BNC Comments

We have several corrections (noted below). I appreciate everyone who has brought these to my attention. Hopefully, we will be getting these reduced to a minimum. In the meantime, all your help is appreciated.

Litigations

1985CB - players/stats included in this issue

"The positions given are for Fall '07, the season with which the draw proposal was submitted. Winter '07 and Spring '08 were played because my house rules allow the game to continue while anyone who failed to vote gets another chance. When the draw was proposed in F'07, Don Tinker was England, but he NMR'd. Jack Fleming took over for Don in W'07/S'08 when the not-yet-decided proposal was continued. Should Jack get credit for the draw because he submitted the final orders and because Don NMR'd out, or should Don get credit because the game officially ended (retroactively) before he was replaced? I'm listing Don, but the BNC can list whoever he wants. (Note: Maybe I'll change the house rule..)"

BNC - I have included this game in the litigation section because there seems to be some discussions in the hobby of late regarding draw/and or concession voting. Andy Lischett is a very good CM, but one with a complicated HR and a good dilemma because of it. Technically, you could probably argue the point either way and be right; in this case I would rule with Andy and award the draw to Don Tinker. 1) Neither of the players involved com-

plained. 2) Andy knows what was meant by this HR better than anyone else. 3) My own interpretation of the HR would be similar to Andy's in that I felt it meant he was allowing the NMRing player to vote again. I am glad Andy is reconsidering this house rule, and I would hope that all GMs who are (or have) contemplating making very complicated HRs to placate NMRing players reconsider that effort, as you can see complicated situations can arise and I can't see the creation of situations, even if "they can never happen", that must eventually fall into the lap of an ombudsman or the BNC. It is the player's responsibility to submit moves, which I interpret to mean make sure the moves are in the GM's possession; a "vote" is a move, no more, no less, and it is the player's responsibility to vote when required.

1985CG - This was one of the nicer litigations where the GM and I came to the same decision although at somewhat different times. It was the W/S 1904 turn. Right before the due date the Italian player resigned "with maximum venom", due to a personal conflict with the GM, leaving the GM with an open Italian position. The GM processed the Winter 1903 turn with this stipulation: "I will, of course, return his sub fee immediately, despite the fact that I am on a tight budget these days. What this means for this game is that we need a new ITALY, and the newcomer will not get his build, unless I can appeal to the rest of the players to uphold the game balance by the following solution: I will send all players this copy of the results and the new position except for the new Italian player. The new Italian player will receive only the game reports up to Fall 1903 and will be asked to make his build, as well as conditional orders for Spring 1904. If any player disagrees with this arrangement, the Italian player's build will not be used, and he will have to play a unit short...I am giving the players and the GNC the veto on this."

BNC Reply - "With due apologies to Claude ((the SB player)) and with the knowledge of what this would do to his SB position, as BNC I would exercise the option you gave me to veto this proposal. While I am sure the players in this game are mature enough to try not to conduct diplomacy what would affect the Italian build, you do not specifically request it that I could see. Also, it would be very hard for the rest of the players to conduct diplomacy for the Spring moves without discussing what Claude will build. This puts an undue strain for even the most mature of players. Also, on a more general level, the policy of allowing one player to make and/or change moves (this can be argued both ways) after the other player's moves have been published is, in my opinion, not consistent with the precepts of fair play, regardless whether the intentions were good. As such I cannot condone such procedures."

GM Reply (of sorts) - "...players will get a note saying the scheme I introduced won't be used. Funny: after reading over things a week later, I agreed with your reasoning. Thanx.

Epilog (BNC) - Again we see a good GM trying to mitigate the effects of an NMR and putting himself in a position where he is uncomfortable and a position where the integrity of the game could be at stake. I do urge all GMs to make every effort to avoid the NMR, but once it does occur, let it be, it is a part of the game.
