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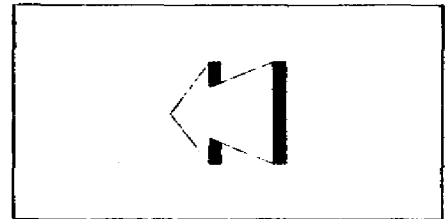


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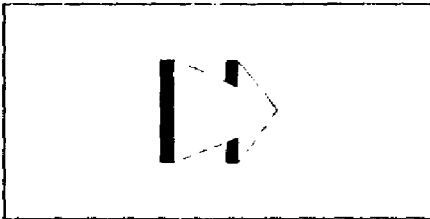

Contents may be reprinted with appropriate attribution.

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BNC COMMENTS - There has been some confusion as to how the numbers will be administered in the remaining time I am BNC. Simply, to do an accurate and (for me) efficient job with the office, I will officially "batch" number requests roughly, but not exceeding, every two (2) months. Even in the most stringent 'zine, this should mean no game will pass 1901 without a number. If that does occur, please re-request your number as it is an indication that I may not have your request.



There has been a question aised as to the potential "double-issuing" of numbers if a publisher folds and the game is rehoused through the Orphan Service. This is simply a non-issue. The assigning process would catch any requests for a new number for a game started in another 'zine, even if the BN was never received or the new GM wasn't aware of it unless the game is presented as a NEW gamestart. If this occurs, it doesn't matter how the number was originally assigned because the game is being represented as new and therefore the worst case scenario would leave the other number as abandoned. By the way, this has generally been my method for the last 6 months and with few exceptions has caused no consternation. Lastly, while this is the method I will use, by no means do I feel this policy is set in stone. Indeed, whatever works for future BNC's to regularly and accurately report starts and finishes and handle correspondence, litigations, questions, etc., I leave to them.



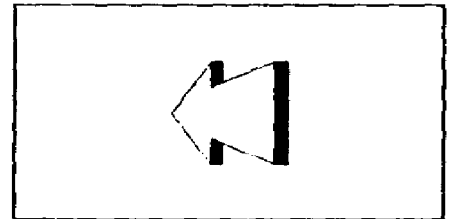
PUBLICATIONS AVAILABLE FROM THE BNC

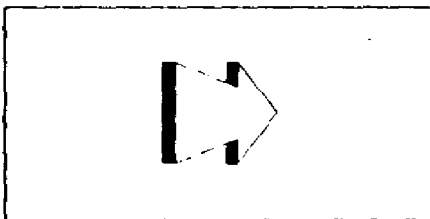

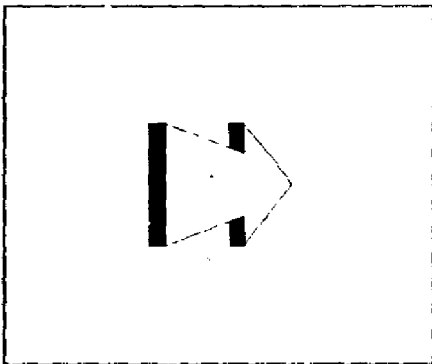
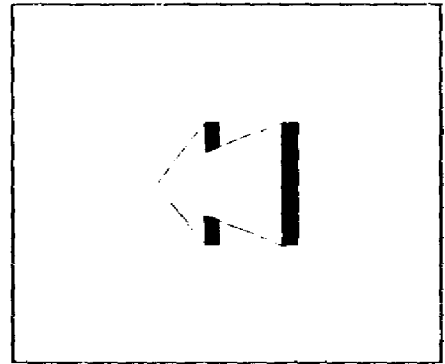

STATE OF THE BNC, FINANCES

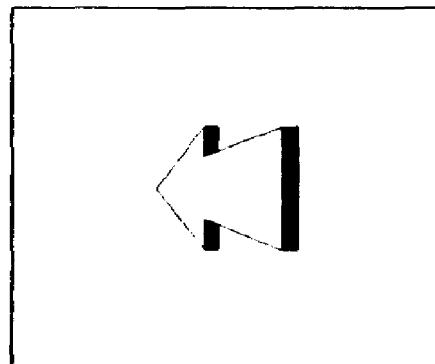

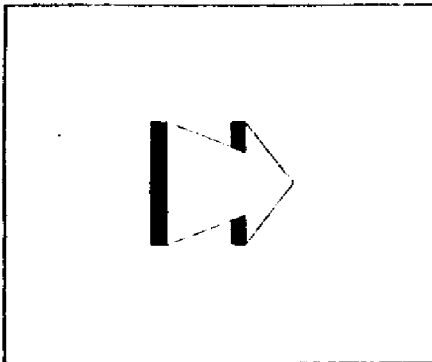

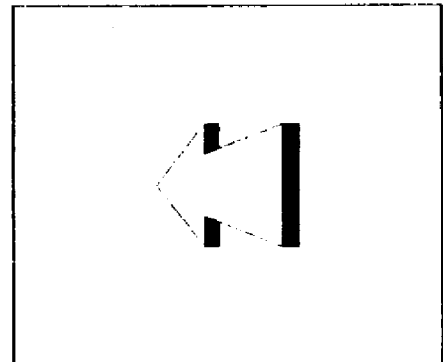
GAME FINISHES

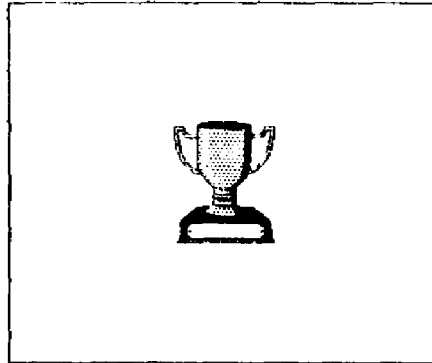
Reported games in 1991 were 97, which is up from 75 in 1990. I expect we may actually see more games end in 1992 than begin as we come out of this "orphanitis".
