

You, South, receive the diamond queen lead against your four spade contract. Since you have but four winners in the plain suits, you will need to take six trump tricks to bring the contract home. One possibility is to ruff two of your minor suit losers in dummy. The problem with this approach is that there is only one high trump in dummy. You would have to risk ruffing low once. Should East be able to overruff, the contract would be in jeopardy. A better line is to ruff dummy's hearts in hand. This will succeed provided the side suit winners can be cashed safely. You should play: diamond king, heart ace, heart ruff, diamond ace, heart ruff, club ace, heart ruff, diamond ruff with the ten, heart ruff. With the first nine tricks in the bag, you simply exit with a club or diamond. The defense will be unable to prevent dummy's remaining 8-5-2 of spades from scoring the game-going trick.
