One Brief Announcement

Generally speaking, the policy statements made in the last issue are being reconsidered and/or reformulated. Please do not act on anything indicated in those statements. Final policy will be spelled out in detail in Issue Number Four.

The remainder of this special issue will be devoted to a comprehensive listing of all postal Diplomacy games which are supposedly in progress. It must be understood in advance that this list is probably accurate as of about 1 August 1972. That is, changes to the below list which have occurred since that date are not reflected. (with a tiny handful of exceptions.)

For instance: At least three games in progress - the old Int'l. Enquirer games - are not listed because the records at my disposal are for some reason missing all data on these games; a minimum of five of the below games are known to be completed, but I lack full data (in most instances, the final year or two of stats) to record them; games the removal of which from this list would be implemented by my going over my own puny archive of magazines remain on the list because I have not yet been able to do this work.

Et cetera.

Additionally, many of these games have probably been abandoned long since, but until I am fully aware of the last date of any reports on them I hesitate to declare them either abandoned or orphaned.

If you are aware of any of the following list having been completed, abandoned, or otherwise terminated, please advise me immediately. Once informed I can probably secure the necessary data to wrap them up, but unless informed I may not be able to do this.

Listings are: Game number, last known magazine, last known games-master and/or publisher. Games assigned numbers in previous issues of Everything... are not included (i.e. 1972-B0 through, so far, -E0).

Policy Overhaul

Although it says on Page One that this section will appear next issue, I've decided it would be well to get things clear. So....

1. Everything.... will be sent to all active regular-game Game-masters automatically, free. In addition, compilers of rating systems and Game-masters of variant Diplomacy games may receive each issue free if they so request. For any other recipient the subscription rate is \$2.00 per year, 11 issues, first class.

2. All regular games will be numbered. Game-masters are urged to take the initiative in applying for numbers as soon as they fill a game; when this is done the number will be assigned within 24 hours of receipt of required information (see last issue for required info). Games the statistics for which I have to scrounge out myself will be assigned numbers when I feel like it.

3. The symbol #, denoting irregular games not precisely variants, will be retained in certain cases. Five- and sixteen-games, if played under rulebook provisions, will be so numbered. Local area, telephone, or partially in-person games will likewise be numbered with the #. Team games, games with fewer than five players, and games varying substantially from the rulebook will not be numbered at all. Games played as a group, as in a tournament series, will be numbered as fully regular.

That should settle that. Please be aware that the editor of this journal welcomes, even encourages, comment and criticism. If you have the urge to say something, please do.

On one final note. Those among you who are opposed to my doing this work, that's fine and certainly your privilege. But how about having the common courtesy to come out of the woodwork instead of pulling this behind-the-back lobbying crap? Huh?
