## New Publisher

## Standbys Needed

What?! Standbys needed for Everything!?! The answer is YES. I have been urged by several people to establish a "Universal Standby List" for use by the Orphan Service and for publishers who have no standbys left in their pool. This offers an excellent opportunity for players to pick up another game without the expense of game or subscription fees. The list will work like this for the present:

1. Players wanting to be on the Universal Standby List should contact my office by mail. Information needed includes NAME, ADDRESS, NUMBER OF GAMES that you are willing to standby in.
2. Standby players will accept whatever position is assigned and submit at least one set of orders. Players who NMR, resign, or refuse positions will be removed from the list.
3. Publishers and GM's who use the Universal Standby List shall provide the standby with the names and addresses of the other players and a copy of the last season's moves. Time should be allowed for the new player to negotiate with the other players.
4. GM's and publishers will provide the standby with each season's adjudications at NO CHARGE. It is not necessary to provide a free subscription.
5. Until further notice, requests for a Universal Standby should be sent to me.

A reply form is provided on another page. Publishers, please reprint.

## New Feature

Beginning this issue, I am starting a new feature. The name is Litigation. Litigation will contain the decisions handed down on cases of irregularities and complaints. The purpose will be to notify the hobby public of policy regarding the thinking and processes used when evaluating complaints and charges of irregularity. This issue contains two cases for which a decision has been made. Hopefully, it will eliminate the complaint, "When did they rule this irregular?". If nothing else, it will make for some boring reading.

## Local Games

Since last issue, I have received several requests for clarification on my remarks regarding local games. It is not my policy that any game having two local players is automatically a "local" game. I am staying with the established policy that requires three local players to cause a game to be regarded as local without question (see Everything #53). My guidelines are just that. If no two players are within fifty miles or have local phone service, then there will be no question of locality. Furthermore, my statements apply to game's end, not its beginning. I would bring such games under consideration only if there is a player complaint. The burden of proof would lie on the complainant to show the locality of the players gave an unfair advantage to the local players. My application of these guides to standby players covers the situation where at gamestart, there were two players who are local. Note that at this point the game is not considered local. However, if the GM then appoints a standby who is local to the other two local players, is the game now local? I say that it depends on the circumstances. If the guidelines presented (no two players within fifty miles or local phone service) are followed, then again, there is no question of locality. The bottom line is that if players are kept widely separated, then the problem does not exist.

## Litigation

## John Caruso vs. Robert Sacks

This case was instigated by John Caruso charging that the standby policy of Robert Sacks is irregular. Mr. Sacks uses an anonymous standby policy. The policy works like this:

1. When a player NMR's or resigns, Mr. Sacks places an announcement in his 'zine that a standby is needed for a position.
2. Persons wanting the position then submit orders for that position.
3. From those submitting orders, Mr. Sacks selects a standby. However, neither the selected standby nor the players in the game are informed of the identity of the chosen standby.
4. When the season's moves are due and the chosen standby's moves are needed, they are used and his/her identity is revealed.

It was my immediate reaction that such a policy is irregular. The reason is this: Diplomacy is a game that requires negotiation. One cannot negotiate with an unknown person. Furthermore, to make moves where contact with other players is not allowed resembles Sunboat Diplomacy against that country. I believe that this is quite unfair to any power that had some alliance with that country not to be able to renegotiate that alliance with a potential new player. To reaffirm by opinion, I consulted with Mr. Fred Davis, Mr. Don Ditter, and Mr. Rod Walker. Their unanimous opinion agreed with mine.

Litigation (continued)

Julie Glass Martin vs. Konrad Baumeister

In this case, Julie Martin charges that Konrad Baumeister:

1. Refused to accept her resignation from game 19811B.
2. Failed to call a standby for the resigned position.
3. Wrote orders for the resigned position after Ms. Martin refused to.
4. Listed Ms. Martin as "dropped" when in fact she resigned.

From the outset, it was apparent that there is a great of animosity between these two. Arguments in the case were little more than mud slinging and had little substance. I was impressed by two facts. The first is that Julie had the presence of mind to originally lodge her complaint soon after she noted that orders were appearing that she did not write. This information was passed to me by Kathy Byrne in a letter discussing the transfer of the BNC. I had hoped that there would have been a written document, but Kathy said that the original complaint was verbal.

The second item that impressed me was the fact that Konrad Baumeister listed Julie as (drop S04). This does not agree with the seasonal adjudications. Orders appeared in Julie Martin's name until Fall '05. Then in W'05, the position is suddenly listed in CD without explanation. Konrad dismisses this as a typo and that Julie really did tell him via phone that she didn't want to continue playing. I find nothing similar between (drop S04) and (res W05). In addition, it seems peculiar that Konrad would have listed Julie as dropped during the very season that Julie claimed to have resigned. I believe it to be more than a coincidence. I believe that for some personal reason, Konrad did in fact attempt to keep Julie in this game by refusing to accept her resignation. I cannot back this decision by hard evidence, and Konrad and I could be victims of an elaborate and well thought plan to discredit him. However, I believe that Konrad is guilty of misconduct in this game.
