgame statements for publication, if they wish.

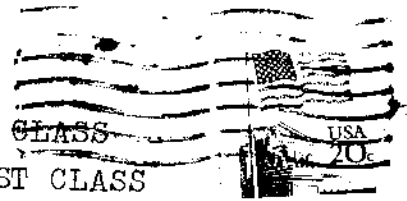
