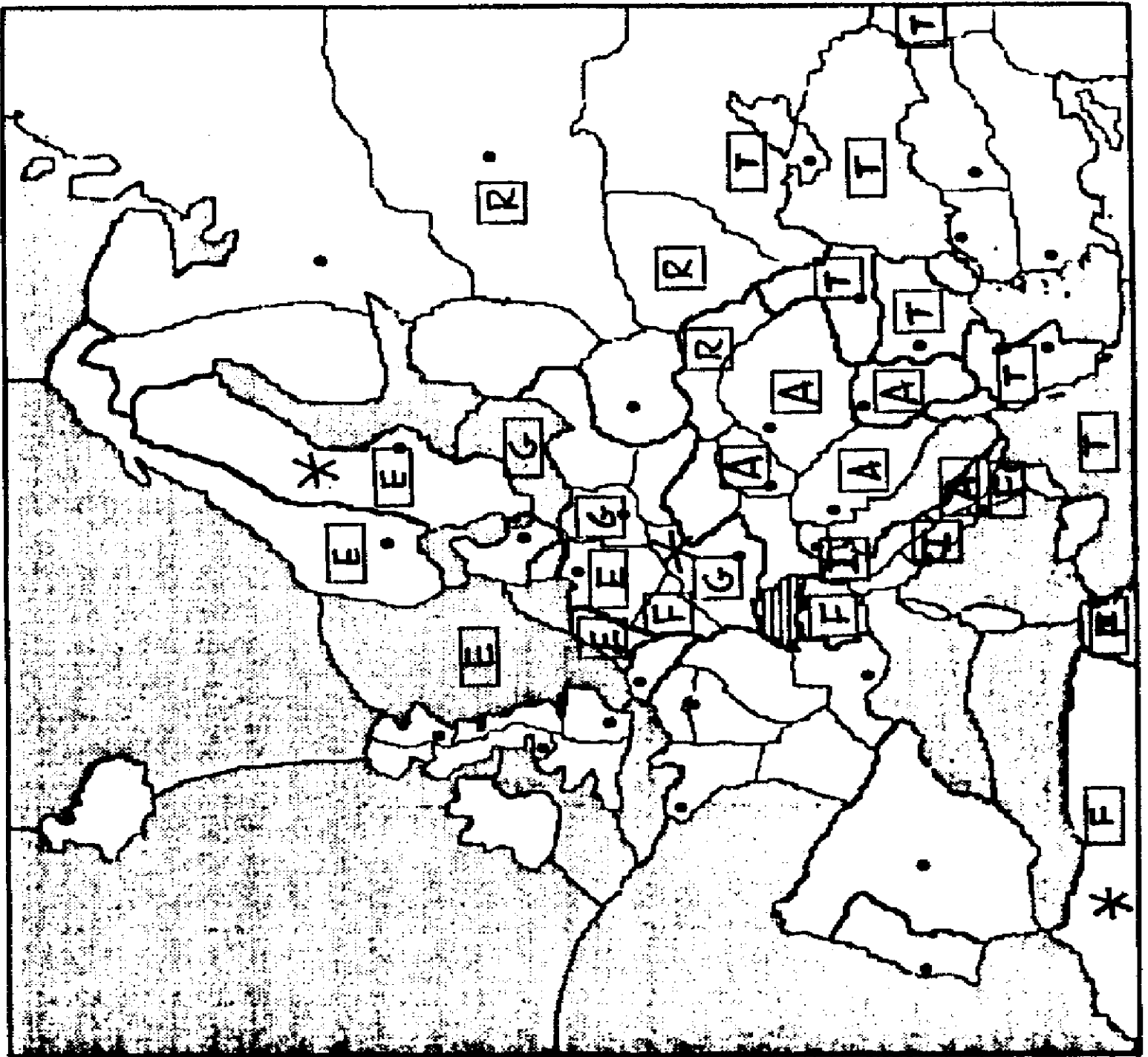


Garden State: 1981HD

Note: An error was made in the adjudication of the last season. The Russian army in Bohemia was correctly reported as supporting his army into Munich, but I incorrectly adjudicated the position as if it was supporting his move into Tyrollia. Thus, the Russian unit did not make it to Tyrollia, and has to retreat to Galicia. Unfortunately, the error was not brought to my attention till the deadline, but I contacted the players (at my own expense) and was able to get updated moves. No-one requested a delay of game.

I was not able to contact the French player to tell him of the error. Normally, this would be enough for me to delay the game until he could be informed of the error and have a chance to revise his moves or request a delay. However, the French player was not only unreachable, but I did not receive any orders or any note from him since the last issue. Thus, the French player would be in a state of NMR, and he had no orders to revise.

I felt that delaying the game to inform the Frenchman was unfair to the other players, since this would effectively give him a chance to undo his NMR. I also felt that proceeding with the game was not unfair to the Frenchman, since he did not get any moves in to me anyway, so his 'moves' are obviously not influenced or affected by the incorrect information. Thus, the game proceeds.

No standby is being called for Dave since this is a 'no-standby' game.

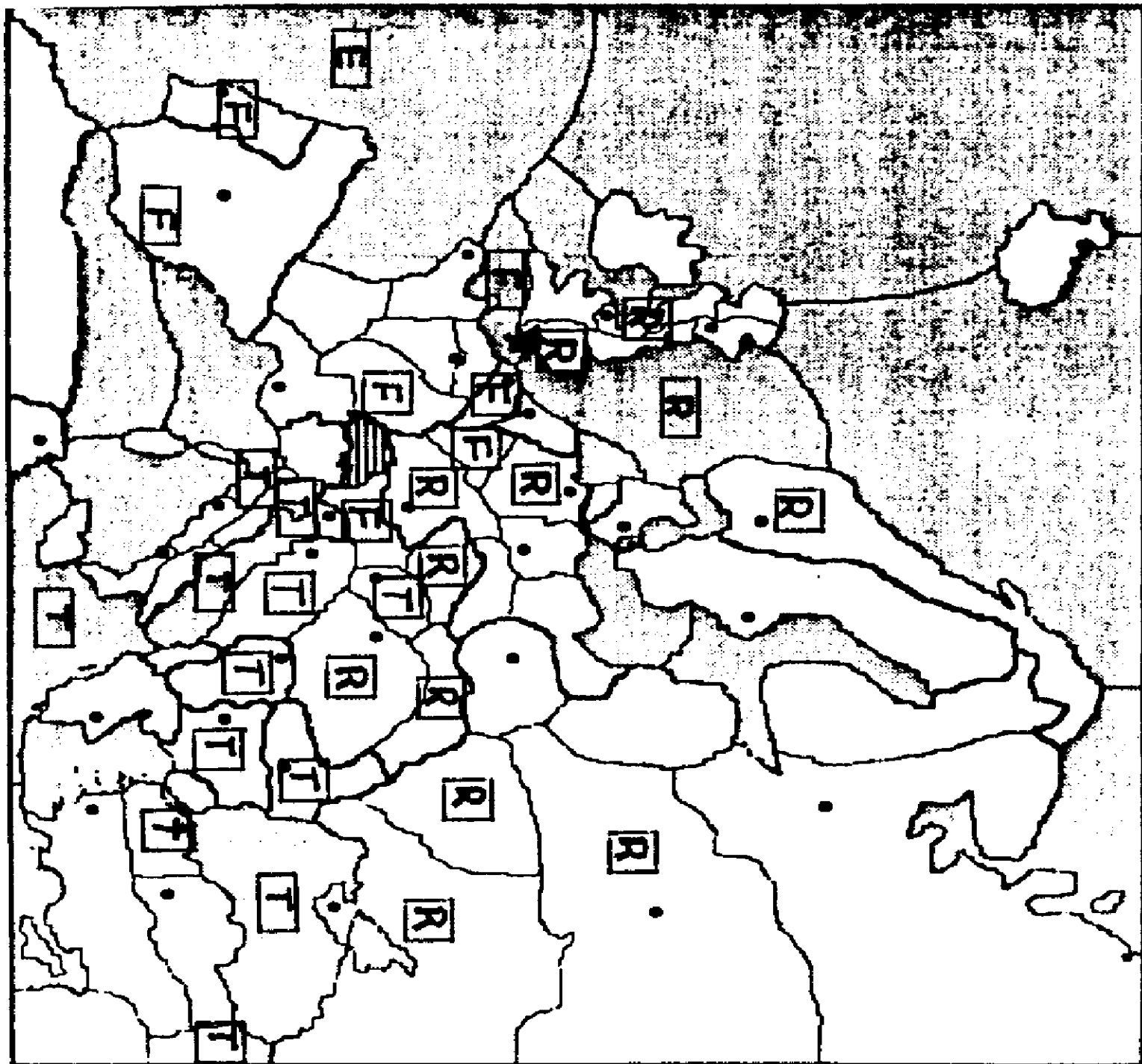

GM-France: You may well be right. As an outside observer, I can only comment on the tactical play, not on any diplomacy that might be going on. The most brilliant stab can be a stupid move if it causes the rest of the board to unite and destroy you. However, my comment remains. It was a very good stab.

France-GM: I'm protesting Bull Hugh. Three players are now within 15 miles of each other, putting the rest of us at a big disadvantage.

GM-France: I understand your concern. When I asked Bill to stand by, I had forgotten that Kevin has moved out there. Unfortunately, my standby list is short right now, so I'm afraid I will have to let it stand. However, I do not think that it is quite as bad as you seem to think. Their zip codes are certainly not that close (92 for Bill Hugh vs 90 for Kevin and Bruce).

France-Germany: No wonder you've never gotten above centers in any game. The two games I've been in with you show why. In one game you stick to an alliance that did you no good. In another your paranoia slowed down a good alliance and your stab helped you the least.

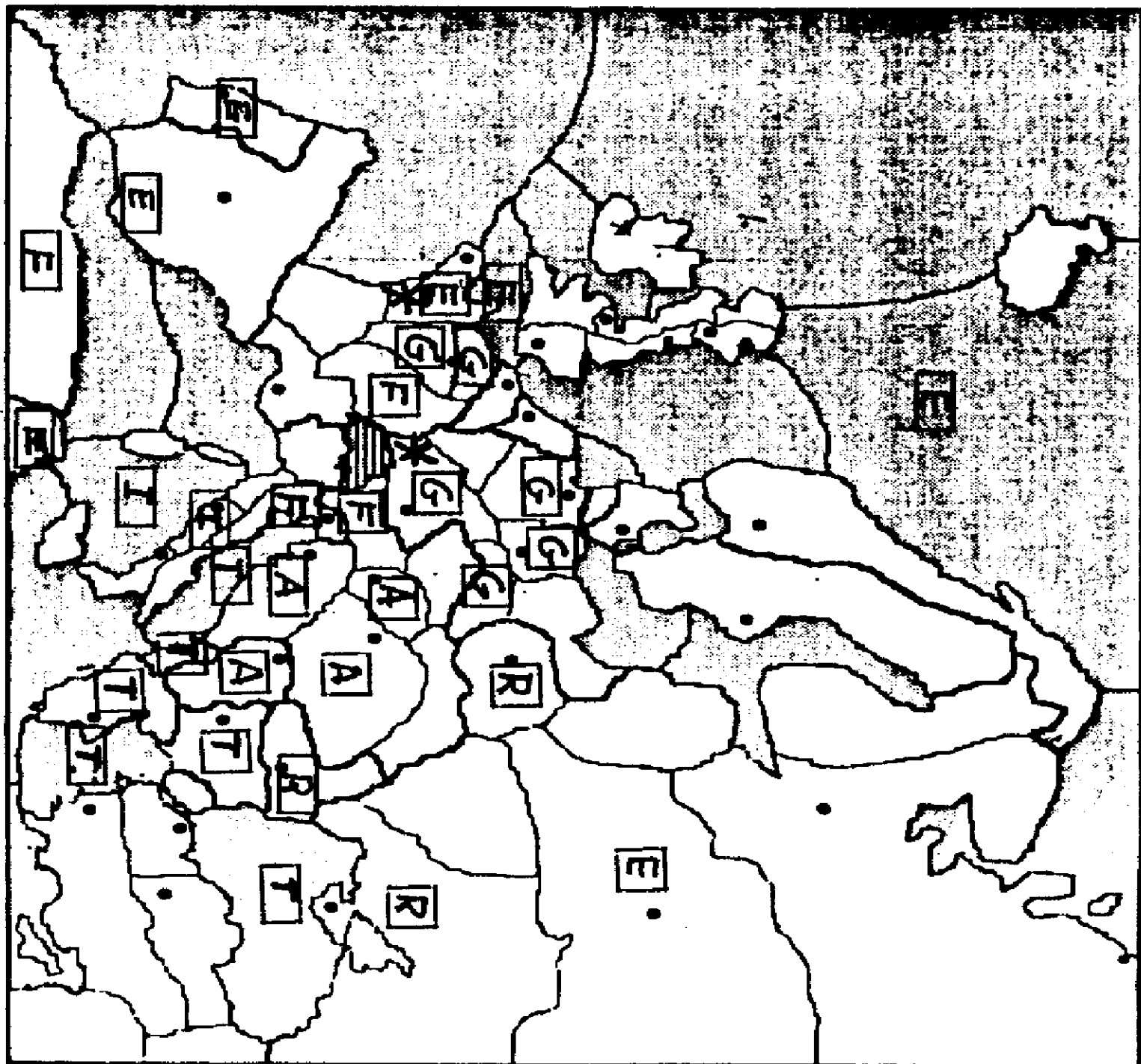

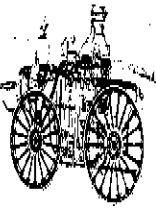
