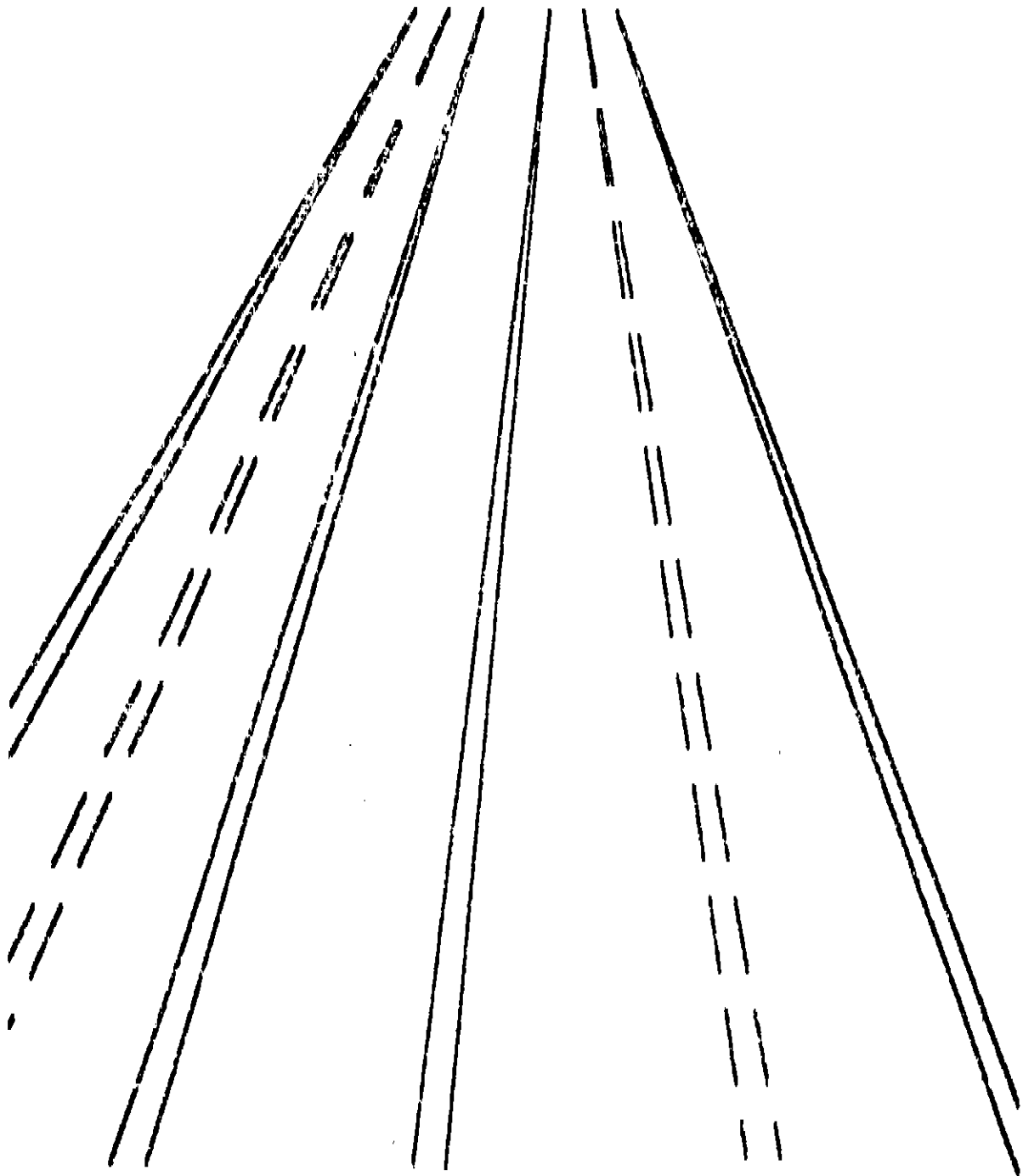

Ramblings

It's been quite a while since I have rambled on, but I have much to say this time, so here goes.

SUB RATES: As I mentioned last page, sub rates are reduced to 25 cents per issue, effective immediately. The sub rate will remain at this level unless DH grows to it's former size again. You are getting a warehouse zine at this point, so here's a warehouse price. To those people who are trading with me, if you want to continue to get DH, fine and dandy, but I certainly won't be insulted if you take your time and money elsewhere. For the present, new trades and subbers are not being encouraged.

ORIGINS: Arye and I went to Origins and had a pretty good time. This year I avoided the Fantasy Role Playing games (after some abysmal experiences at GenCon last year) and concentrated on Diplomacy (pick up games and the tournament) and playing Tiddlywinks. I also managed to get in a small amount of sightseeing. (I HIGHLY recommend seeing the Washington Temple to anyone who gets into the DC area. The Mormon Church has justified itself with that single piece of architecture alone. I have never seen any man-made structure that came close to combining the sheer impressiveness, beauty, and glory of the Washington Temple.)

I didn't do too bad in Diplocon. I got a two-way draw in the first round as France. The second round I got part of a 5-way draw as Turkey, despite being on the same board as "Liar Pearson". The second game was not as much fun as the first, though. The time constraints let to people looking to who could be cut out of the draw before the clock ran out rather than long-range goals. However, all in all I must applaud the "Committee of 1/2/3" and especially Mark Berch for a tournament well run. I have now run in tournaments under Berch, Robert Sacks (GenCon), and Jim Bumpus (Pacificon). I would rate them Diplocon (best), Pacificon, GenCon (pretty bad).

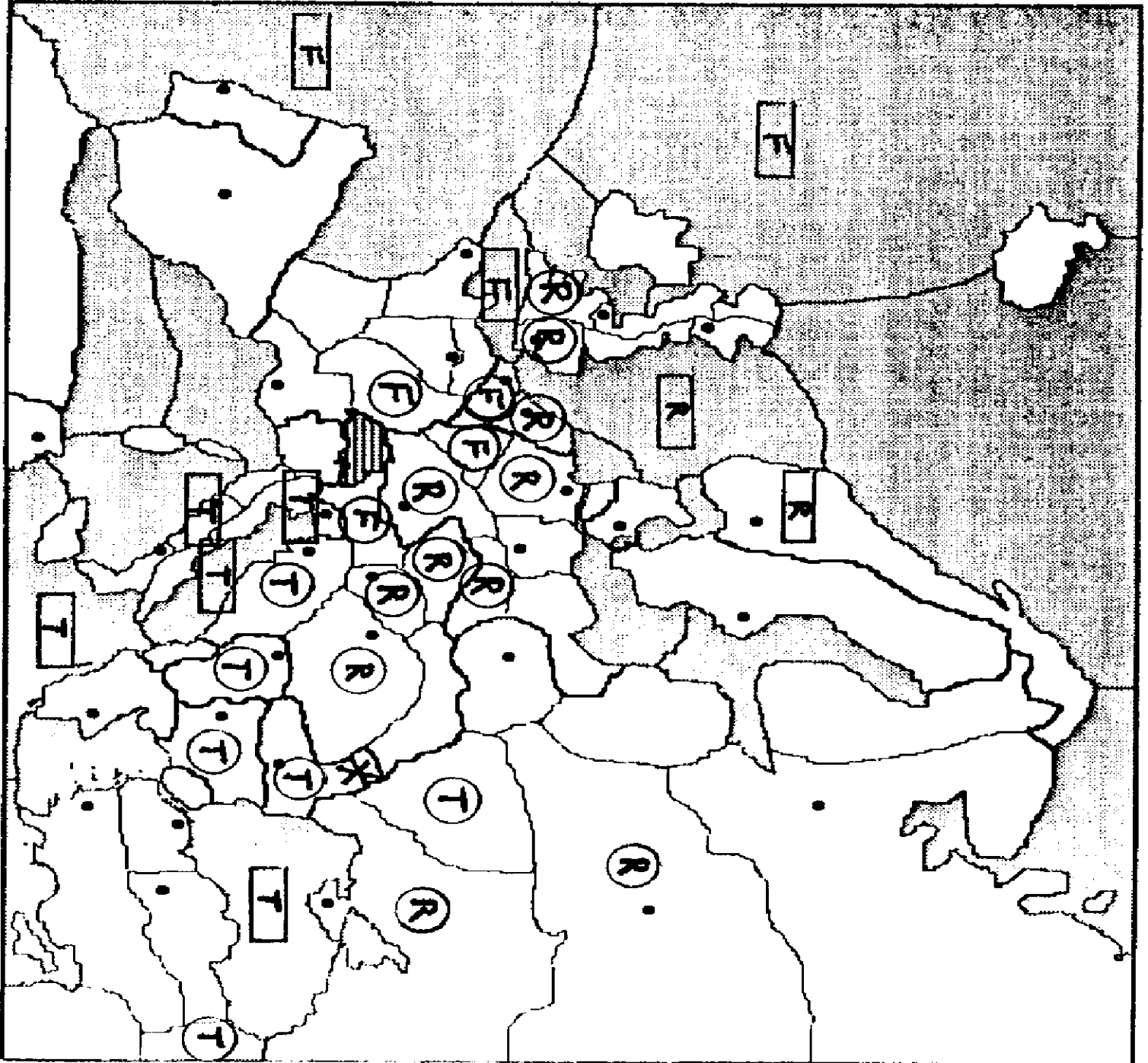

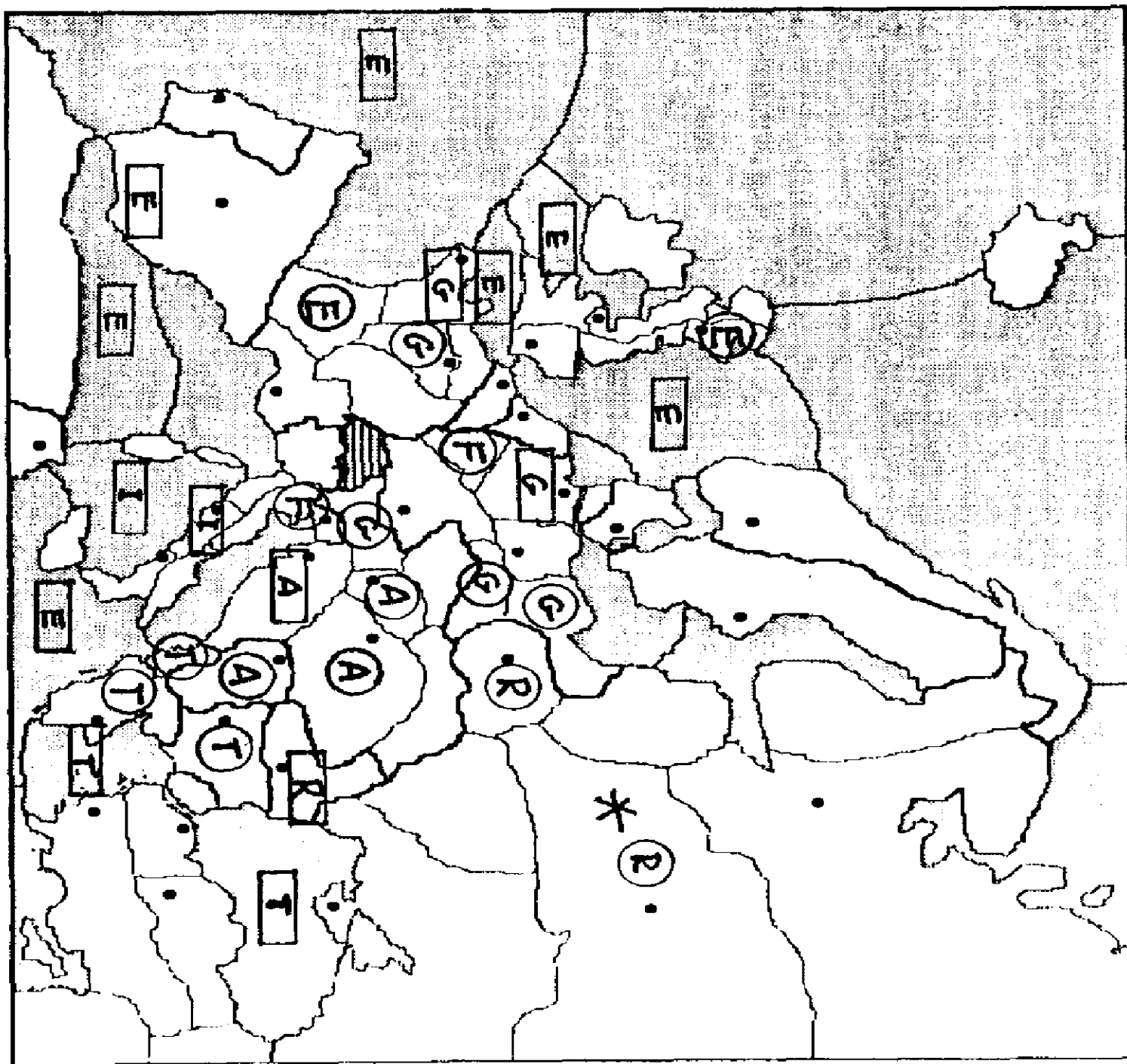
NOTE: I realize that this standby is yet another person from California. However, I am short enough on standbys that I no longer have the luxury of selecting them by region. Sorry.

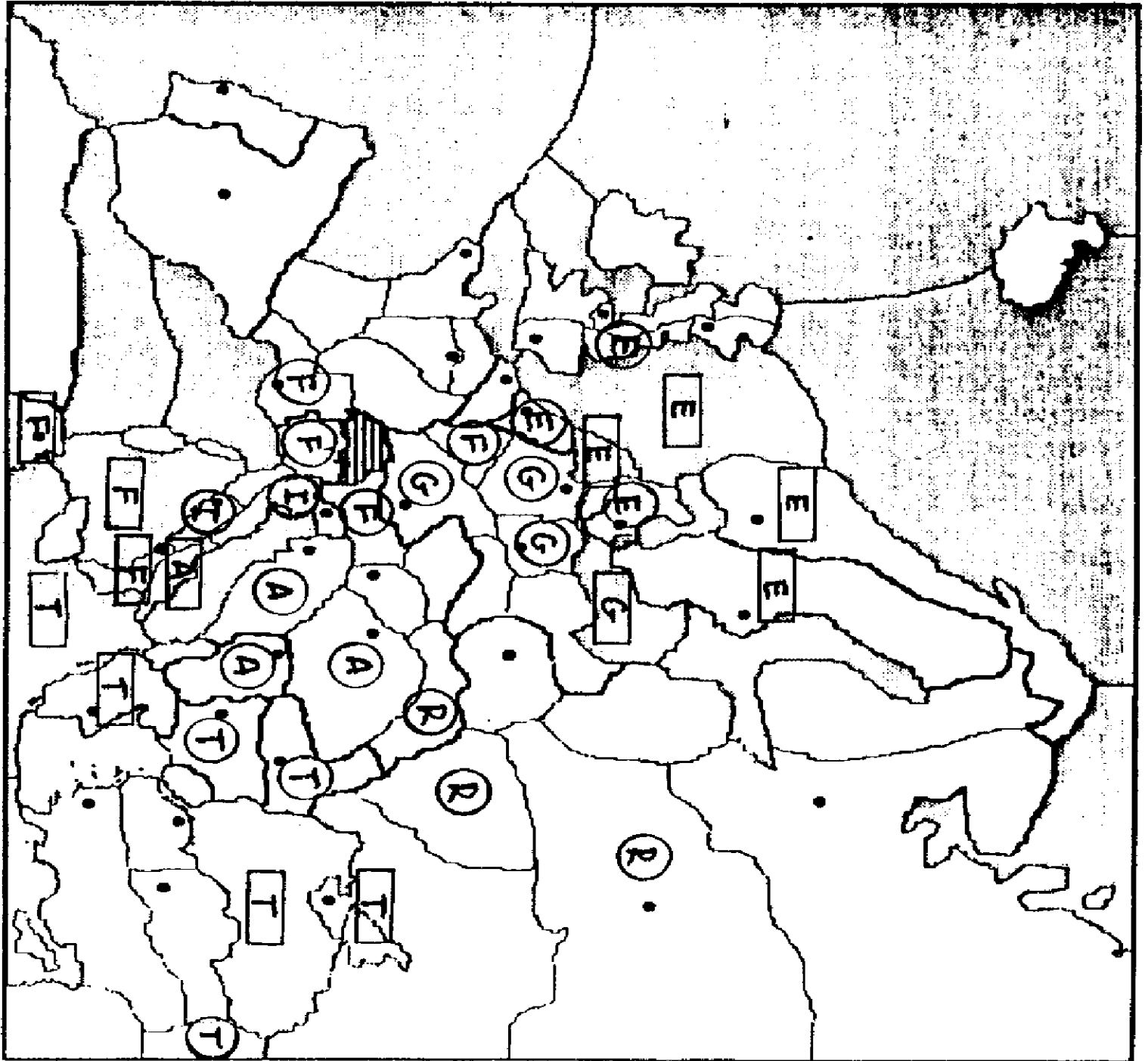

Germany-World: I regret that I have but one life ...

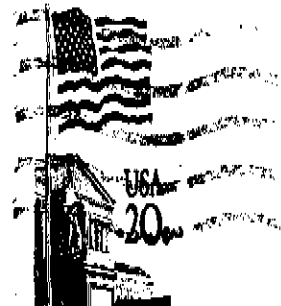
