This issue is being typed and sent to Weswig for publishing early (today is 19 February) because I will be out of town for a business trip later this month and early next. It looks like I will get a change of climate as I will be spending a week in Maryland and then a couple days in upstate New York at Cornell University. To prepare for the worst, I am taking my winter hiking gear along. Next issue of Everything, #32, will come out 1 June, according to the schedule printed in #30. So don't be surprised if you don't see Everything for a while. We planned it that way.

For those of you who receive Graustark read in #357 (1 January 1977) that Boardman was assigning Raymond Heuer as Boardman Number Custodian. John Boardman thought that the assignment of Boardman Numbers would not continue to be universal with my mandatory one dollar fee for a number. Thus his action. This apparently caught everyone, including Heuer and myself, by surprise. However, I quickly told John of the announcement in Everything #30 (which was then at the printers) of my decision to make the dollar voluntary based on expected revenue from the ORIGINS III Diplomacy tournament. This satisfied Boardman and Heuer decided not to contest my position as custodian and, thus, I believe that everything is settled. I will remain as Boardman Number Custodian until I resign or a majority of the publishers indicate that they no longer have confidence in my ability to handle the job. Sound fair?

A group of volunteers has come forward to run the Diplomacy tournament at ORIGINS III. His report follows.

This assumes that #31 will be 10 pages in its final form. So far John has received no comments, either personally or in any zines, to his offer to let someone else publish Everything if they can do it cheaper.

With the increased cost of printing it looks like we will be scraping financial bottom in an issue or two. The one dollar fees for Boardman Numbers assigned are providing some much needed income and we have not as yet billed IDA 35 cents per number for numbers assigned in the last part of 1976, so I think that we will be able to cover costs for a little while longer. But to further complicate the picture the expected revenue from ORIGINS III may not be as great as anticipated because of some recent events which I am not going to publicly discuss at this time. Ever get the feeling that we are just going from one crisis to the next?
