## 'Irregular' Symbol Returns

I have been persuaded that there is still a definite need for a prefatory symbol to denote certain games as 'irregular.' Previous custodians have used the symbol # for this purpose; as you know, when I took over I dropped the symbol except in a few rare cases.

However, I see now that I was precipitous. Therefore I am calling back the 'irregular' notation and will use it, in the future as well as retroactively, to indicate:

1. Five- and six-man games, if played under the rulebook.
2. 'Local' games. This includes telephone games where moves are published, games in which all players are confined to a single metropolitan district (normally determined by 'ZIP' code, with other aids to supplement if in doubt); and games in which moves are made in-person as long as they are made one season per in-person session and are published thereafter (otherwise, in-person games are not numbered at all). In the last connexion it is mentioned that I will normally decline to number an in-person game of any type unless and until it is demonstrated that there is a definite and distinct postal (not merely printed) aspect to the game.

However, the old symbol will not serve. Hereinafter, and for all applicable games in the past, the symbol will be changed from # to (). E.g., (1972-FV) denotes 'irregular.' The change of symbol is at the request of overseas Gamemasters who point out that the # symbol does not appear on foreign typewriters.

A list of games in 1973 which have been assigned the irregular designation appears with this issue's newly-assigned numbers section.

Policy Change; Please Note: Up to this point it has been my desire to assure that the means to keep the Diplomacy Gamesmasterial ranks in touch and interacting were provided. Everything... was designed partially to serve this end, by the simple expedient of sending copies to all known Gamesmasters.

In general, I am still satisfied that this is a worthwhile endeavour. However, a small handful of GM's apparently do not care to partake of this means, at least to the extent that I and this journal represent a catalyst. Well, that's fine and good, and they are certainly entitled to operate this way -- after all, in ultimate terms, who the hell am I?

On the other hand, this thing costs me money, and I am no longer willing to throw money away on those Gamesmasters who either refuse to establish contact with me, or - worse yet - say they will but don't. Beginning next issue any and all GM's in either of these categories will be dropped from the mailing list. New Gamesmasters will receive three issues before they join the group.

At this writing there are three such individuals: Dix, Henning and Reinsel.

A similar system will apply to Gamesmasters whose publications seem to be defunct; however, application of this system will be handled on an individual basis.

(Definition: 'Establish contact' means 'provide the means to compile statistical information on active games as they proceed.' Magazine issues sent in large bunches meet this test; mere final summary sheets do not.)

Report On The Orphan Games Project

It is my pleasure to report that there is not a single orphan game left! Nice though this is to know, there is a certain embarrassment in the fact. I have sent out several calls recently for volunteers to take several games thought to be viable; many responses were received, but none of the games could be saved (which I hadn't expected at all). I thus apologise to the generous individuals who were kind enough to offer their aid, and add withal my profound thanks.

Naturally this 'no orphan' situation cannot last. It never does. In fact, several games are now under scrutiny as possible orphans, to wit:

Stoned, 3 games, has in effect published only once since last summer. It is almost certain that the games are orphans. Arrangements are in the works.

SANTA, 4 games, is long overdue, and the yelps from the players are getting louder. One of the four is known to have ended; the other three are being investigated.

Lomokome, 2 5-man games plus variants, is probably not dead. The editor recently moved and may be having trouble sorting things out. The Orphan Games Project, however, remains 'Auf dem Anstand.'

Erehwon and the other Walker 'zines were supposedly cleared up long ago. However, it appears that fees were collected and a full roster achieved for a new game that never started. Normally such 'unbegun' games are not handled by the Project, but in this case, in deference to several friends, the Orphan Games Honcho will resolve the matter - i.e. run the game, or have it run.

La Guerre poses a strange problem. Though considered orphans, the four games in this notoriously erratic journal are supposedly going to continue under the original auspices. However, a great number of the players in these games requested that the Project conduct a vote to transfer these games elsewhere; the vote is now in progress.

Other recent efforts by the Project have met with rather mixed success. The greatest success was the resolution of the matter of John McCallum's two games, which we thought we had under control last November only to discover in January that they were still languishing. Both were transferred. The World News games didn't fare as well, only about a third of them surviving the ravages of time and abandonment. More devastated yet was Omnifarious, from which only one game came out alive, and that barely so. The seven-game La Guerre tourney that was investigated could not realistically be saved, and was buried. The Smerch game likewise was peacefully interred. Games in Protocol and Ma turned out not to be orphans after all; The Voice game seems to be possible of salvage only by its original GM, who keeps promising; Carpetbagger, as you all know, was a serious mistake on my part - not only weren't the games orphans, they weren't even late!

So the perils of Orphanization run their ups and downs. Further reports will be provided as applicable.
