If you're not familiar with PONTEVEDRIA, it's a listing of postal Diplomacy (and other) game openings which is sent free to anyone requesting it. Mostly it goes to novice players, but many experienced players find it a handy place to find new games. I founded PONT in 1970, and it has been through many changes and vicissitudes since then. Now PONT will again be available without charge from me.

Please be assured that I will work hard to keep PONT accurate and current. Most of all, you have my promise that those who get PONT will find only useful hobby information. There will be no hobby politics, feuds, and other annoying distractions. I will continue the policy I've always had of providing game opening and informational listings without making PONT a feuding and/or political vehicle.

I'm writing because I need your help in keeping PONT on target. I'm enclosing a data form which you can fill out and return to me. Although I will be happy to print opening info from any reasonable source, I'd rather get my information right from the GM. Please copy the form, and send it to me whenever there's a change in your game openings. The information will be entered the day I get it in, and every issue of PONT sent out from then on will have the updated info.

Also enclosed is a copy of the current PONTEVEDRIA as it stands now. If you're listed, and any information therein is inaccurate, let me know as soon as you can. I've tried to include anyone about whom I can find any information anywhere.

Please note that PONTEVEDRIA also lists standby openings. If you have no game openings as such, but need standby players, the enclosed form will help you tell me about that too.

I plan to work toward creating good visibility for PONT, and good demand for it. Please also give us a plug with your readers.

Thanks for your help. I'm looking forward to hearing from you.

**WHO:** People (can you call Diplomacy players people?) who want to play Diplomacy. Or, if you're from out of town, people who want to play Diplomacy and see Toronto, not necessarily in that order (I'm thinking of some spouses here!).

**WHY(HOW-KUM):** To meet some of the names you've heard about in face-to-face or postal varieties of Diplomacy. To try your hand at beating the best. And, to be involved in an 'International Diplomacy Tournament Ratings' sanctioned event. Or, just to win the tournament on a best, three game total point scoring system. (BNC: Having just completed Larry Peery's Hobby History: the 80s project, I find myself left with a ton of data handy and quite a few people who would like to see Everything be, uh, a little less dry, read: Boring. So, for the totally bored reader, remember, you asked for it)

#### Dip Statistics and general country strengths:

When dealing with inherent country strengths and end game results, we have, over the years, been concerned (perhaps overly) with the 'win' as the criteria for a country's starting strengths. Yet, despite this belief, we all know a 'win' is not necessarily the end result of a Diplomacy game -- there are (shudder!) also 'draws'. Yes, folks, 'draws': there are such things as stalemate lines, players who play for alliance endings, and people in 4 center countries that realize an outright win may be a bit much to hope for. So, let us then consider the statistics of 'drawing' countries, and using the two-player draw as an example find out what happens when you don't 'win'.

First, let me present the following table that lists two-player draws from the games (ended of course) of the 80s:

(Also, I suppose I should include a win list in case you haven't seen it elsewhere, this would be: A(30) E(45) F(45) G(36) I(38) R(61) T(50) )

Now comes the part where I can use these statistics to say whatever I want, and I must be right. After all, I have statistics to back me up.

Austria) A lot people say Austria sucks dead rats because you can't win with the darn thing; well, I've got news for you, you can't draw with it either. Not only can't you draw with the thing, you actually stand a better chance proportionally-speaking to win. When you get this dog, you'd best put the west on the back burner for despite the standards of WAR-GAL, and VEN-TRI, your future lies with Russia or Italy. Good luck, you're going to need it.

England) England comes off these stats looking like the proverbial street-cleaner. Flip a coin - pick either F or G, then casually sweep the remaining SCs into your respective baskets...just like clockwork. In fact, once EF or a EG established itself, the rest of the board ought to just surrender, rather than waste everyone's time.

France) Of course you must now realize, France was put on the board solely for those people who don't want to win. No, I don't mean don't want to play; I mean don't want to win. If you're here you're an alliance player...OK, so you may back into a win, but let's face it you'll play alliance with most everyone (except of course Austria, but then nobody wants to ally with Austria anyway). Enjoy yourself, make a few friends, and have a good time.

Germany) As a central power, you're going to get caught up in the east-west thing. Obviously you must convince either E or F, or both, that you really, really, really are a western power - let's face it, over half your draws come from their side. Of course you could always opt for the historical alignment (A-I-T), I mean someone somewhere actually did draw with these two combos, just let me know so I can sign up for E/F.

Italy) Based on the relatively even numbers of draws across the board, it would appear you'll ally with just about anyone; unfortunately for you, no one else really cares. "I came, I saw, I drew" does not apply here, you are an obstacle more than an ally. Again as with Austria, good luck.

Russia) You're here because like the French player, you like to be around for the end of the game; unlike the French player you may actually win a few. As for draws, it doesn't matter you're equally suited to go with any, anytime. Somebody best nail you early while they still can.

Turkey) Ah, here is where stats can be deceiving. Why? Because we can't list your best allies: boardside A and boardside B, though they might show up more in the win column. Your best ally is Russia and you ought to be able to sweep the board just like England; unfortunately some dunderhead stuck Italy right in the way. I suppose you could always ally with Italy, but then why should you, no one else is. Take heart though you may not draw as much you do win a lot, just try not to be so bored - take an interest in the game for god's sake.

In conclusion, I'd like to make some earth-shattering revelation about Dip statistics: just give me a chance I'll think of something in a while - I'm old and the mind don't work like it used to.
