Once again the BNC staff grows. I received an excellent response to my question last issue regarding someone to compile all sorts of records that have been set on the playing board (this was all brought about by 1969CF going to 1929). Five people volunteered for the job and Russell Fox was selected. He has published Centurion since the spring of this year and should be an excellent addition to the staff. Once Russell has all of the needed material at hand (which I still have to send to him) and works out the various categories and records we will have a column in each issue of EVERYTHING giving his results. It should prove to be very interesting and informative. His first column will probably appear in issue #26 in the spring.

The Canadian postal workers' strike is over. It lasted about six weeks and pretty well slowed down the pace of the hobby on both sides of the border. Almost all U.S. publishers and gamesmasters postponed their games in which a Canadian player was playing, and this was obviously the proper thing to do. Now things are once again rolling and all we have to worry about is the Christmas mail mess and the increase of postage rates due on December 28.

I am quite happy to note that Richard Walkerdine is still with us as associate custodian for the U.K. For those who read the last issue remember my adventure in trying to call Richard, only to find out that there are no Walkerdines listed in the Addlestone, Surrey phone directory. Well, the postscript to that story is a happy one as it turns out that Richard and his wife, Claire, have been very busy with other things -- in particular buying a house, and time slipped by. His material (which is in this issue) and a letter explaining all arrived shortly after issue #23 went out. On to more important things.

Since the last issue I have received some orders for photocopies of the game reports from EVERYTHING #1-18. Well, if you are one of those people please don't think that I have forgotten about you or the money you sent. I just have not found time to do the necessary photocopying. Hopefully, I will get around to it by the start of the new year.

I have now been the BNC for a little over a year, and perhaps this would be a good time and place to stop for a moment and see where everything stands (pun intended).

My primary goal of establishing some order out of the chaos that Conrad left has for the most part been accomplished. Boardman Numbers are once again being assigned to new games and finished game reports are being published. These are the most obvious tasks that the BNC has to handle. And this of course means publishing EVERYTHING. Here things would have been much more difficult if it had not been for John Weswig volunteering his time and resources to handle the publishing end of things. Were it not for his aid I sincerely doubt that you would be reading a zine from the BNC today. In a slightly different manner the same can be said of Richard Walkerdine. His excellent handling of the British side of the Boardman Numbers removes a good size burden from my shoulders. And because of my great respect for the way that he handles the job I have decided to go the associate custodian route for Continental Europe and Canada starting in '76.

Conrad did more than just assign new Numbers and report the finish of games. He also kept track of games as they progressed. This was one thing that I found impossible to do (and was probably the reason why the job overwhelmed him) and today I rely mainly upon the publishers to supply me with accurate and complete information on game finishes. Where problems had arose Walt Buchanan and the Hoosier Archives could almost always resolve them. I hope that this system continues to work well in the future. I need the support and aid of the publishers if it will.

For the future I see a modest expansion of the services that the BNC offers. If this is to result, it will require more people helping out to supply the services. However, my basic goal and responsibility will still be to assign new Boardman Numbers and publish reports of finished games. New ventures, like the world records of Diplomacy, will have to come from other members of the staff. I probably could do more of this sort of thing myself, but realistically I have to pace myself if I am to keep this job from getting to me. Anyone who has been around for a while in this hobby knows what I mean. But if I can keep things at about the current pace I figure that I can run the Boardman Numbers for about five years. That is not a guarantee, but a hope. Time will tell.

One thing that I considered and that has been recently suggested by John Baker is that we get someone to do all of the typing for EVERYTHING. It is a good idea, but unfortunately slightly impractical. Our top secretary at Hydrocomp guesses that it would cost about \$50 an issue for a professional typist to type up the 20 or so pages that makes up an issue of EVERYTHING. In addition, there would be the problems of not being familiar with the material plus my need then to write up everything in advance (yes, I type all of this commentary stuff off of the top of my head -- I know it shows), and getting someone to do all of this within a two-day period just prior to each deadline. A Diplomacy type person might be the answer if (1) they were nearby to minimize delays, (2) had an excellent typewriter like this IBM Correcting Selectric II with a carbon ribbon, and (3) had the time available. That is a difficult combination to find (even Marie doesn't have the time nor desire to spend all of a weekend doing this) such a person. However, if anyone out there is interested please let me know.

The schedule for the coming year is as follows: EVERYTHING will be published on or slightly after the first of February, May, July, September, and November. That means five issues for 1976. There will be a three-month spread between issues #25 (February) and #26 (May) instead of the usual two to allow Weswig to spend his time on tax returns.

Last, I have the results of the eighth Beyerlein Player Poll, which was conducted this autumn. Because of a change in publication deadline for Diplomacy World the deadline was moved up from December 15 to December 4. The results are as follows:
