Some General Information:

Policy

1. Boardman numbers will be assigned to all regular postal Diplomacy games. 'Regular' will be interpreted quite broadly.
2. Hereinafter the symbol '#' used previously for 'regular' games with a major variance from 'standard 7-man Rulebook' variety will be dropped. Games regular enough to get a number will get it free and clear of value-judgment symbolology.
3. Team games will no longer be numbered.
4. Games played entirely in person, by phone, or otherwise than by post will not be numbered regardless of where the results are published.
5. A decision is pending on the continuation of numbering 5- and 6-man games. My first inclination was to forget them, but I've since decided to think on it.
6. New blood will not be listed in these pages after all. As I'm not on the flyer, I get few enquiries, and most of those are long after the people involved have gained publicity elsewhere.
7. No attempt will be made to continue Mr. Walker's annual bibliography of active magazines.
8. Everything will appear monthly except in December, beginning probably next issue or whenever I get caught up with the backlog. Subscription rates are 20¢ per copy (\$2.20 per year). There is no other way to obtain this than by subscribing in cash.
9. Minutiae - day-to-day changes in players, etc., in active games - will not be listed per se. However, all such information will be catalogued here and will appear with the summary for each game as it is concluded.

*But Had Better Sense Than To Ask.

10. By next issue a plan will be formulated and announced to appoint my successor in this numbering idiocy in advance. Also, a fail-safe backup system in case I go the way of walker or get my lunch in a freeway crash will be proclaimed.

11. In line with many recent proposals to deal by sanction with defaulting Gamesmasters, I herewith contribute what little I can in the context of this magazine: Any gamesmaster who organizes games, defaults on the commitments thereto, and subsequently organizes yet other games without first fulfilling his outstanding commitments, will not have his games numbered until the default is satisfactorily settled. At this writing only one Gamesmaster falls within the bounds of this rule, Buddy Tretick.

How to Get A Number

Information required for numbering: 1. Full names of all players; 2. Countries played by each; 3. Name of magazine; 4. Name of Gamesmaster. Applications for numbering lacking any of these prerequisites may be rejected or ignored.

Please note that I do not keep a file of player addresses; thus these need not be supplied.

Numbers will be issued by calendar year according to the date of receipt of the application for numbering, not by starting date.

Effective immediately, I will no longer assign numbers to games the information for which I am forced to glean from the pages of a magazine. Individual application is required. (I will accept a note on the front cover of a magazine referring me to a game list on an inner page, as long as all the prerequisites are contained in the cited section.)

Normally, 24-hour service on numbering is provided. Return postage is not required.

Honest to God, I got through the backlog left by Rod! All except one game, 1969-BD, in the records of which there are several items I can't decipher and will have to wait on.

I have also begun going through the 'active games' files to pull out those I know to be completed. (67-A in thish was one of those.) So far I have five, and there will be heaps and gobs of others shortly.

Please note a few small changes from the Walker system. Foremost is the condensation of seasons. No longer are there five seasons, merely two - Spring and Fall. This is perhaps technically inaccurate but certainly more realistic.

Further, Rod used to list draws and stalemates as including only the leading players - he had a system. I will be counting every surviving player as a partner in the draw. Cf. 1969-P, Page 9, in which Russia is included in the draw by me but was not so listed by Rod.

It has now been 48 hours since I started on Page One, and I have established two more trades (one I had already but forgot):
