

Games will not be formally announced until: (1) New postal rates are known; (2) FANTASIA games have been incorporated into DPBA; and (3) revised rules have been published and distributed. GM Note (again) -- Just received Pulsipher's orders (day after deadline -mailed 18th); am not going back to pick them up now, as (1) they would have made no difference in the outcome of the game; and (2) they were essentially the same as those made by the stand-by player. FNI (Scotice Scripti) -- NATIONS PLAN STRATAGIES AS OUTBREAK OF WAR IS INMINENT!

The Rules -- A couple of questions have been raised re the rules, which indicate places where clarifications are needed. (1) Re neutral centers. A neutral center in this game is the same as one in Regular Diplomacy (except that they are within the boundaries of the warring powers rather than separate). Before any of them may be raised to support the building of a new unit, it must first be captured via its occupation by a unit at the end of a Fall move, complete with retreats. And, with the exception of the three centers noted in Rule #5, once captured they may not have units built in them. And only F's may be built in the three centers indicated in Rule #5, once said centers have been captured and, for Mona and Dryfed, it is at least 1016. (2) Re formation and separation of A/F's. A/F may not be formed at sea; F must either be in or move to coastal province in order for army to board it. However, F in sea-province may either unload A into coastal province (e.g., given A/F Bristol Channel, A Bri-Mor; F Bri unloads A Bri-Mor) or support it into said province (e.g., A Bri-Mor: F Bri (S) A Bri-Mor). Note, however, that if an F at sea which is unloading A is attacked, unloading does not take place; if an F at sea which is supporting an A into an anchorage in Ire, or into a coastal prov. in a non-Irish nation, support is cut but landing still takes place (unless stood off). (This distinction is important, since an F may unload into a non-anchorage Irish province, but may not support into it.) Also note that an A/F, when attacking land, as unit or with F supporting A, has power of 2 units vs province being attacked; but it has force of only one unit as far as attacks against the sea-province from which attack is being launched is concerned.
