A CORRECTION! Somehow the Turkish orders were given twice (the 2nd time in place of French orders) with the last adjudications—and NO CORRECT French orders recorded. Here they are:

Correct orders for other Great Powers remain as recorded in Black Frog #56, page 8.

The deadline for F'06 remains December 8th, 1981 at 12:00 noon PST.

A question was raised about deadlines in this game. After 1902, deadlines were supposed to be three weeks apart. Winter and (sometimes) summer seasons are seperated, but this does not for the purpose of extending the normal spring/fall or fall/spring interval. It is only for the purpose of eliminating conditional orders based upon builds and/or retreats. It is only possible because BF and MoE are published much more frequently than once every three weeks.

If anybody is interested, the mix-up in French/Turkish orders happened because both France and Turkey phoned in their orders and I recorded them both on the same sheet of paper, and then got a bit careless as I was typing them up after adjudication. Sorry if has inconvenienced anybody. The game will be delayed for one week if anybody requests it. I will treat an NMR as a request for a delay.
