I apologize for this royal mess.

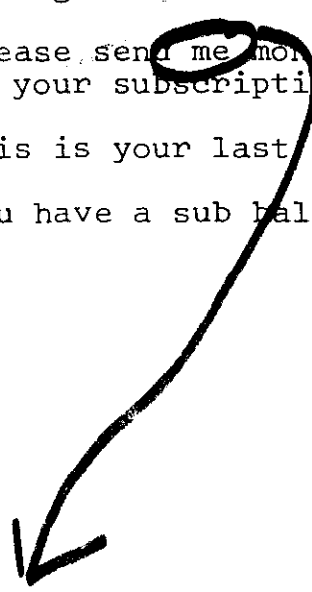

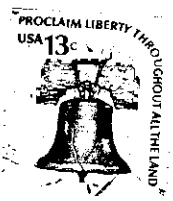
