

Diplomacy is a multi-player war game invented by Allan B. Calhamer and currently owned by Avalon Hill Co.

I have no idea how much negotiation will take place in this game. I will call the orders for the first round of play on Wednesday April 1st, 1981 at 12:00 noon PST. As the game progresses, please let me know if three week deadlines are about right or if you want them longer or shorter.

FIRST ROUND ATTACKS: A-B; B-C; C-D; D-E; E-F; F-A. All attacks are on the first planet of the respective solar systems (see postal rules.)

Notes:

(1.) Kevin Buckalew is the GM's stepson and lives at the same address. He will have no unfair advantage in this game, but I suggest you send your orders in an envelope and not a post card.

- (2.) Excluding the PARASITE, there are no allies in round 1 of attack. Don't forget to ask for allies for round 1(b) and thereafter.
- (3.) Rule 15 on ALLIES needs a bit of clarification. All players, including the PARASITE, may send their tokens to only one cone as an ally per round of attack.
- (4.) In the case of two players attempting to use the same power (e.g. the SORCEROR and the INSECT) the offensive player has first option at using the power.
- (5.) In any round where the INSECT is attacking or being attacked by the PARASITE, he may use the PARASITE'S power to send tokens anywhere he wants as an ally. In other cases where the INSECT copies his opponents power, he may use that power only against that opponent.
- (6.) For each players convenience and information, a copy of how the Alien Powers were assigned is included with their copy of the zine.

Thank you very much for the "Black Jack Award." It's very much appreciated. I have always enjoyed our FTF get-togethers...... I really enjoyed your last issue and wish other publishers would voice their opinions on their favorite zines, least favorite GM's etc. It makes for very interesting reading. Your awards are the equivalent to baseball's hot stove league. A loyal fan voicing his opinion and backing it up. Enclosed you'll find another donation for BF.

Our Diplomacy outing in Sacramento was interesting. ((Al is referring to the St. Valentine's Day Massacre at the Games People Play Store.)) I would classify the competition about the same as PACIFICON. The players are generally inexperienced and Immature. The Tourney was spoiled by the contestants playing the scoring system rather than the game. To be quite frank I really don't know if I will play in many more DIP tourneys. There are so few players that I enjoy gaming with that it can often be a more frustrating experience rather than a fun one. Both Ron and I ((Ron Brown)) wish you would have been there, we both missed you. Don't mention this to Grabar ((Dave Grabar, and I am afraid I just have Al)) but from now on I am going to make it a requirement to attack him first. That sucker is so damn unpredictable that you're asking for trouble when you let him live. A few parting comments on the tourney. The scoring system was interesting (I've enclosed the tourney rules) especially the part about being penalized. Both Ron and I were docked points for infractions. Once I was talking to another player during a retreat seäson, which is in violation of the rules, and was docked. Our conversation had nothing to do with the retreat, but I was docked like a school boy talking when he should be listening. Docked points for talking! Hard to believe!

I've dropped out of all but about four games now. Now I can get back to staying on top of those games the way a person should. In fact if things work out, I may even try to start another game later this year. It was getting so bad, my being overwhelmed, that I chose simply to ignore all DIP. It's a miracle that I'm in any games at all. Sorry that I NMR'd in BF, it will not happen again. I hope that I'm still welcome to start another game with BF should the opportunity arise.

Both Tom Heflin and myself were happy to read you've decided to try a game of COSMIC in <u>BF</u>. Please sign both Tom and myself up. I'm anxious to start and look forward to seeing more info in <u>BF</u> soon.

I noticed that the "Big Timer" ((Dan Kuszynski)) got a special citation Golden Frog Award for "Vacation Diplomacy." This bugs me a little bit because the design for VD is almost just as much mine as it is his. I thought of many of the cards and locations of the "vacationing units." I'd appreciate it if when you have the chance that you mention in BF how VD is actually designed by me and was pirated by Dan. That's sure to get his goat! ((This was done last issue and did get Dan's goat.))


