"Karel Alaric" is obviously a pseudonym; Charles has family he does not want threatened or hurt by the inevitable attacks, and he does not want his games or zines to suffer. Accordingly he will either use a post office box, or receive mail o/s himself or one of his other friends. He is or has been involved under the name "Karel Alaric" in publications with John Boardman, myself, and former publishers including Raymond Heuer, Robert Lipton, and William Seligman; I don't know about his contacts elsewhere.

## THE COVENANT

submitted for registration by Karel Alaric,  
Miller Number Custodian under the Covenant,  
starting 1 January 1966

The Miller Number Custodian is an independent hobby officer responsible for the assignment of numbers for postal zones of diplomacy variants.

No group has any control over the Custodian.

Control of the staff of the Miller Number Custodian rests fully with the Custodian. The Director of Urban Zones, the Registrar of Known Game Openings, and the variant bank directors shall serve as Associate Custodians.

Should the office of Custodian fall vacant without any designated successor or should the Miller Number Custodian die, the office shall pass to the next Custodian. The Electorate shall consist of the independent hobby officers registered with the Registrar of Projects and the staff of the Custodian. The Electorate has the right to advise the Custodian.

Any addition or change to the Covenant, designation of successor, or succession shall be registered with the Registrar of Projects. The Registrar may require a neutral ratification on behalf of the hobby for any material change to the Covenant. A 2/3 vote of the Electorate, including 2/5 of the hobby officers eligible to vote, shall be sufficient to ratify changes.

The Custodian may only be removed by an impeachment for cause admitted by a judicial hearing convened by the Registrar of Projects after an independent investigation. Cause for removal shall be breach of the Covenant, or refusal or inability to assign or have an Associate Custodian assign a valid Miller Number on presentation of information commonly required for such assignment, either a consistent number or as a deliberate act against any person or group.

No Miller Number Custodian, nor any Associate authorized to assign Miller Numbers, will ever require payment or trade or other value as a prerequisite for the assignment of a Miller Number.

Notwithstanding any other provision, no person shall serve on the staff of the Custodian or the Electorate who does not recognize the Covenant, or who requires payment or trade or other value for the provision of the services of their office (but this shall not apply to subscriptions or the inexpensive sale of variants).

The Custodian is free to develop a system of denominators, but no radical change will be made in the Miller Numbers or system of denominators as developed except on the considered and reasoned advice of the Electorate to which the Custodian consents. No system of denominators shall be used which requires payment substantially in excess of postage and copying to obtain.

The Miller Number Custodian has full right to have published as the Miller Number 'zine the 'zine founded by Robert Sacks for that purpose, "Lord of Hosts", except for the personal coat-of-arms he used, but if the Miller Number Custodian should ever renounce the right of Hosts, all rights to publication as a private 'zine revert to Robert Sacks.
