BNC Comments

Things are progressing quite nicely on the BNC front. This issue is a month late in hitting the mails; however as you were all notified, this was unavoidable due to personal circumstances. I expect the next issue to be sent out at the end of June per the planned schedule. Please have all materials to me by June 15th for inclusion.

Contact with the EMail Dip Community is increasing. As is reflected in the game starts/ends CompuServe and America On-Line are registering all (or almost all) of their games. Of course, on the Internet proper, Nick Fitzpatrick handles all BNC duties and issues numbers for them. A short article from Nick is included to report on what's going on the information superhighway.

Delphi has only a few games going, as best I can tell. So far those GMs haven't been interested in getting BNs. On Prodigy, the contacts I've written to haven't responded so I'm not sure what is going on there. Current discussions are underway with GMs on GENie; however, they are interested in having an EMail version of *Everything* before they'll seriously consider getting BNs. I'm looking into this possibility.

Enclosed is a copy of the latest version of the "GM's Helper". I've added another small change at the request of one researcher. They would like the issue number of the gamestart and the endgame. I'll start noting those next time. Of course some of you (those on AOL in particular) do not have issue numbers but that won't be a problem. Any other requests or suggestions for improvements are quite welcome and encouraged.

GAME STATS

Since the last issue of *Everything*, there were 49 Boardman Numbers (23 in 1994; 26 in 1995) issued including orphans and past games first submitted. 37 endgames have been reported; along with two revisions and one abandoned game.

Everything.... is the Journal and official record of the Boardman Number Custodian. It was founded in October 1972 to promote and record the postal play of the game Diplomacy. This issue of *Everything*... was compiled and edited by the BNC W. Andrew York (POB 2307; Universal City TX 78148; USA). INTERNET DIPLOMACY

Andrew York has asked me, as Internet BNC, to write a year-end summary for Everything. (Perhaps I can encourage him to send me a copy one day, I have yet to see if it really exists!). *<You'll get this issue, I've not seen a request for one from you, so it must have been one of the previous administrations?>*.

A long time ago, when Internet Diplomacy was all adjudicated by hand, everything revolved around Eric Klien, who in 1988 and 1989 obtained BN's for his games. From then until 1993 no Internet games were given Boardman Numbers. In late 1993 Lee Kendter asked me to do the job of E-mail MNC. At that point MN's were assigned to all 1993 variant games. In late December 1993 Vince Lutterbie, the former BNC, agreed to my request to also become an E-mail BNC, or Internet BNC. (CompuServe, AOL, etc, still get BN's directly from Andrew York).

So in January 1994, I started out with 156 available numbers, in blocks from 1994KA. (Later Andrew added an additional 52 numbers up to 1994ZZ). At this point (late January) I have handed out 184 numbers for 1994 (and 9 for 1995). All but 3 of these numbers are for games run on a Diplomacy 'judge' (a piece of software that co-ordinates games, determines results, etc. There are currently 6 major ones publicly running on the Internet.)

By comparison 304 Miller Numbers (MN's) were given out to E-mail games in 1994, though 176 of these were either for gunboat (rb32) or partial-press gunboat (rb104).

To date 78 of the games with BN's have already been completed (including 3 that were abandoned; 2 in 1902 and 1 in 1910). 7 additional games that were in process on a judge in Australia may also be declared abandoned due the loss of that judge in the summer. Real game times on the judges tend to be much shorter than in the traditional postal game. Deadlines are typically 72 hours, though they can vary between 30 minutes to 2-3 weeks.

Of the 74 results, 27 were solo wins, 7 were 2-way draws, 26 were 3-ways, 7 were 4-ways, 6 were 5-ways and 1 was a 6-way. The average game lasted until 1910 (the mean was 1909, the mode was 1908). The longest game lasted until 1927.

I don't have the number of players who participated at hand. (Mostly because no-one records who the players are in a database until the game is completed.) However the number of different players who participated in any Diplomacy game (variant and standard) ending in 1994 was 1436 people. (this probably includes about 20-30 duplicates in the database and people who were only in the 2 or 3 AOL and GENIE games that are in the database). Probably over 1400 different players in 385 games. (With 492 total game starts in 1992, and 385 game ends, the trend of a growing Internet Diplomacy hobby can be seen. Another example is the 32 total game starts last January, compared with 44 in the first 28 days of January 1995.)

A log file of all the Internet BNs is available by FTP from the machine sunburn.uwaterloo.ca as the file bnc.log in /pub/nick/diplomacy. (Similarly the MNs are in a file called mnc.log) This file is continuously updated.

Detailed summaries are available for all these games from me on request (nick@sunburn.uwaterloo.ca), and many are available from the judges they were played on by issuing sending the E-mail message summary gamename (where gamename is the name of the game) to the relevant judge.

This GM helper is designed to assist you in reporting games to the BNC. Please keep good records.

This report has 2 parts:

1. The zine, GM, player section.
2. The supply center chart.

Zine, GM, player section:

A proper report should have the following information:

1. The game number- if the GM does not request one, any player may do so. Please keep all numbers in upper case as lower case involves variant games.
2. The zine and GM.
3. Game date when either the GM or zine changed hands.
4. Repeat 2 & 3 for further changes.
5. Player reports by country- usually Austria is listed first. The original player is listed, then immediately, their result and the season their result occurred. The result should be one of the following:
 - Win: if the player won the game. If by gaining 18 centers or more, then the date would be Fall __ (__ = the game year). If the win is by concession, then use the season the vote occurred.
 - Draw: the date is the season the vote took place.
 - Sur: This is for surviving or surrender. Same date as win or draw date.
 - Out: The Fall __ when the SC count = 0.
 - Res: Resigned = the season last played by that player.
 - Rem: Removed from the game by GM, the season is announced.
 - Drop: If the player is removed for repeated NMRs, use the date before the new player took over.
6. Repeat 5 for each player called. Note that CDs are treated as standbys.
7. Repeat 5 & 6 for the other 6 countries.

This supply center situation has a few complications. If the game ends in a Spring season, revert to the last Fall supply center count, SCs gained that Spring do not count since the Fall season was not played. Please indicate who Won, Drew, Survived, etc. It will save me a lot of work.

Some other helpful items:

- * = player did not build a unit entitled to during the Winter.
- + = player did not build two units entitled to during the Winter.
- ! = player did not build three units entitled to during the Winter.
- \$ = player did not build 4 units entitled to during the Winter.
- % = player did not build 5 units entitled to during the Winter.
- & = player did not build 6 units entitled to during the Winter.

(Judges are listed in the log file). In addition a complete history of the games (as seen by an Observer, including all general broadcast press messages and results) are available from the judges.

And so ends 1994. The Internet is continuing to grow, by some estimates by 10% every month. The Diplomacy community is also growing. In the middle of January there were over 250 listed games on the public judges. (in addition there are unlisted games, which might be private, or just not publicized for a few days or weeks while various issues are resolved.) This will probably peak at a record of over 300 by spring before dropping off in the summer.
