The Number Custodianship. In the last issue I discussed a proposal for a new system of keeping game records. A few volunteers have come forward, but they are not sufficient to do the job as outlined. In addition, several have a problem receiving magazines, as they are not themselves publishers.

Accordingly, my proposed diffusion system appears to be a failure. However, before instituting the alternative that I announced, I wish to explore one other possibility: Having each Gamesmaster commit himself to inputting data on his own games and leaving the Custodian the task of printing data only. All active Gamesmasters will shortly receive a short questionnaire on this matter. If the results are favourable, the system will be tried. If the results are inconclusive or unfavourable, my Custodianship will terminate. In order that a reasonable time might be allowed for replies, I am deferring the threatened resignation until April 1st.

Mike Congreve has terminated his magazine and cancelled all games save one. The surviving game will continue by carbon copy.
