Dealer South E-W vulnerable

Faced with a difficult choice of opening leads, you decide to try the three of hearts. Declarer plays low from dummy, and partner's queen wins the trick (South following with the six). Partner returns the deuce of clubs, and declarer follows with the five. Decide how you plan to defend before reading on.

Since South opened the bidding, he must hold the king of spades and the minor suit aces. And from the play to the first trick, you also know that South holds the ten of hearts as well. Thus, you can count nine tricks for the declarer: three spades, three hearts, two diamonds and one club. So, you can't afford to sit back and wait for tricks. Unfortunately, your wretched opening lead has removed partner's only entry, so you can't score enough club tricks to set the contract. You may, however, be able to disrupt declarer's transportation, preventing him from cashing all of his tricks. After winning partner's club lead with the queen, you must next lead the club king. You are hoping that partner started with at least J-9-3-2. South must allow your king to win (otherwise you will gain the lead with the heart ace in time to give your partner two further club tricks). Now that you have removed all of dummy's clubs, destroying that entry to the South hand, it is time to switch to the ten of spades. South's hand is:

♠ K 9 ♥ 10 6 ◊ A J 9 8 3 + A 8 6 5

No matter what South does, he will be unable to enjoy all of his nine tricks. If he wins the spade in hand and clears the king of diamonds out of the way, he can't get back to his hand for the diamond ace. And if he wins the spade in dummy

to clear the diamond king and return to the spade king, he will be unable to use dummy's hearts.
