PUBLISHER'S COMMENTS - I have enjoyed working with Gary (as I have enjoyed working with past BNC's). Putting together something as diverse as EVERYTHING... takes quite an effort. I have been very fortunate that my "partners" have been excellent to work with. I am looking forward to working with Vince who is bringing a lot of enthusiasm to this job.

PUBLICATIONS AVAILABLE FROM BNC - EVERYTHING... back issues available at the rate of \$2.00/issue plus \$0.50 postage per issue. Currently, there is one complete set of back issues ready to ship (E1-E85) at a bargain rate of \$150.00, post paid! If you're a readings master of just a numbers kinda' guy/gal, this is available for a limited time only, first come first served.

GM HELPER SHEET is available free for the asking. Please note, each new gamestart is recorded on this form and is the vehicle that the Boardman number is assigned and sent to the GM. This is a baldface attempt to help standardize the recording and reporting of each game.

UPDATES, CORRECTIONS, ETC. - 90HY was erroneously labeled a PBEM finish in E..85. This is a regular PBM.

The following have been reported as abandoned: 83HX, 88R, 91CC.

TRADES - Please check with Vince on starting/continuing trades. There is a misnomer that the BNC receives every zine, and it simply is not true. If you don't send it, the BNC won't see it. Publishers, it is up to you to keep this office up to date with new game requests and game ends. Also, it is beneficial to draw attention to your requests/ends! Effective immediately, transfer all E... trades to Vince Lutterbie (1021 Stonehaven, Marshall MO 65340).

LITIGATIONS - Weiss "Variant" has been determined to be available for a BN but will always be labeled "irregular" due to the draw stipulation in the victory conditions.

GAME STARTS - There were only 52 reported gamestarts for 1992. This is a surprisingly low number not helped by the silence of the E-Mail hobby. Typically, they will account for a minimum of 25 requests. In addition, Conrad von Metzke has come across a second E-mail group that to date has not requested numbers. Consequently, play of Diplomacy is not in decline. However, as the 52 gamestars indicate, the postal side of the hobby is at an all-time low.

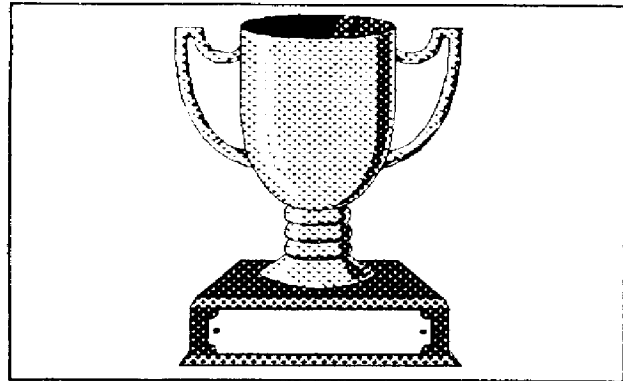
GAME FINISHES - There were 75 reported game finishes for 1992. This is down from 97 in 1991 and the same in 1990. The lack of PBEM games reported kept this figure down. Expect a sizeable increase in 1993 if the PBEM hobby reports in.

WINS BY COUNTRY - There were 43 solo wins reported for 1992. This is quite an increase over the 39 out of 99 wins in 1991. As only 75 game finishes were reported, this represents roughly a 20% increase!

England and France were the big winners followed by Germany! Russia's downward trend continued. Surprisingly, however, the West and not Turkey seem to be the beneficiaries.

STATE OF THE HOBBY - It doesn't take 1992 stats and finishes for the hobby in general to know we've been in a period of postal decline. Fortunately, we can look to the E-mail hobby for the short-term influx of new players and gamestarts. Diplomacy is far from dead, but the reality is our hobby will now become a blend of postal, E-mail, and F-T-F. We can either embrace it or let it fracture our organized hobby.

Opinions are many and varied and sometimes lead to entertaining discussion and reading, but I've become less than receptive to a lot of sniping and so-called "constructive" criticisms from those who do not do anything, but feel they must comment on what is done by others.

In an attempt to boost the overall Diplomacy population, Rex Martin (at DipCon XXV in Kansas City) outlined Avalon-Hill's plan for Diplomacy and looked for ideas and volunteers to help bring it to fruition. David Hood agreed to be a liaison with Avalon-Hill. Cal White took the bull by the horns to update his flyer (now on the back of the new rulebook) and head (write, coerce, etc.) the new Gamer's Guide. I agreed to be the "new players'" contact. We subsequently went to 5 regional contacts (or ambassadors to PBM Dip if you will). At this writing, Cal is closing in on the final touches of the rough lay-out for Rex. I'm proud of the small part I've played in putting this together and feel the results of this effort, born at DipCon XXV, will positively impact the hobby for years to come. The hobby in general owes a debt of gratitude to Rex, Cal, and David. But this project will NOT be the end fo the hobby support that is needed. It is up to all of us to contribute by playing, subbing, writing, and publishing. Without participation, this hobby will end and much sooner than you would think.

I believe the biggest threat to this participation is the numbing effect of feuds and/or so-called "discussions". The most ridiculous to me is the never-ending debate over how and with what con (or none at all), where, tec., to hold DipCon! Invariably, the arguments center around number of players, quality of players, and recruitment of new players. I've heard it stated by a so-called Diplomacy enthusiast that he would never go to a Diplomacy only convention because it should always be held with Origins and the tens of thousands of gamers and games that would be there! I would think that a true proponent of the game would celebrate and encourage each and every opportunity to play the game! So, regardless of which con or group is awarded DipCon, why can't each con attempt to encourage and entice new players to our hobby? Simply, they can. In the future, leave out the argument on new player recruitment when it comes to DipCon. Let's make every gathering an opportunity to recruit!

Finally, the new Diplomacy flyer will generally be available soon from Avalon-Hill. If your event doesn't have seminars on play of the game, publishing, or even a zine bank, you can at least make the new Dip flyer available. Write Rex Martin at Avalon-Hill. I guarantee they won't be stingy.

Here is to the continued success of the Diplomacy hobby. May thousands more know the years of enjoyment of a game well-played, a plan well-executed, and stab well-implemented, and a letter well-written. I hope we all have many more years to enjoy this game and each other.

These Awards are designed to recognize those individuals who have contributed to our hobby during the past year. This is an excellent opportunity for you to show your appreciation for someone that has helped to increase your enjoyment of this hobby. All it takes is a few minutes of your time, but the recognition received by the nominee will be greatly appreciated.

Nominations are being requested for the following awards: (Please list the reason you have submitted your nomination. For the Walker Award, a copy of the article would be appreciated.)

**Don Miller Memorial Award** for hobby service. This is normally considered the most prestigious award. Past recipients have included some of the hobby's most distinguished members. The recipient should be one who has made a major contribution to the hobby in the past year. Ineligible: John Caruso, David Hood

**Rod Walker Award** for literary excellence. Designed to recognize the best article written and published within the past year, this award may be given for an individual or collaborative work. Ineligible: Garrett Schenck, Mark Berch

**John Koning Memorial Award** for outstanding play of Diplomacy. This may be for PBM, PBEM, ftf, or tournament play during the past year. Ineligible: Gary Behnen

**Melinda Holley Award** for general participation in the hobby. This award is designed to recognize those people who make this hobby so enjoyable and functional year in and year out. Ineligible: Kathy Caruso, Melinda Holley

Nominations in each category will be screened by a committee to reduce the list to five finalists in each category. These five finalists will then be presented to the Diplomacy hobby, with votes being solicited from each hobby member in each category. [In the past, there have been frequent complaints about the quality of the five finalists in certain categories. Each time this has occurred, only five nominations had been received for that particular award. If you would like to see more quality nominations on the final list, make a few yourself.]

Hobby members may make as many nominations as they desire. The only restrictions are that the winner of each award is ineligible to win that particular award the next two years, and the chairman of this committee is ineligible for all awards. While members of the Selection Committee may not nominate each other for any awards, other hobby members may. If this does occur, that member of the committee will not be permitted to vote in that category.

As with all awards, this one cost money. I would like to request a one dollar donation from each participant to help defray costs. If you can not, or do not feel compelled to do so, then don't. Your nominations, and later votes, will still be greatly appreciated. The quality and integrity of these awards will continue as they have been established by the previous Chairmen.
