page one will be my column for news, views and comments, but now that the intro is over...

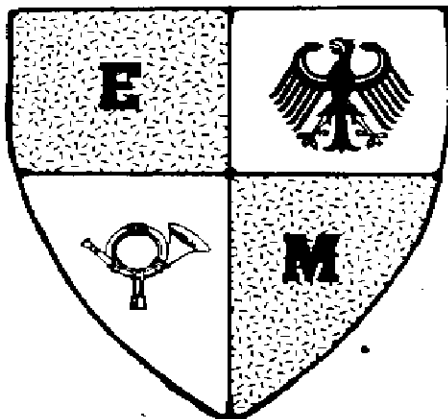



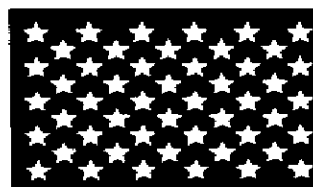

## PROVINCES REAP HARVESTS; SENATE SESSION APPROVED

The traditional harvest festivals are again upon us, and throughout the Empire the people celebrate yet another year of peace and prosperity. Massive stores of food, timber, gold and silver already fill the warehouses of the provincial capitals. Now the Governors face the delicate task of distributing the wealth to their own citizens as well as the open marketplace.

In a related development, the Claudian Export Office of Aegyptus has announced the acquisition of the entire annual allotment of precious metals from the province of Dacia. The transfer of title to these shipments was signed by A. Pompeus Laedar, in his first official act as the new Dacian Governor.

Meanwhile, the City of Rome is buzzing with anticipation of the convening of the Senate, scheduled for the spring of 195. BRIEF BIOGRAPHY OF EMHAIN MACHA.

Emhain Macha (October 29, 1979 - September 22, 1984)

Published 50 issues, only one double issue. Six month sabbatical between issues #26 and #27. First printed in mimeo. Began using both mimeo and spirit circa #22. Issues after #26 are revivals. Began printing in offset digest with issue 30, though spirit and mimeo were still used.

Editor was Michael Mills (Nedrow, NY; Palmyra NY; Macedon NY; Suffern NY; and finally Sloatsburg NY). Subzines were BERSAGLIERI and Keith Mercer's subzine.

Games carried were DIPLOMACY, bourse, S.P.Q.R., and variants like Bhearna Baoghail. Other game rules published included JIMMU, later known as KAMAKURA, PATTERSON'S DIPLOMACY (variant), and KONIGREICH. All except bourse and DIPLOMACY designed by Michael Mills.

Began with a slew of orphaned DIPLOMACY games and added EM DIP games as time went on. In all about seven games were played under EM's roof and ended there, most in single player wins.

Other facets of EM were BATTALION BRIEFINGS (Squad Leader), EMPIRE REVIEW (S.P.Q.R. playtest #1), and BREAD AND CIRCUSES (Chuff Afflerbach's GMing of the 3d edition rules of S.P.Q.R.).

PEOPLES' DIPLOMACY ORGANIZATION born in the EM April 1983 edition with the publication of the MANIFESTO OF APRIL 1983. Grew to become the largest organization of its kind in history, complete with legislative, administrative and a judicial component.

THE POMME DE TERRE-TETE LADY OF THE MONTH began its run in EM after the formation of the MR. POTATO HEAD GOOD FRIENDS CLUB and THE ORDER OF POTATOES. Various other P.D.O. groups were started within EM.

For two years EM ran the EMINENT AWARDS, modelled after the U.K. zine awards. This award breaks down zine features and awards certificates for winners.

EM best known for not being "controversial." Never voiced an opinion on the content of feuds, though condemned participants for wasting our time with them.

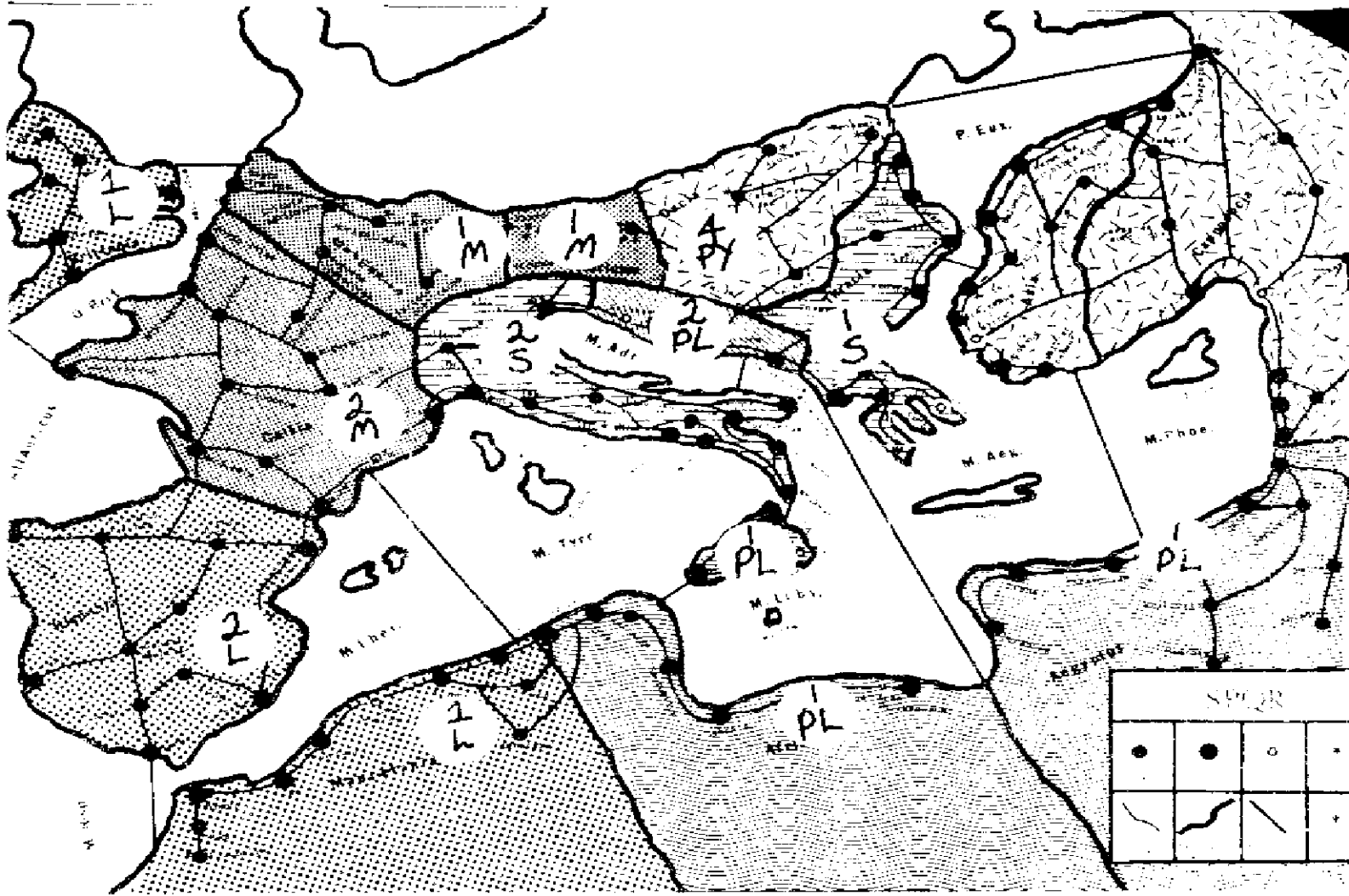
HIGHLIGHTS: EM coaxed and pushed Gary Coughlan into publishing with great results (needed a subzine home). Encouraged the crazy Aunt Tillie to the exasperation of 99.44% of the Hobby. Ignored many people for many, many years to my great satisfaction. Finally learned how to GM DIP in May 1984, to everyone relief. Gave Tom Mainardi's budding BERSGALIERI a start and now it's one of the better East Coast products.

COMMENTS: The favorite zines of EM have always been SLEEPLESS KNIGHTS, EUROPA EXPRESS, SNAFU!, and MURD'REN MINISTERS. The now-defunct RETALIATION and JUST AMONG FRIENDS were always read cover-to-cover. Favorite controversies were "TRO," and "NORTH VS. SOUTH." Hated anything having to do with Linsey et al., or the ones that pitted people involved in the above-named publications against each other.

FUTURE PLANS: To be a subzine in EUROPA EXPRESS and to concentrate solely on multi-player, strategic games, like S.P.Q.R. and KONIGREICH.

NEW NAME: In EUROPA EXPRESS, EMHAIN MACHA will lose its old name and become SAVONLINNA. Both names are those of fortresses, though one was in Ireland, the other in Finland. The tone and content of SAVON. will be different. Voicing opinions and casting dispersions upon the sordid beasts of DIPDOM will be the rule. (EM never did that!)

# Bread & Circuses



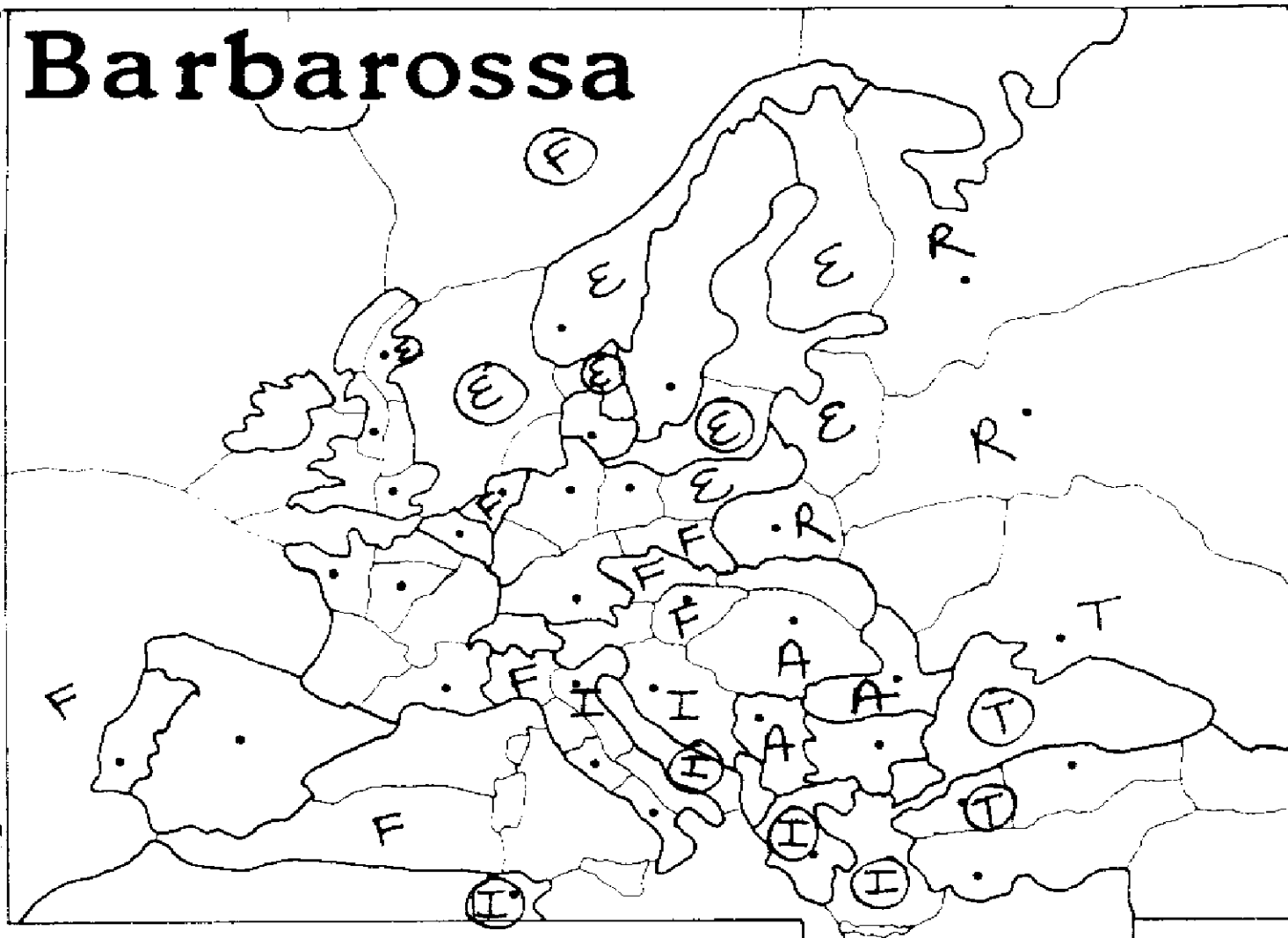

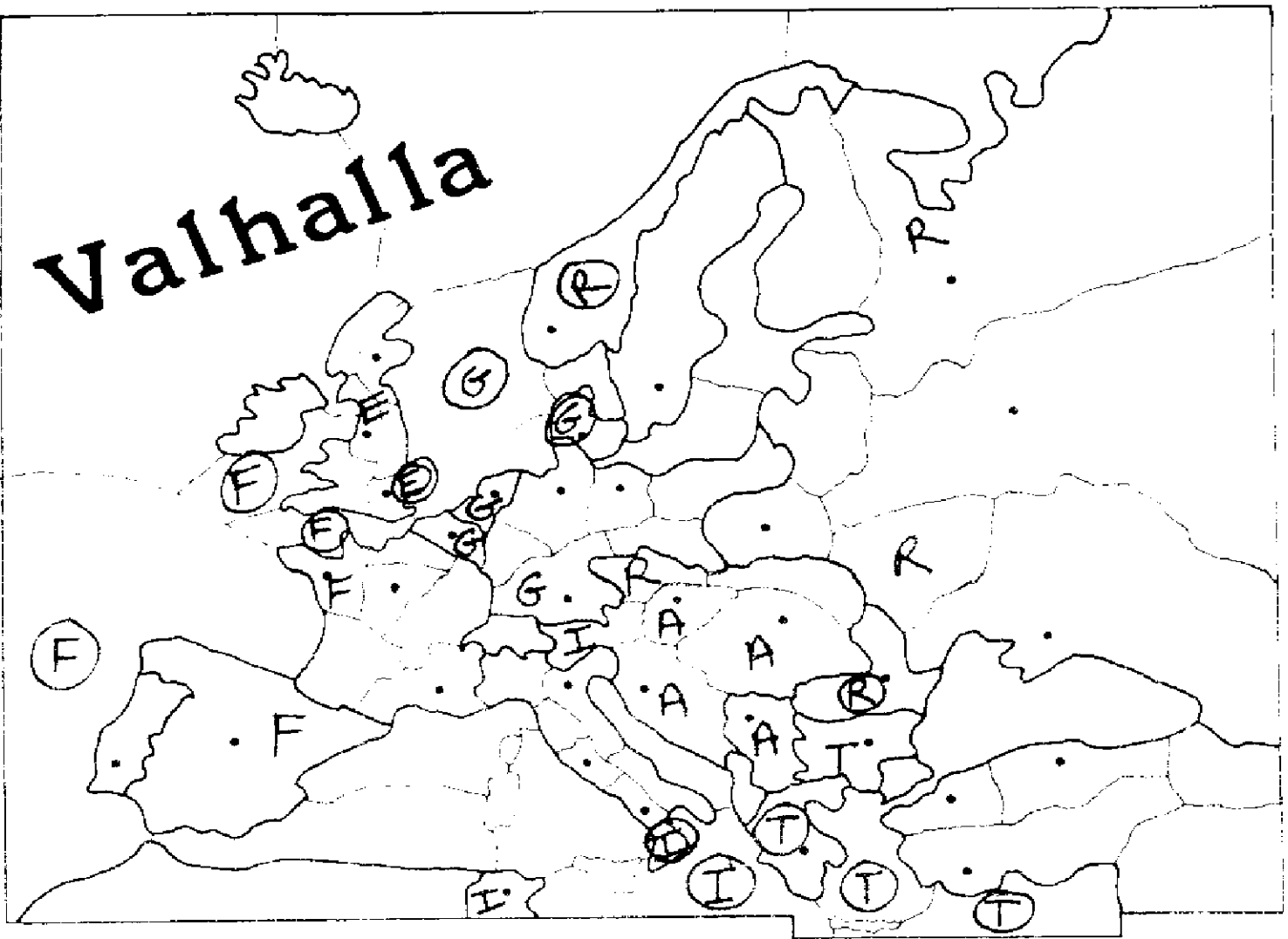

## PARTING SHOTS.

Well, this being the last issue of EM, I thought it appropriate to make a few comments upon some of the more important issues surrounding what we tend to call "the postal hobby." I want to do this not to act as the beacon of right, delineating good and bad, but because I want to go "on record" with a few things.

There is no postal hobby without publishers. That's a fact. If games were played via flyer, there wouldn't be a real hobby, just a bunch of like-minded people. The 'zines are the core of the postal hobby, and the editors and publishers are the core of the hobby. Players, the subbers, and the interested, support the hobby with their subscriptions and game fees.

The editors, then, might be termed the hobby's forefront, representing the very best and unfortunately the very worst. I say the very best because it's they who devote two entire days a month, at least an hour every night, and a lot of out-of-pocket money to keep things moving --- their 'zines. They are the writers, the promoters, the innovators, and the, pardon the expression, the leaders. And when they're good, they're very, very good, but when they're bad, they're very, very bad.

There are a lot of very, very good editors out there. I won't embarrass anyone by naming names, but generally everyone knows who they are and the names of their zines. And the few who are very, very bad are also known far and wide --- no sense in naming names here either because it's counter-productive.

The bad editors are those who grind axes every issue, beat dead horses, and have nothing better to do than stroke their egos with the grief they cause others. These detestable few ruin everything they touch and not only give themselves a bad name, but postal "Diplomacy" also suffers.

And it's all to sooth their child-like conception of getting-even.

Throughout EM, I've tried to stay away from the food of the fools --- "controversy." I am aware of what goes on, but don't offer opinions or information because of the intrinsic stupidity involved in spreading such trash. I tried and maybe once or twice I failed, but that's nothing compared to some naracissic pubbers, who contribute nothing except rumours, lies, four-letter words, and impish drivel.

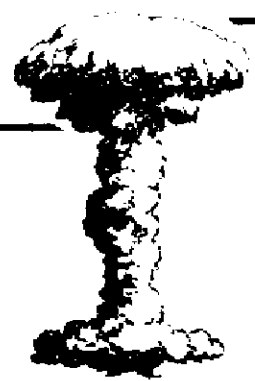

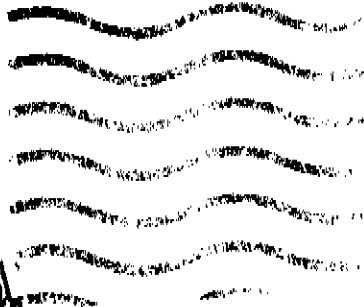
