Orphan Games Project: No room for a big update; not much to update anyway. However, I wish to announce at this time that, effective 30 June 1973, I will cease to function as Orphan Games Director. If there are any volunteers for assuming the mantle, please let me know; I'll help you in any way I can with advice, information, etc. But I can handle all this work no longer, so something must go, and the Orphan Project goes first. Any projects begun but uncompleted on 30 June will be finished by me.

Warning to volunteers: This is a thankless, expensive job which can be time-consuming in spurts. Be prepared.

Assistant Custodianship: Some time ago I appointed Fred C. Winter, P.O. Box 604, Madison, WI. 53701, as my back-up for the Boardman Numbers, to take over if I should have to step aside. Since that appointment I have kept in close touch with Fred at extremely frequent intervals; at the very least, I have sent him weekly reports of all numbering activity for the week.

It seems appropriate to remind all Gamesmasters that Fred's capacity is, insofar as I am concerned, official. Should you receive a notice from him to the effect that he has taken charge of numbering, you may consider it formal notice of his assumption of the Custodianship under terms previously agreed upon by us and outlined in this magazine. I respectfully reiterate my request for full co-operation with him in such event.

In addition, I have - for obvious reasons - kept close tabs on Fred's performance in this capacity (yes, he does have work to do!), and my opinion is this: He has done a superb job, far surpassing any expectations I had when I created the position. My confidence in my selection has, if anything, increased tenfold in these past months.

Without overdoing it, let me give you a prime example. Several weeks ago I purposely 'forgot' to mail one weekly report; this was a sort of test of the air-raid sirens. Fred's response was masterful; precisely tuned to the schedule we had agreed upon, with a large amount of extra effort (but not broadcast all over creation, thus not alarming anyone prematurely) and expense on his part. I also felt a distinct pride in having created a new, untested position in this hobby and seeing my choice to fill it prove so successful.

And so I can honestly say to any doubting Thomases who remain unconvinced: former Senator Stephen M. Young of Ohio was quite right; someone has been writing crank letters over your signatures....

More seriously, as a matter of fact I am also gratified at the comments and discussions, both positive and negative, that I've gotten. It shows decisively that many of you care very much about this work, and that there is aid available if needed. That's nice to know.
