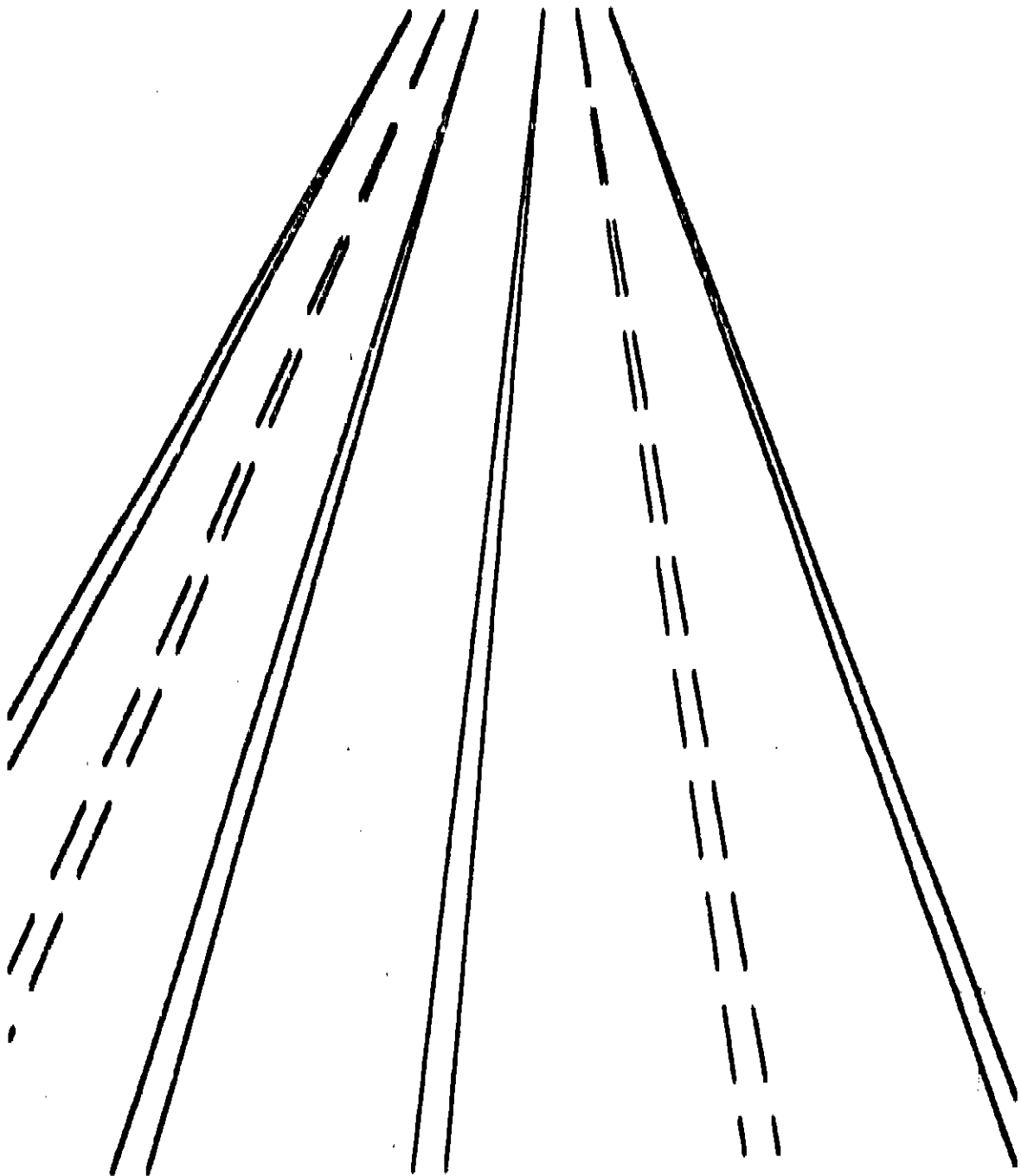

In any event, on to the games.

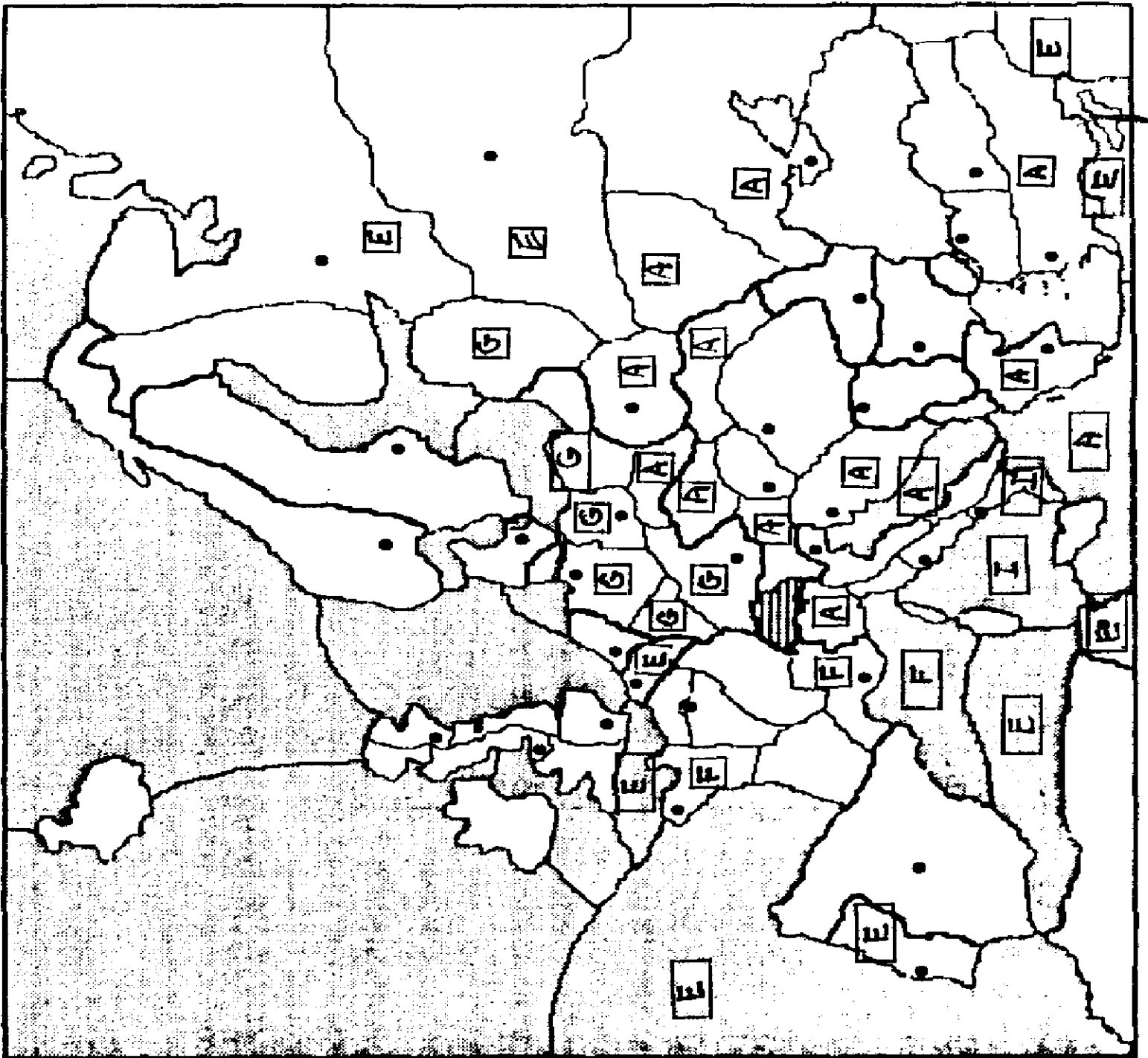

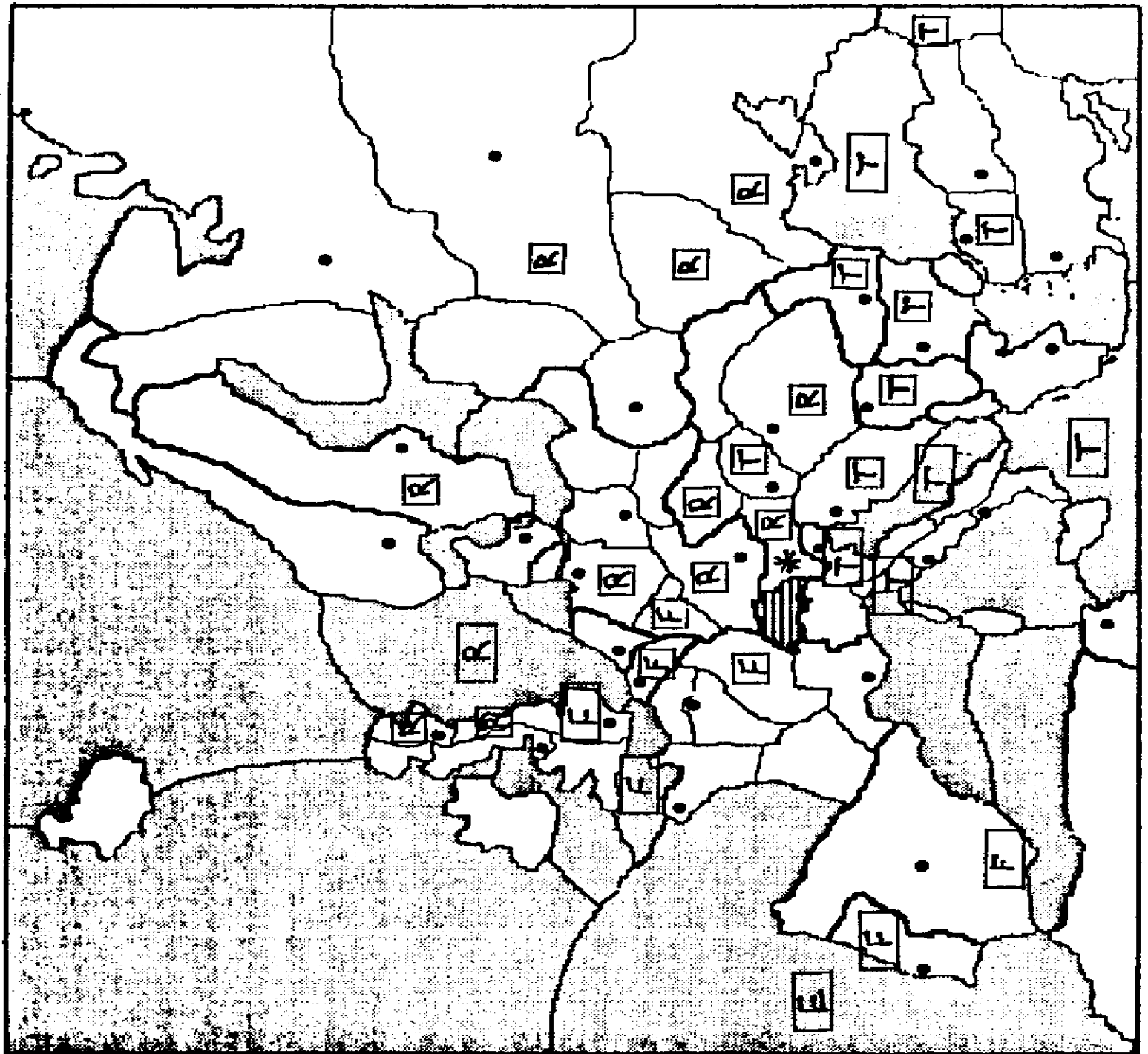

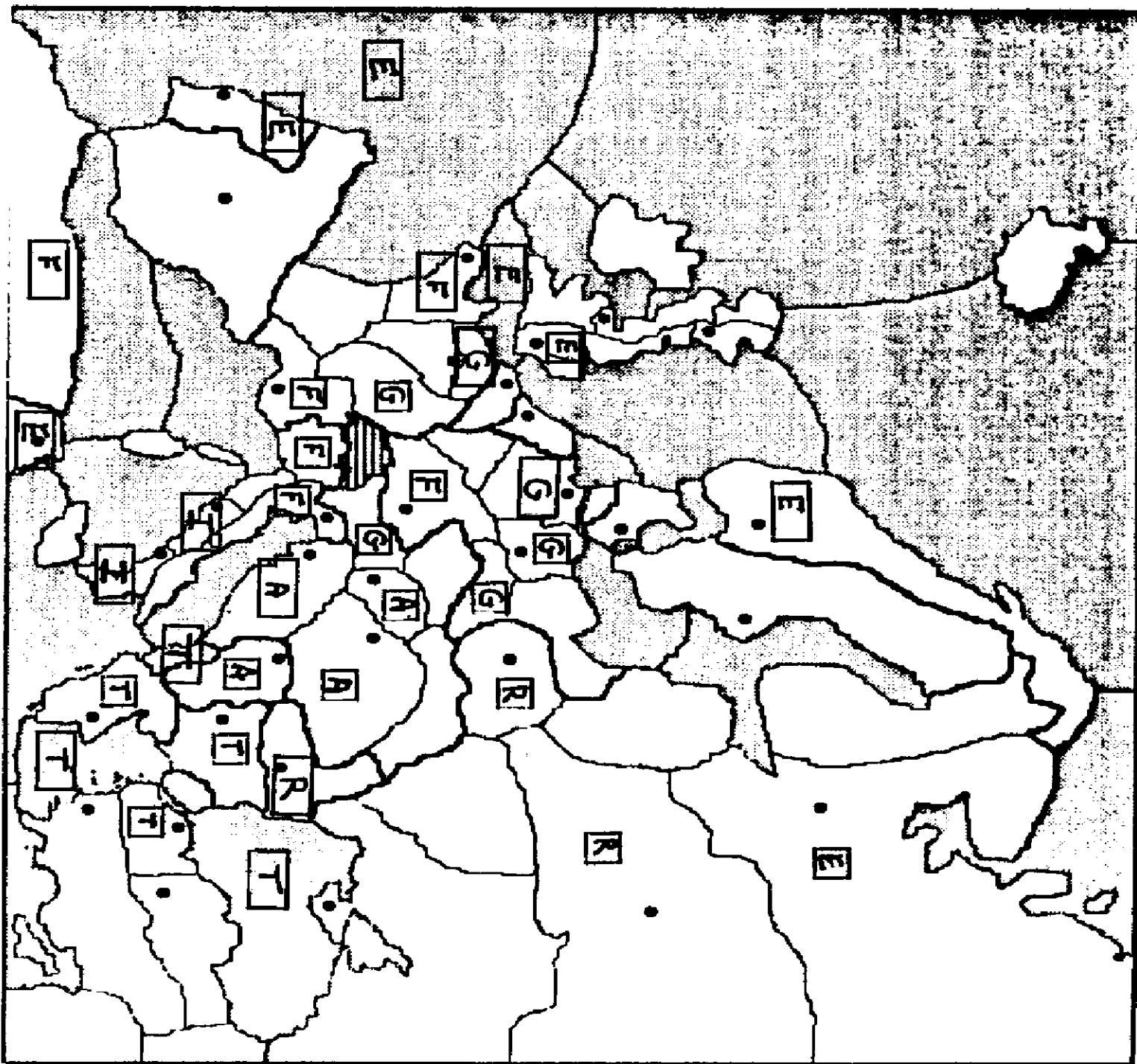


The screws tighten as the giants come to grips. A very active situation in the Balkans as centers shift hands. Can Russia hold on? Will the southern alliance last?

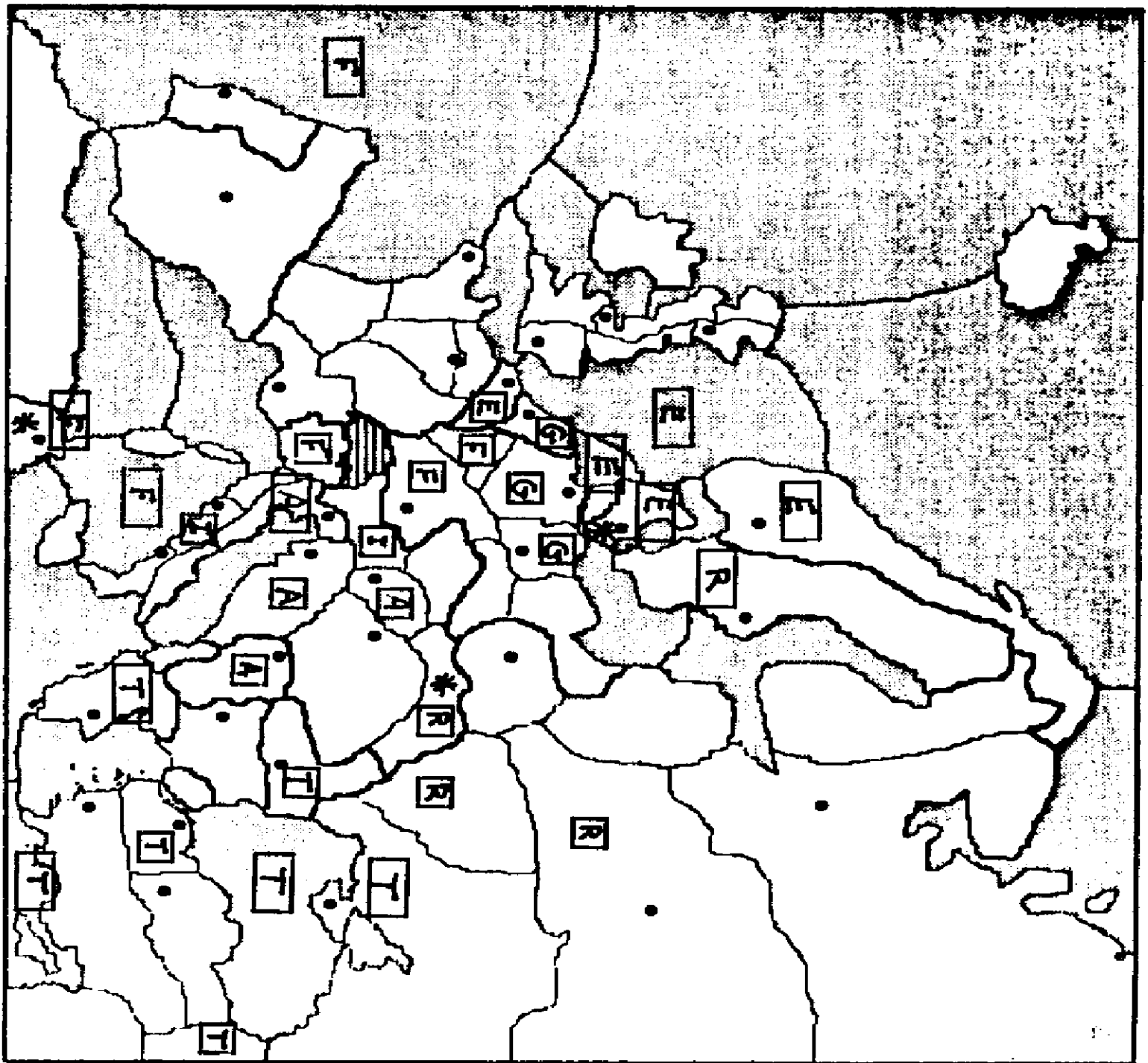
