Finally, I have listed, in a few cases, home addresses rather than current college addresses. This has not been uniformly done, however. In future I plan to list current addresses only; the point of permanent address listings was initially to keep this list as a long-term reference source, but it is obvious that no such is possible anyway.

One of these days I'd like to have a bibliographer step forward and do this stuff for me; I really haven't time, and the results show when you note that I've lost touch with five publishers, lost track of four others, and have no trades yet with at least six on the list.
