As you may have noticed, if you read the above, we now have an associate Boardman Number custodian for continental Europe. He is Roland Prevot of Paris, France. Roland has been publishing a Diplomacy zine for some time now and just recently volunteered to handle the Boardman Numbers for continental Europe. Thus, all continental European publishers should establish trades with Roland if they have not already done so. He will be making Boardman Number assignments for continental European games starting in 1977. Also, please note: I wish to continue trading Everything with all continental European publishers and will assume that you are agreeable unless I hear otherwise from you.

For this new year we have a tentative schedule worked out for the publication of Everything. Six issues will be published. The schedule is #31 - March, #32 - June, #33 - August, #34 - October, #35 - December. Note the three month span between #31 and #32. Unless you hear otherwise, this will be the schedule for '77.

While some people moan and groan about the one dollar Boardman Number fee (more on that elsewhere in this issue) sometimes aid comes from rather unexpected places. Just a few days ago I received a check for ten dollars from the American Wargaming Association. It was their way of showing support for the Boardman Numbers even though they are not active in postal Diplomacy. Last issue I mentioned that John Leeder was starting a stand-by serve for players and zines, called SSSZ. In Paroxysm #44 I read that Andy Webber, 20 Graydon Hall Dr., Apt. 204, Don Mills, Ontario, M3A 2Z9, Canada, has now taken over this service from Leeder. Persons wanting to stand-by for games under this system, or gms who need stand-bys should write to Andy for details.

On a subject outside of Diplomacy let me comment that a small dent is being made in the California drought as I sit here typing this on the New Year's weekend. We have only had two storms roll in off the Pacific Ocean since last spring until this one arrived. Otherwise, it has been sun, sun, sun for eight months straight. And how is the snow in Ontario, Randolph? See you in two months with the next issue of Everything.

*But Had Better Sense Than to Ask

If you have not heard, there is currently a major dispute in the works over who should be Miller Number Custodian (for variant games). Robert Sacks is currently custodian, but Conrad von Metzke has decided to lay claim to the job based on the fact that he was a past custodian (1973) and his belief that Sacks has alienated the variant community. Personally, I feel that this matter has been handled very poorly by both sides. To get input from the publishers, Walt Buchanan has asked Fred Davis to poll the publishers on this dispute. Thus, in late January a ballot will be sent out to each publisher. I was asked by Davis to count the ballots after his and Sacks's first choices were found to be unavailable. However, as I understand the situation Sacks would prefer to have Andy Phillips in on the ballot counting and so I will ask him to do so as he only lives some 30 miles away. This whole matter of von Metzke vs. Sacks points out a real weakness with the independent custodian set-up. The custodian is king. There is no real process established to handle such disputes as the one mentioned above; thus, we get a revolt. The poll or referendum (which comes down to a vote of confidence) can only be used as a last resort sort of mechanism. That is okay, but it doesn't keep potential problems from occurring in the first place. If you ever have problems with me (something that I hope is unlikely) I suggest the following steps in trying to resolve them: (1) discuss the problem with me and perhaps I can do something that will make us both happy; or if that doesn't work: (2) ask a neutral party (perhaps a former BNC) to mediate the dispute; and if that also fails then (3) poll the publishers. But I hope that no problem ever gets to number 3.

In Everything #29 I presented a detailed discussion on why I needed the one dollar fee to pay for the cost of running the Boardman Numbers and publishing Everything. And at the end of that discussion I asked for comments. Many of you have commented favorably in your zine, and I wish to thank you. Others wrote directly to me and some of their comments are printed below.

Ferkin Doyle: "I myself am against the idea of charging a gm a fee for the BN but I am also mature enough to understand the reasons why and not get my paranoia up. The last issue of Everything was very well done and I hope that each side feels that it had a chance to say its two cents worth."

Gil Neiger: "I support 99%. I see nothing wrong with the \$1 fee, though perhaps you might make it less if one gm is getting more than one number at a time. But you shouldn't make it absolutely mandatory yet. Maybe you should say it is, but don't actually start non-inclusion of games just yet. Wait until people get used to the idea of paying. What if no gm ever charged for games or zines and then suddenly they all did. Imagine the outrage. Anyway, I think if you just give people a little time to realize that it's not exorbitant and that it's necessary, they'll come around."

Dennis Agosta: "I support you entirely in your decision to charge \$1.00 for each Boardman Number you issue. The Boardman Numbers are the skeleton which holds this hobby together (however loosely) and without them we would have utter chaos. My original set of Big Brother-type

houserules ((Reinsel)) should illustrate this point vividly. Without the advice I received from you and Rod Walker I would never have known how seriously I was in error. I feel that you have done an outstanding job as BNC and would be very upset to see the more unreasonable members of our fraternity force the system into extinction."

Robert Correll: "I appreciate your complete discussion of the subsidy question in Everything #29, and your fair presentation of the issues and numbers involved. Further to my earlier letters which appear in that issue I wish to express my support of the Boardman Numbers and your handling of the subsidy question. In my opinion, the \$1 charge is fair and provides good value for the valuable service being performed. I think that most Canadian gms agree on this point and I would expect that they will assist in anteing up the necessary \$1 per number to Doug Ronson to maintain the numbers. Secondly, I would like to clarify my statement in regard to the DW subsidy. From the letters and discussion I have had with Walt Buchanan, I am satisfied that the DW subsidy is reasonable. In any event, this is a question for the American hobby to decide, for it is their publisher of the game, Avalon Hill, which is providing the funds for the subsidy."

Thank you everyone for expressing your opinions.

Elsewhere in this issue you will find "An Open Letter to the Diplomacy Hobby" by Don Greenwood of Avalon Hill. He discusses the whole course of events from when Avalon Hill bought Diplomacy from GRI to the present. In his letter (and something that may effect all of us) is the statement that Avalon Hill will donate the entrance fees from future Origins Diplomacy tournaments to the Boardman Number Custodian for the running of the numbers and Everything. In exchange, the BNC must provide for the running of the tournaments. For 1977 this means the Origins III Diplomacy tournament to be held in the New York City metropolitan area. I won't be there, as Marie and I are going to the DipCon at Lake Geneva, Wisconsin, but I am currently in the process of finding some people to handle the Origins tournament.

The Origins tournaments appear that they will bring in sufficient money for me to drop the mandatory one dollar fee, and instead make it voluntary. So all of you people who can't spare a buck will still get your number for any new games started. But don't think that we are rolling in money yet. The Origins convention and tournament won't be until sometime this summer and we are still going to be hard pressed for funds until that time. Afterwards, if the revenue brought in by the Origins III tournament is large enough we will offer refunds for people who paid the mandatory one dollar fee under protest. But remember: that won't be possible until later this coming summer. Is that agreeable?

It appears now that we are on our way to solving the money problems of running the Boardman Numbers and Everything, but don't think that everything is roses from here on out. This job is still a back-breaker and it needs the cooperation and hard work of everyone if it is to succeed. And as the hobby grows it is bound to only get worse. Well, onwards...

AVALON HILL (Don Greenwood): AN OPEN LETTER TO THE DIPLOMACY HOBBY

"I have been appalled by recent events in the ranks of postal Diplomacy. Despite a desire to remain aloof in the affairs of postal Diplomacy, my name in connection with Avalon Hill has apparently become a household word in the ranks of postal Diplomacy players. Therefore, in view of the current controversy it may be appropriate to make an all encompassing statement at this time. I hope this is the last time I take up valuable space in your magazine.

"It seems appropriate to start at the beginning. John Moot of GRI approached Avalon Hill to sell Diplomacy -- not the other way around. Due to the universal esteem held for the quality of the game we met John's asking price -- which was not small by any means. It was only after the sale had been consummated that I received a call from Edi Birsan informing us of the strings attached; a \$1,000 annual subsidy for DW and the Boardman Numbers. Considering the number of sets we'll have to sell just to get back the purchase price this was not welcome news. We had assumed that the postal Diplomacy hobby existed as did other interest groups -- on the interests of its members -- not an artificial subsidy. Neither Avalon Hill nor any other game company of comparable size that I am aware of ever subsidized a hobby group in this matter. We do not do it for any other game -- why should Diplomacy be an exception? A hobby is just that -- something that exists on the enthusiasm and sacrifice of its members for the enjoyment derived from participation. I do not feel that subsidies should be expected to keep a hobby group functioning. You don't see manufacturers of chess sets making donations to the U.S. Chess Federation, nor do you see wargame companies subsidizing national clubs which promote all of their games -- new and old alike -- not just one. Neither should Diplomacy enthusiasts expect this free ride.

"Financially speaking, there is no way to justify the \$1,000 annual Diplomacy subsidy. It effects relatively few people because the ranks of postal Diplomacy are not large, and those involved already have the game. I doubt whether Diplomacy players buy duplicate sets every year out of thanks to the publisher for a subsidy. Therefore, they must be directly responsible for inducing a thousand friends to buy Diplomacy annually. I doubt whether this occurs. Even the advertising advantages of publishing DW are minimal -- by and large Diplomacy enthusiasts do not buy other games and those who do usually receive our literature anyway. The subsidy generated little business for GRI as evidenced by their desire to get out of the game business. There is little reason to suspect it benefits Avalon Hill any more.

"However, not wishing to play the role of the "heavy", Avalon Hill president Eric Dott generously agreed to continue the GRI subsidy. At first, Edi Birsan, speaking for his IDA peers agreed to Avalon Hill printing and mailing the respective publications ((Diplomacy World and Everything)) in lieu of a cash subsidy. As it later turned out, neither Douglas nor Walter were agreeable to this. For reasons of their own, they preferred to maintain the status quo and continue to receive the full cash subsidy. Avalon Hill again agreed but requested that the two magazines be combined in order to cut expenses. Neither party was willing to do this. The only course offered was to pay the full \$1,000 subsidy with no alternatives. Furthermore, Walter was unwilling to

print an occasional Kingmaker or OWW II article in Diplomacy World to help justify the subsidy as a multi-player Avalon Hill magazine. Again, we conceded but left the point in our agreement with him in hopes he'd later consent to a trial balloon.

"Now I must admit to being a bit peeved at the Diplomacy hobby. Avalon Hill is expected to hand over \$1,000 annually with no questions asked. Yet, what are the recipients of this aid willing to do? When asked to ante up roughly the equivalent of a 13¢ stamp per player per game so that the universally accepted Boardman Number system can continue, they heap abuse on an individual who has given freely of his time to perform a valuable service to their hobby. It would have been very easy for Mr. Beyerlein to take the easy way out and wash his hands of the whole thing. That he has courageously and maturely turned his back on unwarranted insults and decided to carry on in the best interests of the hobby is a commendable action of the highest order. Although I have met Doug only once he has gained my highest respect by his decision announced in issue #29 of Everything. If only other members of the hobby would be so gracious and reasonable.

"Although not a postal Diplomacy enthusiast myself, I can see where the plan to require a \$1.00 fee for a Boardman Number won't work. Human nature being what it is, there will always be those too shortsighted to participate and the Boardman Numbers are nothing if not complete. Every player should have the opportunity to be rated in the institution which has become the Boardman Numbers. No... Boardman Numbers should be free but the BN Custodian must be subsidized.

"Yet, I refuse to have Avalon Hill shoulder the full load for a hobby group which is unwilling to help itself. We will meet the postal Diplomacy hobby more than halfway by continuing to pay the \$800 DW subsidy until DW can support itself or the Diplomacy hobby proves by its actions that it is unworthy of any support. The BN subsidy will have to come from the ranks of the hobby. There are a number of painless ways this can be accomplished. Edi Birsan took in over \$400 in tournament entry fees for IDA at the recent DIPCON in Baltimore. Why can't this revenue be applied to the Boardman Numbers subsidy?

"Let's go even further and transcend club boundaries as it is apparent that not everyone belongs to the IDA, although we recognize it through our subsidies as the official organization of the Diplomacy hobby. Avalon Hill will again sponsor a national Diplomacy Tournament/Championship at Origins '77 in New York. We will put up the prizes. All the postal Diplomacy hobby has to do is come up with one volunteer or group of volunteers to run the event competently. We will then turn over all entry fees received to the Boardman Number Custodian. If Origins II is any indication, proceeds should be much more than the current \$200 requested subsidy. Any excess can be squirreled away for future lean years. The process can be repeated every year as the ORIGINS site moves around the country. This in no way forces the IDA or postal Diplomacy to turn the ORIGINS conventions into their DIPCONS. Avalon Hill will not dictate the site of any DIPCON. All it requires is a little volunteer action on the part of Diplomacy fans to help themselves. Is this too much to ask?

"My major reason for cutting the Diplomacy subsidy was to force postal Diplomacy enthusiasts to stop putting out their hand and start working for their own hobby. I had thought that IDA could easily subsidize the Boardman Numbers. Apparently, petty politics stands in the way of that. If postal Diplomacy enthusiasts have so much fun bickering amongst themselves that they can't support one national organization for the betterment of their hobby then that's their prerogative. But don't ask us to subsidize any group so petty that it refuses to take even the most minimal steps to help itself. Frankly, if the postal hobby can't put its own house in order with all of the aid we've offered then it doesn't deserve to exist. No one subsidized me when I printed my fan'zine (Panzerfaust). Over the course of 50 monthly issues I evolved a circulation in excess of 500 -- no mean feat for a spirit duplicator. I didn't make any money on it and no one did my typing for me. I did it because it was my hobby and the hobby supported me with subscriptions and articles because they wanted the service I performed to continue. If Diplomacy enthusiasts want their hobby to continue they can get involved and help it out. Otherwise it has all the stability of a house of cards and is worth considerably less."

Doug Beyerlein, here. Well, as you have read, we are not doing too well in the public relations end of the hobby. I am rather surprised that Greenwood and Avalon Hill have been as patient and helpful as they have been when you see how we have acted in return. I will be first to agree that I should have thought over the situation more carefully and instructed Edi Birsan on just what would be acceptable to the BNC before he went to Baltimore last spring to discuss the subsidy matter with Avalon Hill. That would have prevented the early problems. Today's problem of how best to organize hobby-wide support to handle our own affairs quietly and efficiently is not as easy to solve. Avalon Hill's decision to donate entrance fees collected at future Origins Diplomacy tournaments is going to help solve the money end of running the Boardman Numbers and EVERYTHING (more on this elsewhere in this issue), but it doesn't solve all of our problems. We still need a democratic hobby organization that is going to provide services for the members of the hobby, instead of playing power politics and feuding. That sort of behavior only turns people off and makes them conclude that they want no part of this hobby. I left the AH wargaming hobby some ten years ago because of the incredible immaturity of so many of its participants. I hate to think that the same will come of Diplomacy. It is all up to us.
