BUT ONLY BECAUSE MY BRAKES ARE DEFECTIVE. I never really wanted, or expected, to get involved in any controversy in the pages of <u>East of Eden</u>, but my reporting of news items has seemed to generate a bit.

In Issue #5 (April 8th) I stated that <u>Tetracuspid</u> (a 'zine published by Richard Kovalcik, Ir.) was running late and may be in trouble. I stated that I saw these as real danger signs for the 'zine. I did not report the death of the 'zine. This engendered this letter from Kovalcik, however:

"Dear Jack,

re: Tetracuspid Folding, Hobby Ethics

I am somewhat shocked and distressed to hear (second hand) that you reported the death of <u>Tetracuspid</u> in <u>East of Eden</u> #5. This is not true. By now, you should have received the <u>Tetracuspid</u> #54, dated May 11th 1981.

I don't know what prompted you to print that incorrect information about the <u>Tetracuspid</u>. It strikes me as poor journalism. I would appreciate it if you were more careful in the future.

Furthermore when you print something about someone in a zine, hobby ethics dictate that you send him a copy of that issue.

In closing, I would like to say that ((Well the rest is really not pertinent to the matter at hand--jhm))

Well Richard, as I stated in the introductory paragraph, I did not say that Tetracuspid had folded but said that it was in trouble. Lets look at the record:

December 8th, 1980 -- Tetracuspid #53 was due.

February 9th, 1981--Tetracuspid #53 was dated and mailed out --two months and a day late. There was a brief explanation for the delay and the statement that it would never happen again.

March 9th, 1981--Tetracuspid #54 due.

- April 8th, 1981--<u>Tetracuspid</u> #54 now a month late. Announcement in <u>ast of Eden that Tetracuspid</u> had been running late and may be in trouble.
- May 18th, 1981--<u>Tetracuspid</u> #54 arrives, over 70 days late.

 No explanation.

Hopefully Kovalcik has his problems solved and <u>Tetracuspid</u> will once again become punctial. I hope so. But in the meantime I cannot recommend it as a 'zine for anybody to start a game in. Prior to December 1980, <u>Tetracuspid</u> had been rather punctial for about 15 months—but before that it had been plagued by sporadic publication.

In the 1980 Leeder Poll of Zines and Gamemasters Tetracuspid ranked 45 out of 52 'zines with a score of 4.33. And 24 people voted, so you can't chalk it up to a couple of grudge votes. Although a bit monotonous and drab in content, Tetracuspid has always been a cleanly printed piece of work that I didn't think deserved a mark that low. The low mark probably coming from reservations about the lapses in publication.

As for Gamemasters, Kovalcik was in dead last (50th) place last year with a mark of 2.83. Sim people voted. I was one of the six and, as Richard already knows, I gave him a 3--higher than the average of the other five. My vote to Kovalcik was lower than any other GM that I voted on and was a result of the very poor judgement he used in handling 79KR--allowing two seasons to be replayed, without the approval of all players, in order for one player to make up for an NMR.

As for the 1981 poll. To set the record straight I have voted Tetracuspid a 5. I will not be voting for Kovalcik as a Gamemaster.

PASSCHENDAELE FOLDING?

Word, from Steve Colombo is that <u>Passchendaele</u> is folding. This is one that I never received. If the word turns out not to be true—don't blame me! Canadian zines have had a hard time of it this year. This will leave only <u>Runestone</u>, <u>Fol Si Fie</u>, <u>Snafu</u> and <u>Sleepless Knights</u> coming out of Canada. The last two of these are brand new, but <u>Sleepless Knights</u> is going to be a real good one.
