Although there were fewer attendees this year, the Masked Ball was a colorful affair this year; M. Bic arrived with Mlle Josephine as the King and Queen of Hearts. M. Jardin and Mlle. Isabelle appeared as, respectively, a hummingbird and a fleur-de-lis, right out of the garden. M. Dubois spent lavishly on his bejeweled costume, but was far outspent by M. Van Rijn who walked away with the grand prize when he appeared as the river Loire complete with moveable fountains. He was accompanied by Mlle. Roxanne, dressed as a water nymph.

M. Van Rijn also won both marksmanship and horsemanship contests, the latter when M. Dolokhov, who was in the lead, attempted to stand in his saddle and fell from his horse knocking himself silly. M. - IN EUROPE

M. ROXY LaRUE discovers that the Paris police must mean business in their attempts to get Roxy off the streets of Paris and back to the jungles of Africa. It seems that Roxy's business has taken a sudden downturn. She did not raise any money this turn.

- IN AFRICA

Reports are that PROFESSOR O'FORAN did not shoot any of his camels last turn since he found water in the mountains. After refilling his canteens, he attempts to move on in direction 4 into hex 96, but becomes lost. He is able to convince his guide not to desert.

Pushing on into the desert proves to be a desperate move for DOCTOR HYPO GUY CEMIA. The good doctor heads south around the Sudd, only to discover more desert in hex 149, but there is an oasis in this hex. Feeling somewhat refreshed, he moves on, into hex 175, which is more desert, but this hex contains no oasis. Things look bleak for the good doctor, his bon-bons melted into one large chocolate lump by the desert sun. One camel must be shot to save the expedition from going without food.

ORTE'GO DE DAGO continues up the extension of the Ogove River moving from hex 213 into hex 214, which is a jungle hex. The river continues in direction 1, into hex 192. Dago is awed by the 180 ft. cataract which he must portage around. While attempting this portage, he is confronted by 24 warriors of the Kabinda Tribe. Dago approaches the Chief showing little fear, in a friendly open manner. The chief allows Dago to live, but demands that Dago offer him gifts of great value, for he is a great chief. Bearers of his tribe are so strong that they demand 5 gifts to hire on. Guides know the jungle so well they want 6 gifts to hire on. Their canoes are so well made they are worth more than any payment, but the chief will permit Dago to have one for 5 gifts. The chief tells Dago that the tribe will give him 3 rations for each gift.

It seems that determination was not enough for the RIGHT REVEREND TWOMBLY to march across hex 520. The swamp proved too much for him. He was forced to retreat to hex 521. While camped there, deciding what to do, one of his bearers is stung by a centipede and dies. Hoping to escape this hex, he tries to move NW into hex 501, which he discovers is a lake. Not being able to transverse the lake hex, he retreats back to hex 521 again, after finding no natives.

Headlines in the London papers are confusing as to what is happening with McGuffin's expedition. The headline in the London Times reads "McGuffin defeats slavers", byline McGuffin, while the headline in the Daily Mail reads "McGuffin instructs natives in strange rituals". The story describes McGuffin's hunting technique of lining up Askaris and marching across the veldt. McGuffin moves due west into hex 416. The rumors are that he is heading for the escarpment. Hex 416 is desert. Fortunately for McGuffin, it contains an oasis. Hunting in the desert proves most difficult. His hunters provide no rations for the expedition. McGuffin is heard to say "well, if things get difficult, we just shoot a bearer or two." McGuffin encounters a slave raiding party which dies in a hail of bullets. The party was heading inland, which is the only thing which saved innocent captives from being killed.
