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BNC Chatter

I have received nothing but compliments about the fine job of publishing done by Dave Kleiman on Everything 64. I am looking forward to seeing this issue in its final form ((blush)),

Local Games

There continues to be much ado about nothing concerning local games. Despite the hysterics of a small 'zine type publisher, it is not my policy that any game with two local players is a "local game". However, it is my suggestion that GM's not have two or more local players. Furthermore, I suggest that there be no player local to the GM. The reason is quite simple. It completely eliminates all complaints concerning "local" games and any hard feelings about whether anybody gained any kind of advantage because they were closer to their ally or GM. It also encourages hobby members to circulate through several 'zines from different parts of the North American continent rather than to become isolated pockets. It would allow a little more detached and professional attitude by both GM's and players. The majority of complaints I see arise from personality conflicts between or against players and GM's who are personally and/or geographically close to one and another. GM's who organize such games are taking on an unnecessary liability. My advice to GM's is to keep your players geographically well separated from each other and yourself.

In E63 and E64 I stated that I would consider complaints in games where two players were local, if it could be shown that an unfair advantage was gained by their proximity. This announcement has resulted in numerous arguments that it is a poor policy and would create more problems than it solved. I have been convinced of my error and now must retract my earlier statements. I will not consider a game for a "local" ruling based on two players being local. I suggest that GM's not have two local players. Fortunately, no complaints have been received since that announcement and no rulings made.

The events of the past few months have made increasing demands on my time and energy. This summer I have found little time or energy to devote to the BNC, or even to the few games that I still participate in. Thus I am prompted to make the following call:

Comments on Game Regularity

((The following eight circumstances originally appeared in Everything 53 published in August 1982 and was written by Don Ditter, then BNC. These remain the standard for considering games to be other than rateable. The only change I made is in #1 - Local Games. I added "or are within local phone call" since in New York City it is possible to be in different area codes, but still have local phone service.))

In the past when I labeled a game "irregular" I was expressing my opinion that the game should not be used in a play-by-mail non-variant Diplomacy rating system. This was my interpretation of the role past BNCs played regarding irregular games. However, I have learned that some rating systems use games declared irregular, while others decided that the rateability of any game is properly determined by the rating masters.

Henceforth, I will not use the name IRREGULAR in end game summaries, but will identify games that might not be rateable with a # sign. All rating masters should use their own judgment about which games should be included in their rating systems.

The following is a list of circumstances that I would include the # sign in the endgame stats:

- 1) LOCAL GAME -- Three or more players have the same telephone area code or are within local phone call service. Computer network games are also noted as local.
- 2) FAMILY MEMBERS IN GAME -- Two of the eight people involved in the game (7 players and 1 GM) are related. Relationships I would flag are: brothers, sisters, mother, father, aunts, uncles, spouses and other blood relatives that may prejudice a game.
- 3) GROSS GM VIOLATIONS -- The GM's methods discriminating against one or more players. The player claiming the violation must show inconsistent GM treatment with all players or a house rule or rule book violation. A game where a GM ignored an agreed upon ombudsman's ruling would be labeled gross GM violation.
- 4) ILLEGAL PLAYER REMOVAL -- A GM removes a player for strictly personal reasons assuming the player hasn't been overly obnoxious to the GM.
- 5) INCONSISTENT STANDBY POLICY -- A GM decides whether or not to use standbys. However, whatever decision is made must be used consistently throughout the game. If a GM assigns standbys to a 3+ power, all 3+ powers should have been appointed standbys.
- 6) A PLAYER HAS PLAYED TWO POSITIONS IN GAME -- The same player plays two different countries in the life of a game either simultaneously or as standbys. The significance of the position will be taken into account if the same player is a standby twice in the same game.
- 7) GM IS A PLAYER IN THE GAME -- The GM is also a player in the game.
- 8) Other circumstances that I feel may affect the game's rateability (for example, the "anonymous standby policy").

Postal Standby Locator
