It is with some reluctance that I find myself accepting the office of BNC. Kathy and I had discussed the possibility earlier this year. Our time table was for her to resign about Jan. 85. However the controversy which arose from the personal attacks on Kathy Byrne by Mr. Linsey made Kathy feel that she should resign to defend herself without involving the office of the BNC in this feud. I will make no other comment about the accusations by Mr. Linsey except to say that Kathy's tenure as BNC was exemplary. The accusations are completely false and without merit. This is not to say that Kathy's reign was without controversial decisions. The questions of electronic mail games, the Wordswork game and other questions of 'irregularity' in games caused grumblings among those affected. However I have studied the decisions of past BNC's and Kathy's decisions were consistent with the policies and precedents established by those before her. These decisions were reinforced by second opinions obtained from hobby notables such as Walker, Berch, Davis, and Beyerlein.

Those expecting a great change in the policies and operation of the BNC will be disappointed. I will continue to conduct the office as my predecessors have done. There are areas in which better communication with the hobby will result in a better understanding of the rulings the BNC makes concerning 'irregularity'. One thing that is important to remember is that these rulings represent the opinion of the BNC and are not 'law'. Rather these are opinions based on the precedents set by the procedures used to play Diplomacy via the USPS since 1963 as originated by John Boardman. Through the years the hobby expanded and matured. One person's idea of how the game was supposed to be conducted varied from another's. Some individuals believed they had the right to tamper with the play of the game or to introduce changes which altered the form and/or procedure of the game. When these alterations and unscrupulous activities were noted the need for the 'irregular' and 'variant' labels arose. What causes a game to be declared a variant or irregular seems to be a matter of confusion among the majority of the hobby's members.

What gives the BNC the right to declare games irregular? Who appointed the BNC hobby dictator? Why should I allow the BNC to interfere with the way I run my games? These are but a few of the questions I see from time to time in print. The tone of frustration and aggravation in these questions reveals that the origins and functions of the BNC are widely misunderstood. The basic function of BNC is to catalog the start of games, monitor their progress, and to publish their conclusions. From these responsibilities other functions have arisen. Briefly some are making sure games move along without long interruption, referring to the Orphan Service games abandoned by their GM's, investigating player complaints, and observing game reports for unusual conduct or procedure. Thus the BNC has become a hobby watchdog by virtue of the fact that no other person or office has access to the type or quantity of information that passes through the hands of the BNC and the publisher of EVERYTHING. In addition the BNC represents one of the most visible, impartial and respected authorities in the hobby. It is only natural that when a player feels wronged or in need of help the BNC is one of the first called upon.

I regret the tardiness of EVERYTHING # 61. The task of transferring the BNC and publishing has put me far behind schedule. Next issue I hope to have a publisher to relieve some of the burden. An Atari computer would simplify the matter greatly since information could be transferred by E-MAIL. Also I hope to continue my comments on the functions of the BNC.
