## Foreign readers, read and weep

Between the soaring costs of this thing and the diminution of my financial stability, I am forced to declare the following policy applicable to recipients outside North America:

Beginning next issue, copies will be sent by sea mail. This will take 4-9 weeks depending on country of destination. If you want air service, I am afraid I will have to request reimbursement for the excess postage charges at the rates indicated in the preceding paragraph. For the remainder of 1973 that excess cost would be \$3.06, or one pound 28p sterling. Draughts in foreign currencies, add 50¢ bank fees (32p).

I'm sorry, but if you want to know the why of it, you may wish to read that the circulation of this journal as of this moment is 80, of which 14 go overseas. Postage on the 66 North America copies is \$5.28 per issue. The cost for the 14 overseas copies is \$5.88. Now do you see my point?

The six games 1971-CJ-C0 were a tournament series run by the Spartan Wargamers club. Some rather exotic rules for victory held sway, resulting in the various declared draws indicated. Further, a calendar time limit resulted in 'no decision' in two games. (contd)

Finally, these games saw the all-but-unprecedented firing of the first two Gamesmasters by Russell Powell, head of the tournament club and a player in three games. (Mr. Mankiewicz, I understand, was fired at least partly because he wished to identify these games by Boardman Number, which Mr. Powell forbade.)
