CORRECTIONS TO THE LAST ZINE! On the special expertise, it should be noted that M. Bic is currently only proficient in Footrace(Doug - you got an extra point for winning) while M. Dolokov is proficient in both marksmanship and Horsemanship.

RULES Additions, Deletions, Modifications & Clarifications!

1) Henceforth a roll of 1 will always fail, not only in the courting of mistresses, but also in applying for appointments, granting of titles, winning contests(trip in foot race, costume too gaudy, etc), and in any other die rolls as deemed appropriate by the King.

2) Once a character has become a Duke, he may enter into intrigue to usurp the throne. The first step is to become the leader of a faction, then to become a pretender to the throne and finally grasp the crown itself. Each season a Duke may (but need not) roll 1 die. On a roll of 4-6 he has succeeded in becoming the leader of a faction, on a 2-3 there is no effect, on a 1 the character is brought to trial(it is considered treason) and may not use influence to affect the outcome(though other characters may do so if they wish). If he succeeds then he may continue to roll. On a 5-6 he has been recognized as a pretender, on a 2-4 there is no effect and on a 1 the character will be brought to trial and no influence whatsoever may be used one way or the other. If he is successful again, then he may continue to roll. On a 6 he has overthrown the King and will be crowned in his place. On a 2-5 there is no effect and on a 1 the character is automatically introduced to the hangman's rope unless it occurs after 1789, in which case his last dance will be with Madame Guillotine.

The King's social level becomes either that of the character but is always at least 3 levels above the next highest character and is never less than 21. The King receives 1000cr/month and makes appointments as indicated in the rules.

Be warned, however, that becoming King may also bring a package in the mail containing all of the game information, from the current King, and the game will be all his to run while the former King sails for England and begins to run a game of Kingmaker in the Gamer's 'Zine.

Look for rules on becoming a Cardinal in a future issue.

NOTES FROM THE JOURNAL OF THE ROYAL ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY - Edited by LORD HARRISON BURKE, Fall, 1827.

- IN EUROPE

M. ROXY LaRUE receives a free ticket to Quilmane from one of her business contacts.

- IN AFRICA

PROFESSOR O'FORAN, finding that it is time to move on, moves into hex 96, which is veldt. Finding no river sources, natives or anything else, the Professor moves on into hex 95, which is also veldt. Professor's expedition finds itself surrounded by 8 warriors of the Fulah tribe. Undaunted by the show of force, O'Foran approaches the chief in an open friendly manner. The chief, respecting this maneuver, does not attack the expedition. O'Foran may study and trade with the tribe, next turn. He discovers that bearers will hire on for 4 gifts, Askaris want 6 gifts to hire on, and guides will hire for 6 gifts. One gift will buy one ration.

DOCTOR HYPO GUY CEMIA, contemplating a molten lump of chocolate, retraces his steps back to the oasis in hex 149. The good doctor waters up in hex 149 and hunts before moving into hex 148. Hunting by the oasis in hex 149 produces one ration per hunter. Hex 148 is a desert hex. There is no oasis in this hex. Although the expedition did manage to eat this turn without shooting camels, things do not look very sweet for the good doctor.

ORTE GO DE DAGO offers the chief of the Kabinda tribe all of his worldly goods, consisting of 2 canoes, 60 rations and 2 gifts to gain permission to trade and study the Kabinda tribe. The chief, so impressed by this great gift, gives Dago 9 gifts in return. Dago manages not to come down with any strange disease, after spending a few hours with several of the native women. His hunter's provide the expedition with 3 ration each. He dismisses one bearer, who

wishes to return home. He finds that bearers demand 6 gifts to hire on, Askaris will hire on for 4 gifts and guides want 6 gifts to hire on. Rations sell at the rate of 1 gift buying 5 rations, and canoes can be bought for 2 gifts each.

The silence of the African veldt is broken by the thunder of a charging Rhino for the RIGHT REVEREND TWOMBLY. Six of Twombly's bearers are killed. Twombly convinces two members of the Go-na tribe to hire on as bearers for the price of 5 gifts each. Convinced that stars favor a southward journey, he moves into hex 535, which is a jungle hex with a river source heading in direction 5 into hex 534. Twombly is confronted by six warriors of the Wadahalo tribe. Twombly may attempt to preach to this tribe and trade next turn. Canoes sell for 5 gifts, rations may be bought at the rate of 1 gift getting 4 rations. Bearers want 3 gifts to hire on, Askaris want 5 gifts to hire on, and guides want 2 gifts.

"More slavers Defeated" - McGUFFIN

A. H. McGUFFIN, facing the possibility of starvation in the desert, pushes his men on into another desert hex, hex 415. To inspire his men, McGuffin tells them of his real mission in Africa. Standing on a dune, McGuffin issues forth an oration of the Great White Ape he has come to hunt. He says that he will give a gold coin to the first man to sight the White Ape. His expedition move on, discovering an oasis in the desert hex 415. At the oasis, he encounters a band of slave traders, which he attacks. The 12 scouts stand and fight, but are no match for his 17 Askaris. He then sets upon the 4 other slavers guarding the prisoners. The guards are quickly dispatched and McGuffin frees the captives. Although he obtains no rations by hunting he does find 6 rations left behind by the slavers. He dismisses 3 bearers and his guide. Four Askaris desert, including the one who would not follow orders. At the oasis, one of his Askaris is seen hollowing out a palm tree and when asked about it refuses to answer.

The retirement of the Pope from public life has caused wide spread rumors in the Vatican that the Church is embarrassed by the actions of GUIDO VITTORIO SCONZINESE. It is reported that Guido has arrived in Mombassa, bringing only the finest Italian wines to use as gifts, and outfitting a canoe expedition. Guido has two main objectives in Africa: 1) To find the source of Life, and 2) to find a new topping for the best pizza in the world. His rations consist of the best pizza making he can find in Mombassa.
