I hope none of you are too frustrated by the delays you've been experiencing. Now that 1983AZ is firmly entrenched in *Frobozz*, we will proceed on a regular schedule. I'm reprinting the Fall, 1904 season below. Henceforth, deadlines will be every fourth week.

I've been asked about the names of the games. For the games that started in *Frobozz*, the house names were assigned by me. I get the names from things of interest to me. *Ragnarok* comes out of Norse mythology; it is the final battle of the gods. *Arrakis* should be familiar to science fiction buffs; it's the name of the planet better known as *Dune*. When a game is started, the Boardman Number Custodian is notified, usually by the GM. The BNC then assigns the number for the game. When the game ends, the BNC is again notified, so that the results can be published in the BNC journal, *Everything*.

About the code that appears after your name in the mailing address: Most of you will see an S followed by a number. This means you are a subscriber and your sub expires with the issue indicated by the number. If a T appears, it means we trade. If neither letter appears, this is the last issue you will receive unless you become a subber or trader.

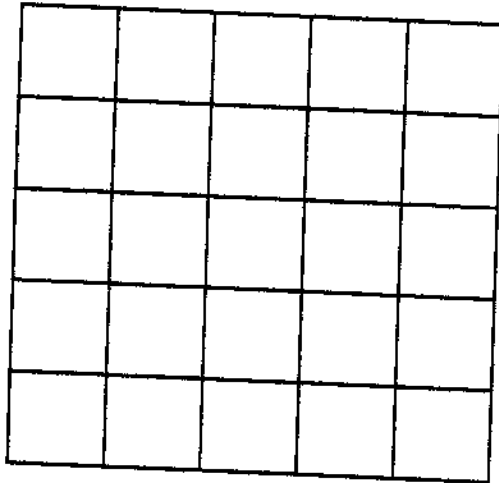

## Contest Puzzle

The Contest Puzzle has returned! This is your chance to win three issues of *Frobozz*. Fill in as many boxes as you can in the diagram below to form words crossword-style (reading across and down). Foreign words, abbreviations, contractions, slang, poetic, hyphenated, and capitalized words are not permitted. You may not use the same word twice. Scoring: Points are scored for each letter in the diagram. Initially, the score for a particular letter is the same as in Scrabble (see the table below). But in this puzzle, you score extra points for using a letter repeatedly. Each time you use a letter (anywhere in the puzzle), its value doubles. Thus, the word MUMMY is worth 26 -- the first M scores 3, the U is worth 1, the second M scores 6, the third M is 12, and the Y counts 4. If another M were to appear elsewhere in the puzzle, its value would be 24. Note that unlike Scrabble, a letter only scores once, even if the letter is part of two words (one horizontal and one vertical). The submitter of the highest score earns honor, glory, and three free issues of *Frobozz*. Deadline for this contest is Friday, July 27, 1984.
