NONE THIS TIME

M. de Sod was promoted to Col. of the Cardinal's Guard this season for leading his squadron in a fierce charge that temporarily broke the enemy line while his commander was beating a strategic retreat at full speed (for which he received a promotion, saving M. de Sod a lecture on not making his superior officer look bad). It is rumored that M. de Sod was seen rummaging through the pockets of fallen Italians before returning to his lines. Better that his "pocket" money should come from the Italians than from the coffers of France, Eh? For his bravery de Sod received the title of Count.

Other promotions include Diderot to Lt. Col. of the Gascon Regiment, Dolokhov to Col. of the Princess Louisa Light Dragoons & Jardin to Lt. Col. of the Crown Prince Cuirassiers. M. Jardin looked very dashing on his fine new mare La Filles de le Regiment. M. Lafayette, despite a less than sensational showing in the field, was promoted. He now holds the rank of full Brigadier General and is breveted Lt. General, passing on command of the Royal Foot Guards to his Lt. Col.

Meanwhile, back in Paris, M. Bic embarked on an intense program of self improvement by practicing a variety of skills and M. Dubois honed his already deadly dueling skills to a fine edge. Dubois' expertise will avail him little, however, as M. Le Fleur has been appointed Commissioner of Public Safety and immediately announced that Dubois would be brought to trial on the first of June for treason against the Crown. Minister of State, Van Rijn, who has had some difficulty with Dubois in the past, has refused to disqualify himself from judging the case, saying, "Have no fear, I shall see that this scum gets a fair trial and is then reduced to the poverty that befits his station!" M. Le Fleur also received the title of Baron upon his appointment.

M. de Lampalle returned from campaign and increased his social standing immediately. Some eyebrows were raised, however, when he was seen in the company of the lowly Terrault, who, on the other hand, benefited greatly from being seen in such illustrious company, and raised his own social standing enough to regain his rank of Major in the Crown Price Cuirassiers.

M. Jardin was not as fortunate at home as on the field, winning the lovely Marguiritte early in the season, only to lose her later when he took her to his club once and then ignored her. She ran off with Matusse. C'est la vie.

NOTES FROM THE JOURNAL OF THE ROYAL ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY - Edited by LORD HARRISON BURKE, Winter, 1827.

- IN EUROPE

Just before attempting to leave Paris for Quilimane, M. ROXY LaRUE realizes that Quilimane is a Portugese port and is closed to all but Portugese explorers. Roxy, depressed by this turn of events, redoubles her efforts to raise money, but she is only able to raise \$50 this turn. Hopes of a canoe expedition up the Zambezi river fade from Roxy's memory.

PRESS RELEASE from the Zurichers geologisches Institut - "...and so we thought it best to hire someone who virtually has rocks in his head, the notorious Geneva born geologist and essayist, Professor Humbert Humbert. Although he had been planning a sabbatical in Lucerene, a few words to authorities in the right places soon convinced prof. Humbert that Africa was where he needed to go. Reached at his favorite watering spot, Der Blaue Angel, Prof. Humbert commented, 'I understand that Africa holds a number of tropical nymphettes - in rock strata'.

- IN AFRICA

PROFESSOR O'FORAN, very happy to have found natives to study(at last!), gives the chief of the Fulah Tribe 8 gifts to gain permission to study the tribe. O'Foran spends this turn studying the native tongue and the Tribe's primitive customs. He learns that bearers will hire on for 5 gifts, Askaris now want 5 gifts to hire on and Guides only want 2 gifts to hire on. One gift will buy one ration. Camels sell for six gifts each.

Things seem to get sweeter for DOCTOR HYPO GUY CEMIA this turn. The good doctor moves on in direction one into 122, which is a desert hex, but it contains an oasis. Stopping to

hunt, each hunter gets 2 rations and water before moving on in direction 4 into 121, which is also desert, with an oasis. The good doctor relaxes in the water, splashing around, having a good time.

ORTEGO DE DAGO, having studied the Kabinda tribe in enough detail, decides to move on. Before heading up river, he buys 1 canoe and 35 rations. To fit everybody into his canoe, he must dismiss 7 bearers and 3 Askaris. As his expedition is heading up river, a leopard jumps out of the Jungle and kills his Guide. Dago now has an open space in his canoe. Continuing up what he believes to be the Ogove river, he moves into hex 192, which is jungle with the river turning in direction 6. Finding no neat things, Dago moves on up the river into hex 166, which is also jungle with the river still heading in direction 6 into hex 140. His hunters provide the expedition with 2 ration each.

Offering the chief of the Wadahalo tribe all his worldly possessions, one gift, an astrological calendar and 25 rations, persuades the chief to give the RIGHT REVEREND TWOMBLY 16 gifts and permission to preach to the tribe. Twombly uses 2 gifts to buy rations for himself and his men. The natives applaud his sermon, he receives 2 VPs and the native attitudes are raised by +3. Twombly survives attempts to poison him by both the witch doctor and the chief. Twombly is sick for a few days, but recovers to follow the stars West.

A. H. McGUFFIN moves on out of desert hex 415, due West, into hex 414, which is a mountain hex. McGuffin knows that this may be dangerous, but he also knows that he must push on if he is to kill the great white ape. The mountain peaks are only 10,600 ft. high, so they present little danger to him. His concern is about Roerore, one of his Askaris, who is dragging the hollowed out trunk of a palm tree, which he has carved into the shape of a large box, with a lid. The expedition does not starve this turn because each hunter gets one ration.

GUIDO VITTORIO SCONZINESE believing, through Divine Guidance, that a river source lays inland, decides to leave Mombasa and head inland, carrying his canoes. Guido heads due West into hex 299, which proves to be a veldt hex with no river sources. He does encounter a band of slave raiders heading inland. Guido's normal reaction to slavers is not one of charity, but considering that this band consists of 30 heavily armed men, Guido decides that discretion is the better part of valor. By pretending that they are not here he hopes and prays that they will go away, and they do! His hunters provide the expedition with 3 rations each.
