CONCESSION TO ITALY PASSES....1980ID becomes first game to end of those started in BLACK FROG .... CONGRATUL-ATIONS TO BILL SCHIWAUTZ!!!

The Italian concession passed with no opposition. Actually only Italy and England voted for it. Germany abstained while no orders were received for Russia or Turkey. A game wrap up will be published within the next month-end game statements from all players are in order.

On another note, orders from Turkey were received for F'06, but a day after the deadline. They were post-marked four days before the deadline, so normally they would have been received in time (perhaps the air-traffic controllers strike is slowing down cross-country mail). They would have made a difference in 1906 and saved one Turkish center from Russia, but in the long run it is unlikely that they would have made any real difference in the game.
