## BNC COMMENTS

First, let me thank all of you who are helping to clear out the BNC files of old games. It has not and will not be an easy task and anything that can make things go easier is much appreciated. Expect another push along these lines to come again shortly.

Finances/(Subs/Trades) - I regret to report that the Everything mailing list was full of a lot of dead wood; some of this has already been removed. Some more will with the next issue. On trades, I would encourage each and every publisher to trade with Everything for it is the only way I can keep track of what's going on in the hobby (and yes, I do try to read what I get); however, if you are a trader I do expect to get something now and then! On subs, non traders will have to pay for the full cost of sending them an issue, in this case the cost of \$0.75. You must remember that Melinda and I will be setting the cost in advance, some issues you may get a break, others we may; but in the long run we will average out. On your label you will find a \$\$ value if you are a subscriber; as long as you have a positive balance you will get an issue, a negative or -0- balance means this is your last copy.

(Contributors) - It has been common practice to ask for a contribution of \$1 per game request - this is not a mandatory practice. As such we suffer from 2 areas: (1) \$1 was set back when a dollar was worth \$1.99 and (2) about 30% of the requests come sans contribution. It should take no mathematician to figure this can't last indefinitely. Also, if you do wish to contribute to the BNC, please feel free to do so, but also please, if you must attach strings to your donation do not waste yours and my time.

1986 Report - We are somewhat solvent for now. In the future I plan to reinstate the listing of those who contribute and the amount of their contribution. There are no plans to cut back anything due to cost; the office will function normally.

State of the Hobby - We still seem to be in a general state of decline, starting less than 100 games for the first time since 1970. There are various reasons being blamed for this state of affairs: lack of support from Avalon Hill, lack of cohesion among hobby functionaries, lack of enough good GMs, lack of appropriate hobby promotions...take your pick / and now that you've taken your pick perhaps something can be done to "cure" your particular cause.

(Litigation) - Though I do have a rather nice litigation problem brewing at the moment, it has been a rather quiet state of affairs since assuming this

office last September. So, there isn't a whole lot to put here. I will relate the one problem that came up...

BNC and the requirement of initial player addresses before assigning a #. It is my policy to require this information for the following reasons: (1) to verify that the players are spread far enough apart to avoid being a local game, (2) to be able to verify on request that a player in a game is a real person, and (3) to have a working base to contact the players in the event their zine folded. A couple of postal GMs balked at this requirement but could not come up with a reason why such information could not be sent. So the requirement remained in place. This would be for a postal game of Diplomacy. For those games designated as E-mail games, the provision was waived before my time and that will continue due to their different format.

(Questions and Answers) - The topic of reserved BNCs has come up several times. First let me review which numbers are available to North America: A-AZ, CA-CZ, HA-IZ, KA-LZ, PA-QZ, TA-UZ. Second, let me state that I have contacted a couple of past BNCs who have told me reserved #s would be a royal pain in the posterior to bookkeep. However, I shall try for one year, a compromise. A GM may reserve a GM for a game, within the #s listed above at a cost (as opposed to contribution) of \$3 - the first come first served. I will adjust my records to accommodate this. If after one year it really does screw me up or if interest is so slight to be worthless, the policy will be automatically eliminated.

The topic came up about whether I would encourage or discourage players from playing under GMs using the "prophetic retreat" houserule. As the regularity of the rule was already made on the rule itself, it is not my place to tell anyone how to play. If you like this HR, play with it; if not, play somewhere else -- you're playing the game, not me.

#### PUBLISHER COMMENTS
