## Report on the Orphan Games Project

In the last two months the effort to revive or salvage the multitudinous orphan games floating around has met with mixed success. It seems appropriate at this time to give an accounting of progress to date.

The first major effort undertaken by the Project was the brace of nineteen games dropped by Rod Walker. With two exceptions these games were comparatively easy, involving merely the finding of a new home and the notifying of players. The two exceptions were 1970-BL, which seemed simple at first but ran into a snag through mismanagement by the Orphan Games Director, and 1971-DN, which for complicated reasons appeared for a time impossible. It is pleasant to note that these two games were eventually dealt with successfully, giving a 100% revival rate for the Walker games.

Next on the list was the pair of games run by John McCallum. This proved even easier, as the cooperation of the original Gamesmaster was offered and greatly simplified the mechanics. (In fact, the Orphan Games Project can take little credit for this, as almost all the work was done by John McCallum.)

Thereafter the road grew rockier. A quick and very pleasant success was unexpectedly obtained with Game 1969-D, orphaned twice previously and now ensconced in its third home. But after that the games being dealt with were very old, very long dormant, and more often than not composed of players long since inactive.

Since many noises had been made about the RAMSEY DIPLOMAT games, it seemed reasonable to try to revive them. Although the final verdict

is not yet in, it strongly appears as though all of these games are dead and cannot be salvaged. This is too bad, but if nobody wants to continue, they cannot very well be forced to.

Next on the list was the incredible maze of confusion known as WORLD NEWS AND WAR REPORT (or JOURNAL, or RUNNING RIVER, etc.). The problem here was finding the records. To the best of the Project's ability they have been found and revival efforts are under way.

The preceding also applies to the six OMNIFARIOUS games.

In addition to the preceding, there are about twenty games 'under investigation' to determine if they are in fact orphans at all. If they are they will be dealt with as soon as possible. However, it is the policy of the Orphan Games Project that games are not pulled out from under their Gamesmasters without substantial evidence that they have been abandoned and without substantial agreement by the players. The rather vague guidelines which determine the first part of this are: (1) Statement of abandonment by the Gamesmaster himself, a rarity; (2) Failure to reply to three consecutive and wellspaced letters, including a certified letter; (3) Six months' inactivity. These are vague because they are not applied rigidly, with the emphasis of course on lax rather than strict enforcement.

Finally, at least eighteen games have been investigated and found hopeless. These were listed in the last issue.

Therefore, the summary box score at this writing is:

Salvaged - 22.	Determination pending - 17.
Abandoned - 18.	Under study - ca. 20.
Probably abandoned - 5.
