Players comments:

Ben Schilling (Russia): I took over the Russian position in this game as a stand-by in Spring 1907. I had submitted a set of unneeded orders for Russia in Spring 1906 so I was not coming into the game without any information, just nearly so. The only player who seemed interested in any diplomacy was England. Italy never bothered to answer any of my letters and France acknowledged my existence, something he had failed to do in 1980J. I can't say that I enjoyed playing this game, it is supposed to be a game of negotiations and there were very few negotiations going on in this game. My thanks to Kathy Byrne for a very regular correspondence and to the GM, for showing why he ranks number one in the NA GM poll.
