There are numerous things to discuss in this issue, and so we might as well get to them. First, I did not receive any game reports from the associate custodian for the U.K., Richard Walkerdine, and thus none will be found in this issue. I suspect (and hope) that Richard just forgot to send in the information. He has been very busy lately working on an accord to improve relations between IDA and NGC. Undoubtedly, Boardman Number information from England will be included in EVERYTHING #27.

The associate custodian for continental Europe, Michel Feron, has been asked to resign. All requests for Boardman Numbers should now be directed to me (Doug Beyerlein) from publishers in continental Europe (Haas, Prevot, and Jonsson). The reason that Feron was asked to resign was because his schedule did not permit him the necessary amount of time to devote to Boardman Number activities. I hate to have Michel leave the staff, but I think that this move will be best for all of us.

For those of you who have not heard, Greg Warden has turned over control of the Orphan Game Bureau to Raymond Heuer. The OGB handles the transfer of games abandoned by their gamesmasters to new homes. Warden did an excellent job during the past three years. And I am sure that Heuer will handle the job just as well. If you know of or are in games which appear to be abandoned then contact Ray and give him the specifics. His address would have been included here, but I am at the office and don't have it available; next issue.

The typing of this issue has been delayed a week. I mentioned a possible delay in the last issue of EVERYTHING. We had planned a vacation about at this time, but that plan fell through when Marie changed jobs last month. However, Marie's parents arrived just in time for the typing weekend and rather than disappear (and earn Marie's scorn) we journeyed down to Monterey and Point Lobos to take in the scenery and wildlife (sea otters, seals, and sea lions). And that is the excuse for this issue.

As all of you must have heard by now, Avalon Hill has bought Diplomacy from Games Research Inc. The Boardman Numbers have been well supported by John Moot and GRI and it appears that Avalon Hill will continue in this tradition. Currently I am in the midst of discussions with Don Greenwood of AH to establish a working

relationship with Avalon Hill. A final agreement will be made by Origins II, but at the moment there are a number of possible solutions. A brief outline of AH's thinking and mine is presented below. I am doing this because I want your input as to how we should proceed. A questionnaire has been enclosed with this issue for your response. If you are at all interested in this discussion fill out your questionnaire and return it as soon as possible. Issue #27 will present the results and my decision prior to direct talks with AH in late July at the convention.

Avalon Hill's position as presented in a letter from Greenwood: AH would prefer to combine EVERYTHING with Diplomacy World and print the combined zine at their Baltimore printing facilities. They would handle the subscriptions and mailing list. I would send EVERYTHING to Walt Buchanan. He would set it up for offset printing along with DW and then send it all to AH for printing and mailing. This would change the schedule of EVERYTHING from five issues a year to four to agree with Buchanan's quarterly schedule. My main objection to this plan is that EVERYTHING will cease to be a zine in its own right, and will instead become a sub-zine to someone else. It will remove some control from my hands and add extra time delays in getting each issue to you. I would prefer to have AH continue GRI's \$200 a year subsidy and have Weswig do the publishing (and John is agreeable to continue publishing EVERYTHING), but AH would rather go with a package plan for both EVERYTHING and DW.

The GRI subsidy of \$200 a year provided half of the income necessary to produce EVERYTHING. The other half comes from IDA. Thus, with the IDA subsidy and another plan to cover the rest there are options available other than the plan put forth by AH.

If each gamesmaster/publisher was willing to pay a fee of one dollar for a Boardman Number then the additional revenue of \$200 a year could be raised without the need to accept AH's plan. EVERYTHING would stay a separate zine with its current format. This is one possible option, although I would need almost unanimous support from the gamesmasters and publishers to try it.

Another option is to ask all publishers who wish to receive EVERYTHING to subscribe while still sending me their zines. With a hundred additional subscribers at the current subscription price (10 issues for \$4, which equals \$2 per year) the \$200 needed could also be raised without AH's support. The major drawback to this idea is that I will not be able to continue contact with publishers who might send me their zines but not subscribe.

A third option is to ask for donations to support EVERYTHING and the Boardman Numbers. The number of people who can afford to do this and are agreeable must be somewhat limiting.

Well, the choice is yours. Think over the pros and cons of all of the above and then fill out the enclosed questionnaire. Send it back to me and once I review them all I will try to reach some conclusion and decision. The results and accompanying discussion will be presented in the next issue. So if you want any say in all of this, let me hear from you now. Thanks.

On a less heavy topic, I should mention that the first of Russell Fox's series of columns on records set in postal Diplomacy games can be found in this issue. Hopefully you will find it of interest. Any comments, suggestions, and the like should be directed to Russell. His address is on page one.

I have been running the ODD Rating List since John McCallum, its inventor, gave it up in 1972. But since I have taken over the Boardman Numbers I no longer have time to keep it current. The problem is that over 200 games have finished since I last updated it two years ago. At a half an hour per game you can quickly see that a great deal of work is required to get it going again. But if you are interested and have the time to take it over and get it going again please let me know. I have a computer program to do all of the calculations (it is written in FORTRAN IV), but still preparation of the input will take a while. I hate to see the ODD system die, but I just don't have the time. Maybe you do?

For those of you who are interested in attending DipCon IX and Origins II in Baltimore on 23-25 July you can get information and a registration form by sending a stamped, self-addressed envelope to Convention, c/o AH, 4517 Harford Road, Baltimore, MD 21214. Marie and I will be attending and playing in the Diplomacy tournament even though it is a lot further way to go than Chicago. But I have not missed a DipCon in five years and I guess that I won't start now. Hope to see you there.

This spring IDA published its first Publisher's Handbook. I and nine other authors contributed to this handbook. And as such, it contains information on all aspects of publishing and gamesmastering. So there is a lot of new and interesting information to be gained from getting a copy and reading it. To do so send your money (\$2 for IDA members; \$2.50 for non-members) to Len Lakofka, 644 West Briar Pl., Chicago, IL 60657. I know that it will be worth your money if you are really interested in doing a good job as a gamesmaster or publisher.

John Gross and Calvin White have asked me to mention a proposal of theirs to provide a zine in which novice gamesmasters could get an opportunity to handle the job of gming without publishing a zine. They will provide the resources to publish the zine with IDA funding the cost. In this way a means will be available to handle the expected horde of new players once AH places Diplomacy in every store across the country. This proposal is now before the IDA Council for approval. The refuse to trade list, which is found in each issue, has a new member added to it. Robert Lipton recently informed me that he would no longer send me his zine, Mixumaxu Gazette (an excellent zine, by the way). Thus he has joined the ranks of Charles Reinsel (Coleman is no longer publishing, I believe). Therefore, I request that anyone who is willing to part with MG to please send me their copies. I would especially appreciate info on game finishes. Thanks.

Moving down the list of subjects: next is 1973DT, reported in the last issue of EVERYTHING. After the results were published the gamesmaster of the game suddenly discovered a vast conspiracy among the members of the BNC Staff. It seems that there was prize money associated with the game. How this made any difference in the outcome I have no idea. The game is still as regular as any other as far as I can see. But as the publisher of EVERYTHING was a member of the three-way draw that concluded the game and as I did not declare the game to be irregular it is obvious to one person (the gm) that we conspired to gain John whatever points the finish might be worth on the various rating systems. I will let you make your own conclusion. And all ratingskeepers please note: if you think that the game should be declared irregular because of prize money then please do so for your rating system. (You lost your bet, Burt.)
