This issue of <u>Fast of Eden</u> is being mailed about one week after the game deadline. For many 'zines this would not be an unusual delay, but it is the first time that Diplomacy adjudications in <u>Black Frog/East of Eden</u> have not been mailed within 48 hours of the deadline.

I have always felt that the span between deadlines should be spent in negotiating and not in waiting for adjudications. As a postal player I have always appreciated, but have seldom gotten, quick turn arounds by the G.M. Because of this, I have always sought to provide quick turnarounds in the games I am CMing.

For these reasons I am very sorry about the delay this time. But I have gradually come to realize that most of the subbers to my 'zines really don't give a damn-so why should I?

This has been an extremely busy month for me. I missed out on a vacation that I had been looking forward to for a long time. Instead of it I have had a very hectic workschedule at Lockheed working on a bid for an important bid for a \$500,000 NASA contract. I have also had a medical problem that has required a lot of attention and lab tests—but, as I have recently learned, will not require surgery in the immediate future. Also I have been making preparations for my son, who normally lives with his mother, to live here for the summer. This has taken quite a bit of preparation.

But none of the above situations have had anything to do with the reason for the delay in this issue of <u>EoE</u>. The reason lies in my present attitude toward the postal Diplomacy hobby. It has bottomed out at absolute zero (0). To be very truthful I almost think that the best thing for me right now would be to load my Diplomacy set and all the game files into the trash can and to forget that I ever had anything to do with postal Diplomacy.

But I won't. I know that my spirits will eventually pick up. And, I live up to my respnsibilities. I have a commitment and a responsibility to complete all the games that I have started as a gamemaster or as a player. And I will! But I am, as of right now, going to curtail my involvement in the hobby in many ways.

Postal Diplomacy is a hobby. A hobby is an endeavor to be pursued for personal pleasure or enjoyment. Well, I have greatly enjoyed my involvement in this hobby up to a point. Up to a point where I have failed in one important objective:

I honestly thought that I could publish a light controversy free 'zine. That I could stick to humor and stay clear of controversy and dispute. I haven't been able to do this. All of a sudden I have all kinds of crap coming down on me rather hard:

(1.) McLendon. Issue #35 of Black Frog was the Black Jack Awards issue, mailed out on February 14th, 1981. Naive as I was, I actually intended that the issue would create good will in the hobby for myself and Black Frog. However, in a section clearly entitled "games" I cited 1980AN as my least favorite game. And then gave a reason for citing it as such. "It was a Steve McLendon/Bob Sergeant alliance game and I had been game long without any ally, with virtually no correspondence." I certainly didn't, or at least didn't intend to, implicate Steve McLendon for any kind of wrong doing.

Lee Kendter, Sr., who I have always had a great deal of respect for (in the very same issue of Black Frog I gave him a "very special citation" as "the single most important person in the hobby today") first picked up on this and wrote me in regards to my comments on 1980AN. I regarded Lee's letter as inquisitive and not hostile. I wrote back to Lee and simply stated that that the game was not enjoyable to me at all because of the alliance structure and lack of communication, but that I certainly had not intended my statement to be construed as making charges or indictments of anybody—most certainly not him. (..Would I have given him the special citation mentioned above, if had been charging him with mis-running 1980AN?)

Well, I thought the matter had ended there, but wrong again. Apparently Kendter wrote the other players in the game (including McLendon) and, in the words of McLendon "Lee Kendter was rather furious...and...asked me ((McLendon)) if I was going to do anything about it."

Well, McLendon did something about it. Not only did he castigate me in an editorial in <u>Dragon and the Lamb</u> (#54, 27 May 1981) but he has apparently launched a personal vendetta against me in the hobby.

About three weeks before <u>D&L</u> came out, I talked to Steve via phone and he confronted me with the question. At that time I told him that he misunderstood my intention in the comments and apologized to him.

But in closing his editorial in <u>D&L</u>, he states: "I call upon Masters to either present evidence to backup his charge or to print a retraction and an apology."

Well Steve, I didn't make any charges (or at least I didn't intend to) so I find it rather impossible to present evidence to back up charges that I didn't make. I will and do apologize for any misunderstanding that may have resulted from the way my statements were worded. As for a retraction: 1980AN always has been and always will be my least favorite game—even more so now—this is the statement that I made and will not retract.

(2.) Oaklyn. Ever since I first heard the name Bernie Oaklyn, I never once doubted that he was indeed Buddy Tretick or that he was guilty of at least 90% of the charges levied against him. But I have been more or less soft on him-up until now that is. By being soft on him I simply avoided comments in his regard in Black Frog and I exchanged mutual subscriptions with him (not a trade-he paid for my zine and I paid for his). But I refused him the right to play in a Black Frog game and I refused to play one in Le Front (although Bernie once listed me as being signed up for a game-without my knowledge or consent.)

I stopped receiving Le Front as of the January issue and, since I had paid for a sub and expected to receive issues if they were being printed, I thought it was dead. Fat chance. Bernie simply cut my sub, without even informing me. Not only has he cut it but he and his cohorts (Ozog, Kovalcik and Kozlowski to mention a few) have started a vendetta against me. No big deal (unlike Kendter, McLendon and ergeant—whom I have always held in high esteem) I have never liked any of the Oaklyn gang anyway.

It seems that the Oaklyn vendetta is the result of wrongdoings that I am alledged of committing against his chief lieutenant, Eric Ozog.... read on:

Since he had missed the deadline on my double-money back offer and since the cost of printing and mailing the issues that he had received exceeded the amount of his donation. He got no refund.

Well I understand Ozog is back in the hobby and once again pushing his 'zine <u>Diplomacy by Moonlight</u>. He has not sent me copies, but I understand that he has been blasting me pretty heavily (I have learned this through secondary sources). (I have written a letter to Brutus <u>Bulletin</u> that delves into Mr. Ozog in greater detail if anybody is interested.)

(4.) John Caruso. In Whitestonia #36 (June 2nd, 1981) John Caruso has seen fit to spike many little digs in my regard. All are harmless except for one thing. On page 7 he fabricates a quote that he claims came from me. "That Caruso doesn't have the brains God gave a retarded goose!"

John claims that this is a statement that I made about him in another 'zine but he "can't remember the zine".

Well John this is an out and out lie. I have never made such a statement and it is completely out of character for me to write things like that. Will you please print a retraction, or (which you will be unable to do) produce the 'zine where I made such a statement!

(5.) Mark Lew. Well Mark Lew is a long long story and I will not go into it here. Suffice it to say that I am not at all happy with him. nor he with me.
